WHAT?

A grant-based finance mechanism, was introduced by COMCEC Coordination Office in 2014 as a policy support instrument under the COMCEC Strategy

WHY?

- Increasing institutional and human capacity*
- Supporting implementation of policy recommendations adopted by COMCEC Ministerial Sessions*
- Enhancing cooperation and solidarity among the member countries*

WHO CAN APPLY?

- Relevant public institution of a Member Country(Registered to Relevant Working Group) or an OIC Institution/Organ operating in the field of economic and commercial cooperation*

- Peer-to-Peer Experience Sharing :

Conducted by technical expert(s) from PO country in a host country in order to share experiences and collect information and data in the host country

- Needs Assessment:

Studies, which assess needs of the project owner member country regarding the related sectoral theme

- Opportunity to implement project individually

TIMELINE for PROJECT SUBMISSION AND IMPLEMENTATION

- Preliminary Application: October 1st- October 31th
- Declaration of the Short-Listed Projects : Early December
- Submission of the Final Project Proposals : End of December
- Declaration of the Final-Listed Projects: Early February
- Implementation Period: April - October
- All procedures are coordinated via COMCEC website (cpf.comcec.org) and Project Management Information System
