





About TMO

- Founded in 1938 as an institution running on state capital
- Has administrative, financial and decision-making autonomy
- Related institution of The Ministry of Food Agriculture and Livestock

Duties

- To regulate cereal markets
- To produce morphine and its derivatives from opium poppy required by pharmaceutical industry.
- To keep extraordinary cereal stocks that can be used in the state of emergency.
- To carry out the duties for other agricultural products given by the related Cabinet Decree (hazelnut, raisin)





The Agricultural Market Information System (AMIS) is an inter-agency platform to enhance food market transparency and policy response for food security.
























Agriculture Market Information System (AMIS)

Focus of AMIS is on four grains that are particularly important in international food markets.










Global production, utilization, stocks&trade of those commodities come to the forefront in work Schedule of AMIS.

AMIS Participating Countries



TOBB

- The Union of Chambers and Commodity Exchanges of Turkey (TOBB) is the highest legal entity in Turkey representing the private sector.
- Similar to the patterns of guilds and syndicates, which traditionally organized and represented tradesmen and producers throughout the Turkish history, TOBB, too, adopted a representative role in a democratic and modern society.
- Today, TOBB has 365 members in the form of local chambers of commerce, industry, commerce and industry, maritime commerce and 113 Commodity Exchanges which are located in 58 City and 55 district








