



Total OIC exports fell by 9.2 per cent in 2016






Main Reasons Accounting for the Weak **Performance of OIC Exports**

- Continuing weakness in world economic activity
- Falling commodity prices in particular oil prices
- US dollars appretiation
- **Ongoing political instability in the Middle East** •





Weakest growth was recorded in world trade in 2016 since the global crisis






Oil prices declined from 52.4 \$/bbl in 2015 to 44 \$/bbl in 2016








OIC fuels exports fell sharply following the collapse in oil prices.








OIC Countries' share in global exports have been declining since 2012








Top five OIC exporters as a whole represents 61 per cent of total OIC exports







High country concentration in extra-OIC exports






Dominance of mineral fuels and oils in total OIC exports

Share of Fuels in Total Exports, 2016



Share of Commodities in Total Exports, 2016








Share of Intra-OIC trade peaked at 18.4 per cent in 2016







Top performers in intra-OIC trade in 2016





Intra-OIC exports is more diversified











Trading Across Borders - Distance to Frontier





Time needed for documentary and border compliance in the OIC is above the world







Albania



Border compliance costs varies substantially among Member States




