WCO DEFINITION:

"A facility that allows parties involved in trade and transport to lodge standardized information and documents with a single entry point to fulfill all import, export, and transit related (…) regulatory requirements".

Single Windows & Trade Facilitation lead towards the simplification, harmonisation, standardisation, and modernization of customs & trade procedures in the interest of reducing transaction costs between government and business in international trade.







Global implementation framework...



Political will and the leadership

Conditions of success:

- High level governmental leadership
- Consensual approach
- Strong involvement of customs
- Appropriation by users

Risks to handle:

- Leadership rivalry
- High costs of the services
- Low impact on the processing time (notion of involvement or commitment)
- Ineffective change management
- Duality of the manual and electronic systems

A higher level decision (President or Prime Minister) is the determinant. In all situation, customs, must be in the starting blocks.





Legal Conditions.

The legal framework Model

The legal and statutory framework encompasses:

- all the laws,
- decrees,
- rulings,
- conventions and memorandums likely to govern the procedures to be applied as part of trade-related operations.

The legal framework Model



Basically, the Single Window can operate based on two different legal models:

<u>Model 1:</u> Single Window operations without electronic signature (the SW being a platform for automated processes and data exchanges);

<u>Model 2:</u> Single Window operations with electronic signature (the SW accommodates paperless procedures).

In a Paperless Environment

In Case of **Model 2 with electronic documents** replacing the paper-based document. It is therefore necessary to have a legal framework governing this new document format.

it might be necessary to enact the laws listed below to sustain the new operational procedures. These laws are:

- ✓ Law on the protection of personal data;
- ✓ Law on electronic transactions;
- ✓ Law on cybercrime;
- ✓ Law on cryptography.

CHANGEMENT MANAGEMENT



KEY PRINCIPLES



- 1. Early consideration of **Human Factors** implications
- 2. Start with more Relevant Stakeholders
- 3. Avoid total **Reengineering** to maintain Commitment
- 4. Control the **Infrastructure** in order to minimize assistance needs
- 5. Don't create **Complexity** where **Simplicity** can be a solution

A Proven and secure methodology



- IMPACTS (value Added must be measurable)
- COMPLEXITY (Rules and Processes to be reviewed if necessary)
- TAKE INTO ACCOUNT GEOGRAPHIC LOCATION
- COMMITMENT IS ESSENTIAL DURING THE PROJECT
- LEGAL IMPLICATIONS MUST BE MEASURED
- KEEP PREOGATIVES OF PARTICIPANTS/STAKEHOLDERS
- INCREASE MATURITY LEVEL OF STAKEHOLDERS




