- ✓ Producing policy recommendations in WGs based on policy questions and the analytical studies

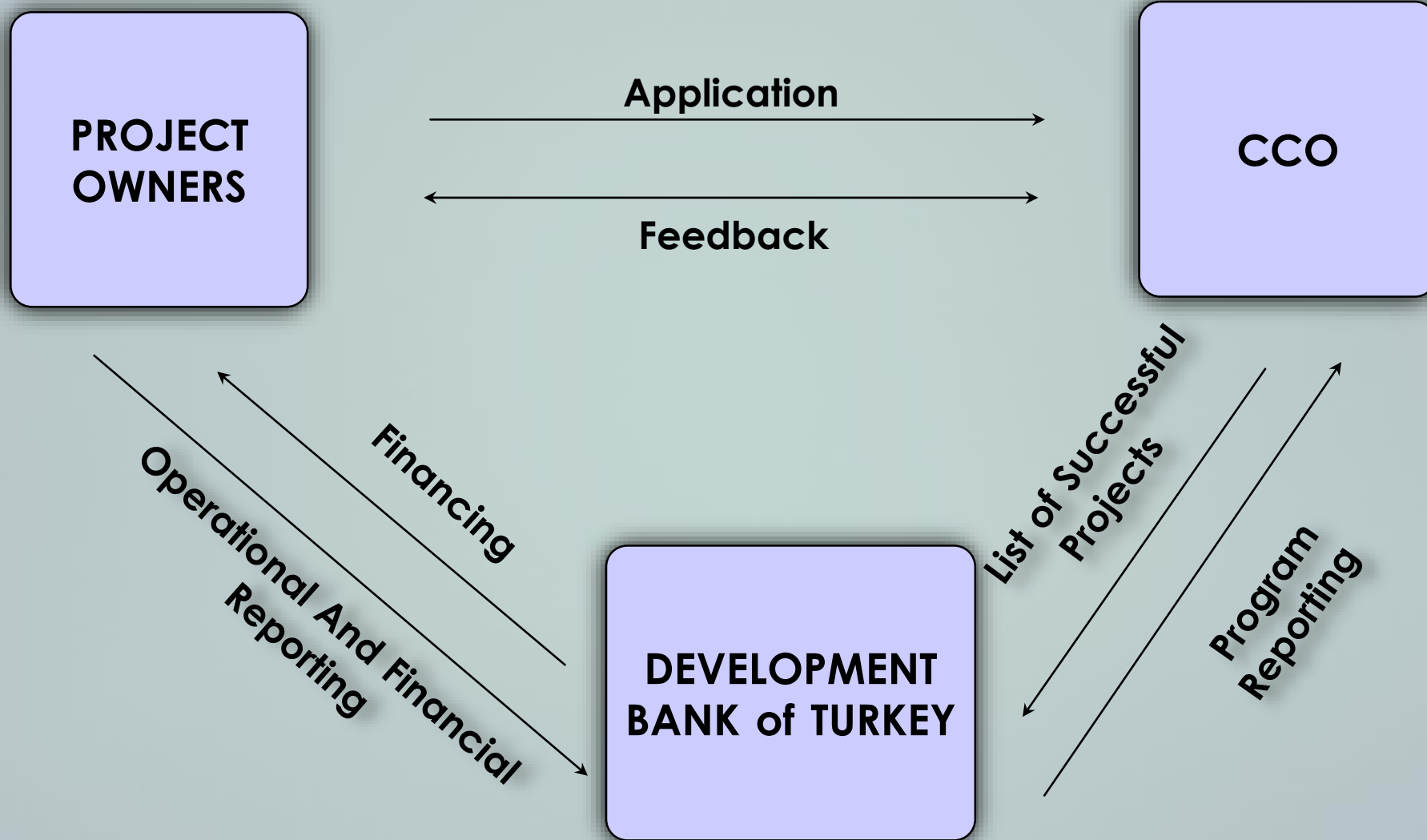
## Project Funding Mechanism

## MAIN CHARACTERISTICS

- ✓ Simple Rules
- ✓ Clearly defined Financial Framework
- ✓ Backstopping by the CCO and the Development Bank of Turkey
- ✓ Demand and Member Driven Mechanism
- ✓ COMCEC Projects are based on **GRANTS** (No re-payment)
- ✓ Simple procedures (unlike credit agreements)
- ✓ Prompt payment after reporting (financial & technical) to the Bank

