Its main objective is to develop and enhance institutional and human capacity in the member countries.

It is multilateral in nature and member countries and OIC institutions can work together in projects for developing joint solutions for common problems

COMCEC Project Funding has relatively simple rules –further simplification is possible-, clearly defined financial framework and flexible procedures.

It finances projects submitted by COMCEC Member Countries and OIC Institutions to transform their ideas into projects with concrete activities, budget and timeline...

For member countries project ceiling is 250,000 USD

(up to 90 percent grants from the Mechanism)

For OIC Institutions Project ceiling is 100,000 USD

(up to 75 percent of the amount can be paid by the COMCEC)

- **It improves the quality of COMCEC project design and management in member countries**
