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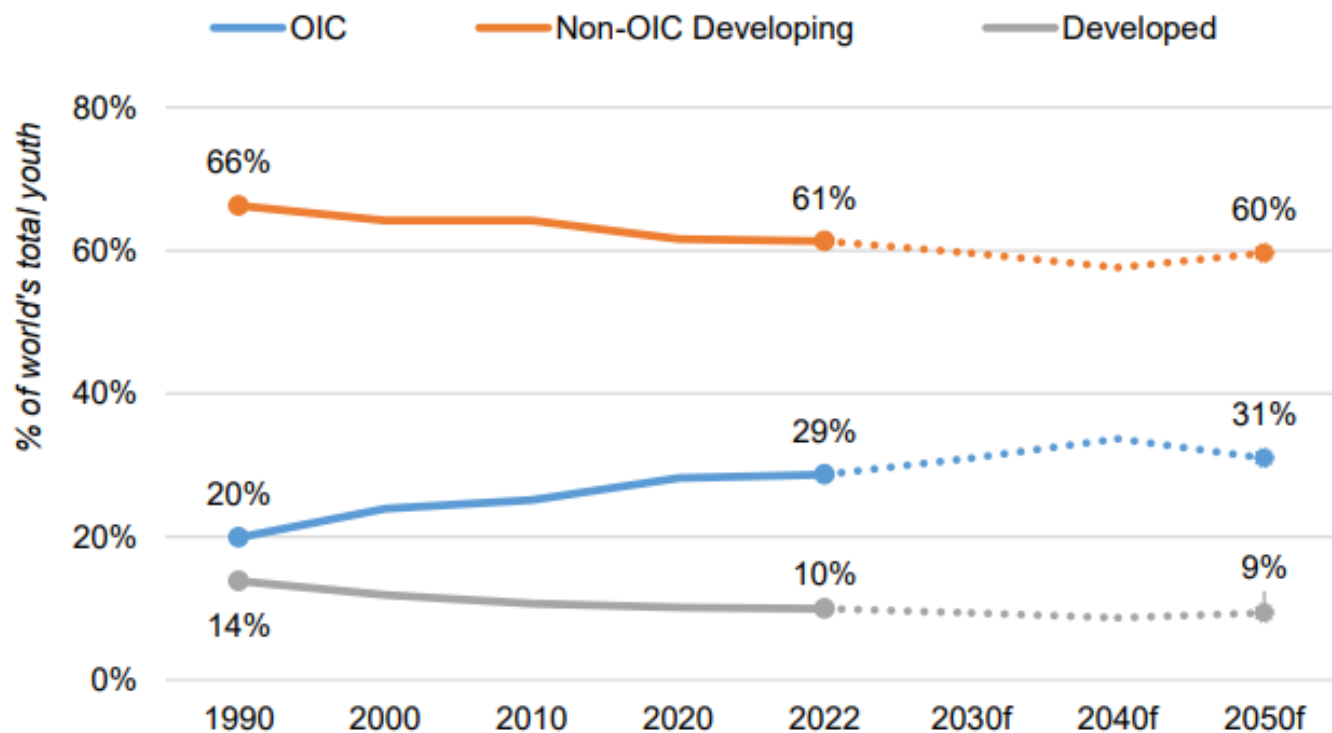

