Despite its natural and cultural resources and traditional cultural hospitality of their local people, OIC countries fall short in satisfying the demand for qualified prospective employees to work in tourism and hospitality industries. There are also problems in the job descriptions, professionalism, working conditions, unionization and rights of the employees working in tourism industry. In the absence of qualified employees tourism industry in OIC frequently import foreign staff in order to satisfy demanding clientele. Qualifications of the employees are not only a requirement for entry level frontline jobs but also for supervisory and decision making positions. Standardization, certification, education, training and employment of local populations in tourism would improve service quality in tourism and result in improvement of tourism demand and per tourist spending.</p>
