# COMCEC STRATEGY

For Building an Interdependent Islamic World

**Its main objective is to develop and enhance institutional and human capacity in the member countries.**

**It is multilateral in nature and member countries and OIC institutions can work together in projects for developing joint solutions for common problems**

**COMCEC Project Funding has relatively simple rules –further simplification is possible-, clearly defined financial framework and flexible procedures.**



# For Building an Interdependent Islamic World

**For member countries project ceiling is 250,000 USD**

**For OIC Institutions Project ceiling is 100,000 USD**

- It improves the quality of COMCEC project design and management in member countries
