- 2. Accompany businesses in the certification of their production systems and their products ;**
- 3. Accompany laboratories, inspection bodies and certification to Accreditation;**
- 4. Manage and disseminate documentation on Standardization and Quality Promotion**

RESPONSIBILITIES OF AMANORM

5. Inform, assist and advise companies and laboratories for Standardization, Quality Assurance, Quality Management and Quality Tools, Certification and Accreditation ;
- 6. To undertake training and development for Standardization, Promoting Quality, Certification and Accreditation;
7. Create National Brand of Conformity to Standards and manage its use.

Standardization is established in Mali by the National System of Standardization and Quality Control (SNNCQ), created by Act No. 92-013 / AN-RM of 17 September 1992 and its implementing Decree No. 92-235 / P-RM of 1 December 1992.

Among other bodies, the Committees Standardization Techniques (NTC), which are in number (12):

- CTN « Cereals and Derivatives » ;
- CTN « Fruits, Vegetables and Oilseeds » ;
- CTN « Chemistry and environment » ;
- CTN « textiles, hides and skins » ;
- CTN « food of animal origin » ;
- CTN « Education » ;
- CTN « Transport » ;
- CTN « Hotels and Tourism » ;

- CTN « Biofuel »;
- CTN « Health and Public Hygiene »;
- CTN « Civil Engineering and Building Materials »;
- CTN « Electrical»

Today Mali has 259 standards.

Concerning the Promotion of Quality, the Government adopted on 10 June 2015, the National Quality Policy (PNQ)
