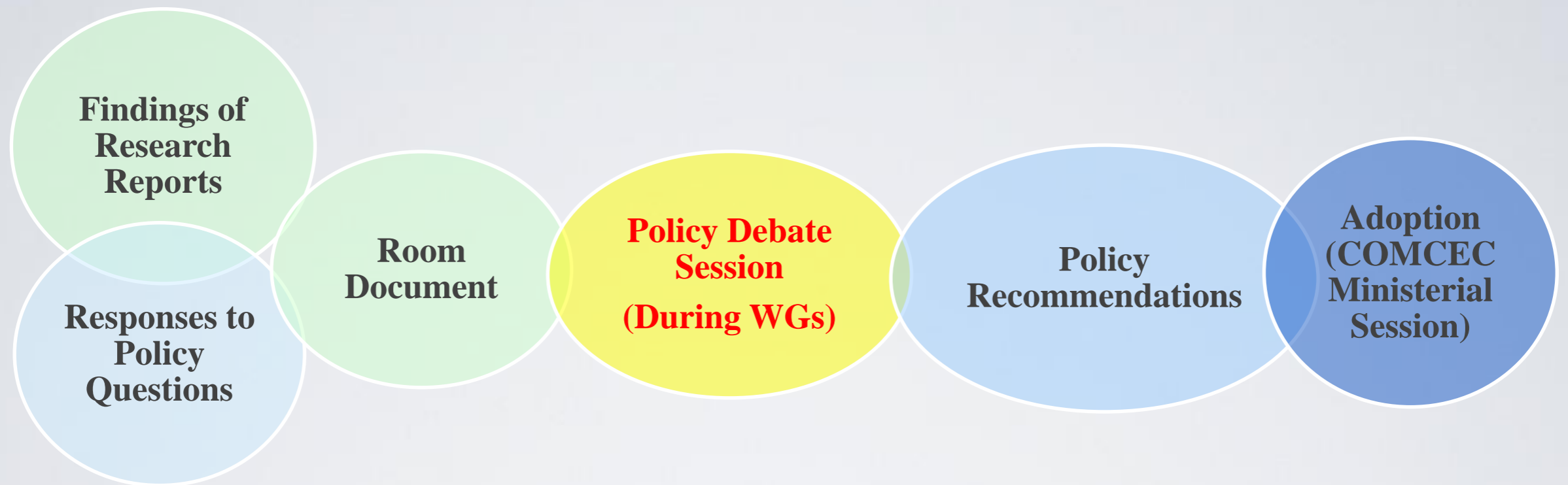

Policy Recommendation 1

- Designing a systematic framework for transport project appraisals, indicating the objectives, types and the utilized methodologies.

Policy Recommendation 2

- Developing manuals and guidelines for ensuring effective transport project appraisals.

3- ROOM DOCUMENT

Policy Recommendation 3

- Applying transport project appraisals as a part of a full project cycle and making use of quality data/information as well as the lessons generated from the implementation of the previous project(s).

Policy Recommendation 4

- Improving transport project appraisals capacity through a system of official certification of competences, exchange of experience, training programs, seminars, conferences and workshops etc.



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
