- ✓ Enhancing Multilateral Cooperation
- ✓ Increasing institutional and human capacity
- ✓ Improving joint solutions for common problems
- ✓ Strengthening operational skills on international projects
- ✓ Supporting the policy environment for the policy recommendations adopted by the COMCEC Ministerial.



Relations Between the Tools of the Strategy

Working Group Meetings

- ✓ Working Group Membership: Relevant Ministries and other public institutions and OIC Institutions registered to the Working Groups.
- ✓ Producing policy recommendations in WGs based on policy questions and the analytical studies

Project Funding Mechanism

- ✓ Enhancing multilateral cooperation between the member countries and OIC institutions in six cooperation areas.
- ✓ Policy support instrument to realize policy recommendations.
- ✓ Contribution to capacity building through soft projects

- ✓ Simple Rules
- ✓ Clearly defined Financial Framework
- ✓ Backstopping by the CCO and the Development Bank of Turkey
- ✓ Demand and Member Driven Mechanism




COMCEC Project Funding


- ✓ COMCEC Projects are based on GRANTS (No re-payment)
- √ Simple procedures (unlike credit agreements)
- ✓ Prompt payment after reporting (financial & technical) to the Bank

Project Proposals in Three-year Period

- ✓ 209 project proposals submitted by Member Countries and OIC Institutions during three-year period.
- ✓ 22 projects were implemented in 2014 and 2015.
 - 3 Tourism projects
- √ 10 project proposals are being implemented in 2016.
 - 2 Tourism projects (Malaysia and Gambia)

Project Title: Improving Statistical Capacities of Tourism Sector in COMCEC Mediterranean and Gulf Region

Project Owner: SESRIC

Project Purpose: Identification of the statistical capacities and needs in tourism statistics in selected COMCEC Countries in the Mediterranean and Gulf Regions

Activities: Circulation and evaluation of questionnaires in order to make a needs assessment in the selected countries, Organization of several training programs and a workshop.

Project Title: Cities of Common Cultural Heritage

Project Owner: Ministry of Culture and Tourism of Azerbaijan

Project Purpose: Increasing touristic arrivals to the selected countries by exchanging good practices, developing and promoting joint tourism products (Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan, Turkey and Uzbekistan)

Activities: Assessment of potentially attractive culturalhistorical sites, Drafting of an interim assessment report, Organization of a workshop

Project Title: Strengthening Community Resilience through eco-tourism.

Project Owner: Ministry of Tourism and Culture (The Gambia)

Project Purpose: Building resilient communities in The Gambia, Senegal and Guinea Bissau through ecovillage practices


Activities: Eco-village design (EDE) education (training of the trainers), Report on EDE practices

- Must be focal point (Member Country or OIC Institution)
- Own a username and password
- Check the reference materials on the pcm online
- Think about the sectoral themes under tourism on page 20 of the Program Implementation Guidelines
- Conceptualize your project
- Fill out the project fiche
- Contact PCM Group (pcm@comcec.org) when necessary

 - 3 Updates in sectoral themes




Online Project Management Information System