## PROJECT PROPOSALS in THREE-YEAR PERIOD

- **209** project proposals submitted by Member Countries and OIC Institutions during three-year period.
- **22** projects were implemented in 2014 and 2015.
  - **5** Trade projects
- **10** project proposals are being implemented in 2016.
  - **1** Trade project (Uganda)

# PROJECTS Implemented in 2014



**Project Title:** Capacity Building in Trade Institutions of the Central Asian Countries of COMCEC

**Project Owner:** Ministry of Commerce and Industries of Afghanistan

**Partner Countries:** Pakistan, Iran and Tajikistan



**Project Purpose:** To analyze potential barriers in foreign trade and finance for SMEs in Afghanistan by using surveys and secondary data.

**Activities:** Desk based research, training workshop, publishing a final report on SME finance



## PROJECTS Implemented in 2014 (cont'd)



**Project Title:** International Seminar on Developing National & Regional Approaches to Enhancing Innovation Support Commercialization of R&D Results and Patents among the Organization of Islamic Cooperation Member States.

**Project Owner:** ICDT



**Project Purpose:** To build capacity and to share good practices through publishing and distributing a research report in the margin of a training program.

**Activities:** Conducting patent commercialization, organizing training, preparing an evaluation report.

## PROJECTS Implemented in 2014 (cont'd)



**Project Title:** SMEs in the Borderless Era, Shaping Opportunity in the Global Value Chain

**Project Owner:** Ministry of Trade of Indonesia

**Project Purpose:** To raise awareness in member countries on the internationalization of SMEs in the Global Value Chain (GVC)

**Activities:** Desk-based research, Field trips (Indonesia, Malaysia, and Brunei Darussalam), Workshop, publishing a research report.



# PROJECTS Implemented in 2015



**Project Title:** Capacity-Building and Institutional Strengthening of The Gambia Standards Bureau for the Adoption and Implementation of OIC/SMIIC Halal Standards and Related Conformity Assessment

**Project Owner:** Ministry of Trade, Industry, Regional Integration and Employment of Islamic Republic of the Gambia



**Project Purpose:** To develop capacity for the production of national Halal Standards and Mark that is harmonized with the OIC/SMIIC Halal Standards in order to promote and facilitate trade among OIC member countries.

**Activities:** Workshop, Study tour to Turkey, Training of Gambian and Senegalese metrology staff at the National Metrology Institute of Turkey, dissemination published halal standards.

## PROJECTS Implemented in 2015 (cont'd)



**Project Title:** Access to Finance for SME and Entrepreneurs in the OIC region; Opportunities and Challenges for the Entrepreneurs

**Project Owner:** Ministry of Business and Trade of Qatar

**Partners:** Saudi Arabia, Kuwait, United Arab Emirates, Oman and Bahrain



**Project Purpose:** To make comparative analysis of the access to finance to SMEs and entrepreneurs in the OIC countries and encourage policy makers to review and revise the current rules and practices.

**Activities:** Reviewing literature, conducting structured interviews, comparative analyses, publishing reports and papers, organizing a workshop in Qatar.

**Project Title:** Improving Delivery of Trade Facilitation Services (IDFTS)

**Project Owner:** Ministry of Trade, Industry and Cooperatives of Uganda

**Partner Countries:** Turkey and Egypt

**Project Purpose:** To prepare a research report that provides a clear road map for establishing Trade Facilitation Bodies in Uganda, Turkey and Egypt.

**Project Activities:** Study tour to Egypt and Turkey for data collection, Preparation of research report on establishing TFB in Uganda, Egypt and Turkey, Workshop

- Fill out the project fiche
