Standardization is established in Mali by the National System of Standardization and Quality Control (SNNCQ), created by Act No. 92-013 / AN-RM of 17 September 1992 and its implementing Decree No. 92-235 / P-RM of 1 December 1992.

Among other bodies, the Committees Standardization Techniques (NTC), which are in number (12):

- CTN « Cereals and Derivatives»;
- CTN « Fruits, Vegetables and Oilseeds »;
- CTN « Chemistry and environment »;
- CTN « textiles, hides and skins »;
- CTN « food of animal origin »;

- CTN « Transport »;
- CTN « Hotels and Tourism »;

- CTN « Biofuel »;
- CTN « Health and Public Hygiene »;
