SEETO 's role

- SEETO enables general policy environment for integration to the common EU Transport Policy on regional level;
- strong added value to the development of the SEETO Comprehensive Network and the national transport planning process
- SEETO sustainability- serious commitment by the Regional Participants; EC places SEETO process in the core of the accession process for TEN-T and Transport Policy (EC Progress Reports)
- Integrated approach in economic development and growth of the SEE region and other macroeconomic regions (SEE2020 Strategy, Danube Strategy, Adriatic-Ionian, Balkan- Mediterranean)





- SEETO Core Network- defined within the Berlin process, as indicative TEN-T Core Network for WB
- SEETO Comprehensive Network- included in the revised TEN-T Guidelines- TEN-T Comprehensive Network for WB
- Creation of efficient and functional network which integrates the region in the global transport flows
- Focus on horizontal measures (including border-crossing facilitation) and overall transport system development to ensure high return of investments in transport infrastructure
- Improved coordination with IFI's and EC:
 - Enhanced coordination under WBIF and increased utilization of WBIF funds in transport sector
 - $\circ~$ opening of CEF funds




Indicative TEN-T Networks to WB






Core Corridors extension





Connectivity Agenda

- New political impetus for development of the TEN-T Core Network for Western Balkans and Core corridors
- Greater focus on connectivity agenda- new dynamism and targeted investments in pre-identified infrastructure projects on the Core Network
- Much higher attention on policy related measures (soft measures) that should improve the overall transport system and facilitate transport flows
- EC financial instruments and mechanisms will have to follow the WB6 connectivity agenda
- SEETO- main regional institution for monitoring and alerting with regards to the soft measures adopted at Vienna summit


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Road safety inspections, ITS deployment, Road/rail maintenance and road border crossing facilitation

✓ Connecta started in January 2017

- National Connectivity Reform Measures
 - ✓ Joint operation in Tuz started between Albania and Montenegro
 - ✓ Construction works started in Merdare









Achievements 2017

- ✓ Transport Community Treaty signed on 12th July 2017
- ✓ Investment EU co-funding
 - €144.5 ml granted in Trieste Summit for 6 projects (3 roads, 2 rail, 1 IWW)
- ✓ 5 projects secured funding for preparation of project documentation through WBIF amounting to €4.9 ml
- Horizontal measures- steady progress in the reforms in some key policy areas:
 - railway sector
 - road safety
 - harmonisation of regulatory and institutional framework
 - border crossing



Commitments and challenges ahead

- Transport Community structures to be established as a legal successor of SEETO
- Continued commitment towards development of multimodal Core/Comprehensive Network
- Regional Participants to work together towards the aligning of the transport system with the EU, for enabling market rules and EU standards
- Real benefits expected when the measures will become operational (BC agreements, laws, strategies, action plans etc.)
