 President of the Republic of Turkey and the Chairman of the COMCEC
- Adopted by the 4th Extraordinary Session of the Islamic Summit Conference (14-15 August 2012, Mecca)

- Lack of Efficiency, Transparency and Accountability in Public Services
- Lack of Aid Effectiveness
- Lack of Absorption Capacity of Aid Recipient Members
- Neglect of Vulnerable Groups
- Adverse Effects of Global Food and Finance Crises
- Underdeveloped Agriculture Sector and Unfavorable Global Trade Conditions
- Conflicts and Disaster-related Challenges
- Lack of Accurate and Reliable Data for Monitoring Poverty



OUTPUT AREAS


Monitoring Poverty:
