The CCO determines sectoral themes under each cooperation area by considering outputs of the Working Groups as well as policy recommendations adopted by the COMCEC Ministerial Sessions. # Common Characteristics of Successful Project Proposals

- Sufficient and informative project summary
- Sound project activities and relevant details about them
- Qualified Human Resources in line with Project Submission Guidelines Requirements
- Detailed and well-designed work plan
- Realistic cost estimations in the budget and sufficient explanations for them

**Project Purpose:** The objective of this project was to increase touristic arrivals to the respective countries through exchange of good practices in the relevant sphere and by developing and promoting joint tourism products in 4 countries.

# Projects Implemented in 2014 (cont'd)



**Project Title:** Improving Statistical Capacities of Tourism Sector in COMCEC Mediterranean and Gulf Region

**Project Owner:** SESRIC

**Project Purpose:** The objective of the project was identification of the statistical capacities and needs in tourism statistics in Albania, Iraq, Jordan, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Tunisia, Turkey, United Arab Emirates, and Yemen (selected COMCEC Countries in the Mediterranean and Gulf Regions) with an aim to improve Tourism Satellite Accounts and evidence-based policy making on tourism.
