






First Call for Project Proposals

- September 2nd, 2013: First Call for Project Proposals
- Great interest from countries and OIC Institutions
- 98 project proposals from Member Countries and OIC Institutions
- 15 project proposals were final-listed



Second Call for Project Proposals September 2014

- The independent appraisal of project proposals
- Revised durations for project submission periods
- Upper limit for Project Coordinator's and Project Expert's fees
- Sectoral themes stated in the Guidelines for the 2014 project call.



Themes for Tourism Cooperation Area


- Developing and disseminating Community Based Tourism (CBT) applications

- Exploring financing modalities for tourism investments
- Disseminating Best Practices in Enhancing Tourism Workforce Capacity
- Developing vocational education programs
- Developing ICT applications for visa facilitation
- Raising awareness and disseminating best practices on visa facilitation
- Identifying and disseminating innovative ICT solutions for effective marketing strategies
- Improving regulatory framework for ICT- based tourism marketing

Timeline	Description	
Early September	call for project proposals	
End of September	preliminary proposals (30 days)	
October	Appraisal of <u>preliminary</u> project proposals (30 days)	
Early November	Declaration of the short list	
Mid-December	<u>final</u> version of project fiche (45 days)	
Early February	final evaluation and declaration of the final list	
Early March	signing operational agreement with each PO	
April 1st- December 31st	Project Implementation Period (9 months max.)
