

Q1: Does your country currently have services and facilities to cater to Muslim visitors?





Policy Advice 1

• Developing/Harmonizing standards and certification systems for streamlining the basic MFT related services

Policy Advice 2

• Increasing awareness of MFT market among the travel industry stakeholders through standardizing terminology used in MFT, introducing market awareness and customer service training programmes, developing an accreditation program on MFT for tourism industry professionals and utilizing social media.

Policy Advice 3

• Developing healthcare services and facilities for the MFT market through identifying the different strengths of the OIC Region, building specialization hubs/regional hubs, developing alternative/traditional treatments and wellness programs