OIC Member Countries: 84.8%

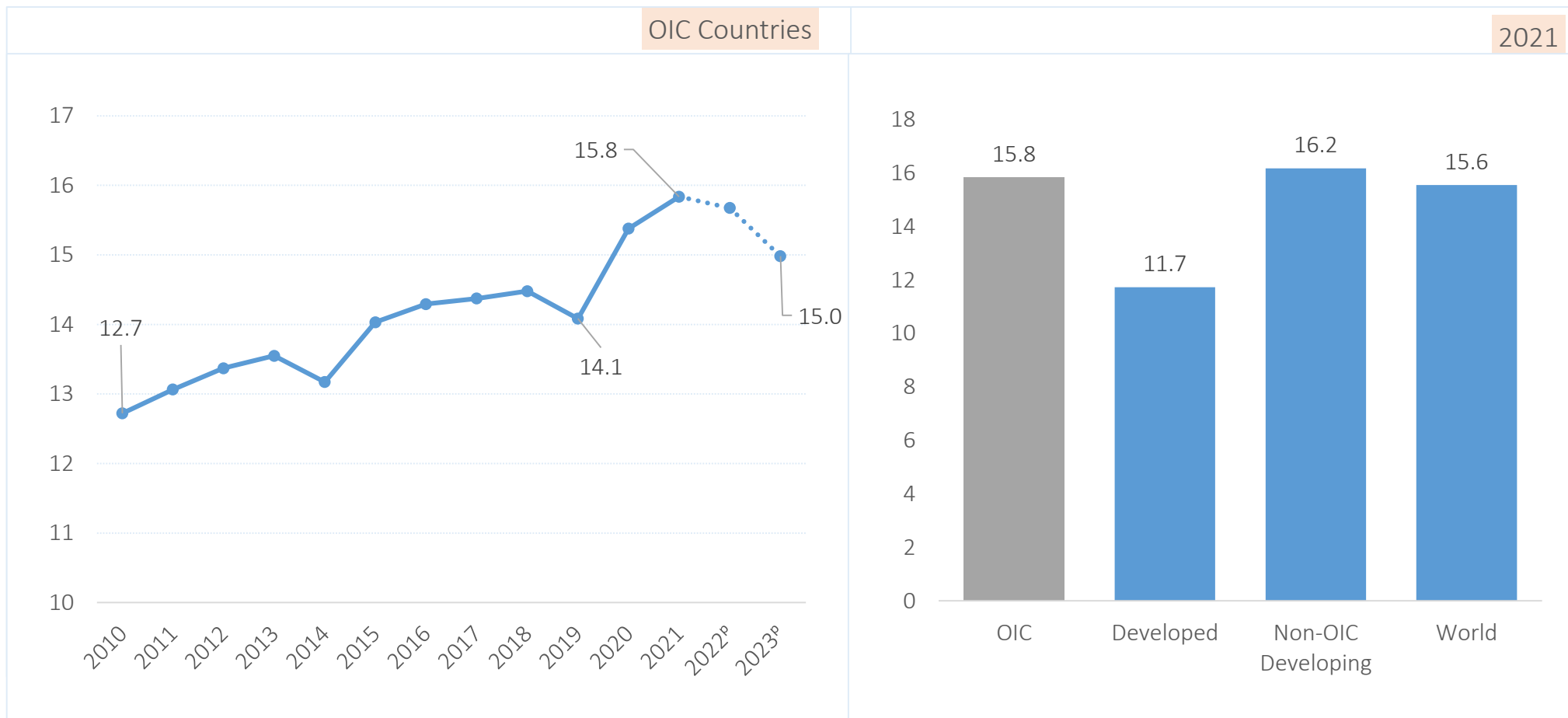

YOUTH UNEMPLOYMENT

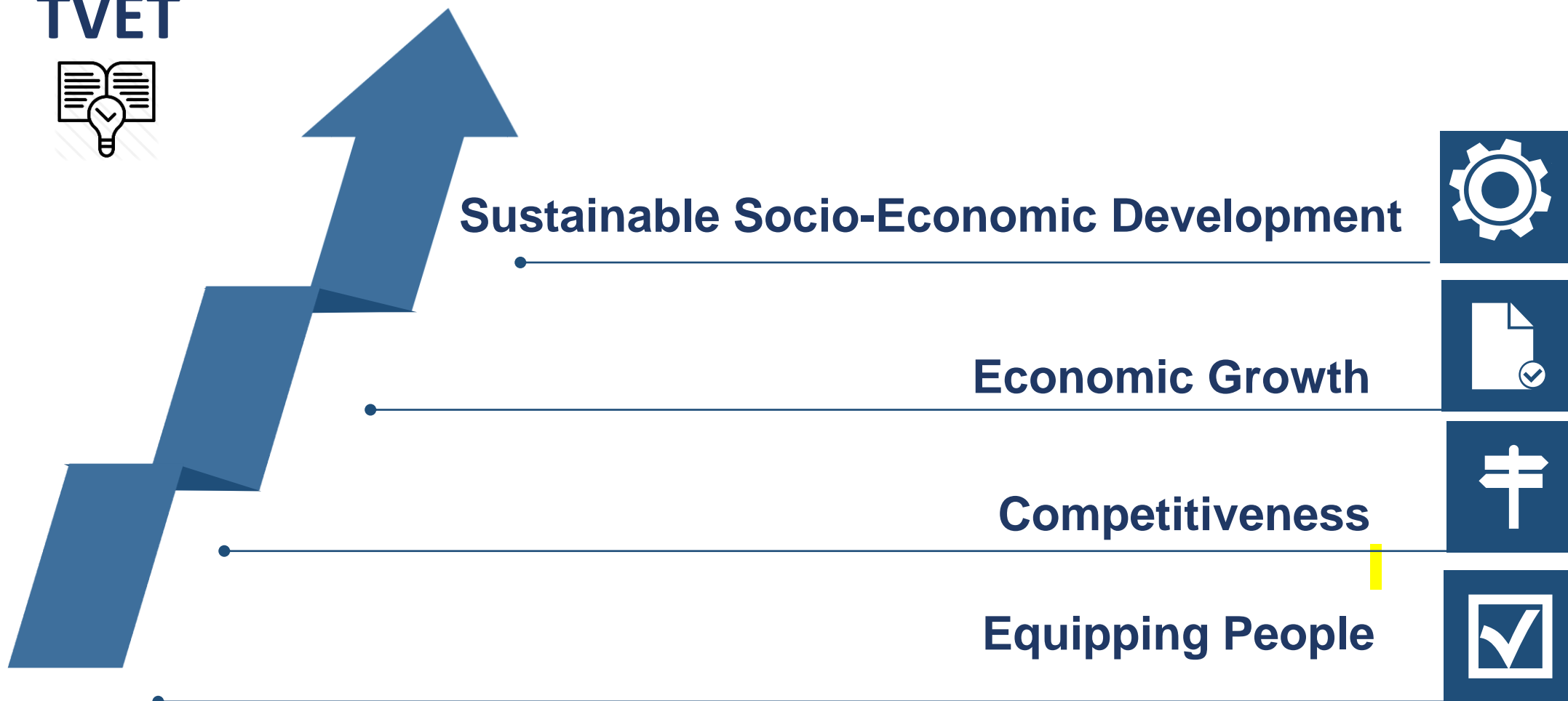
Youth Unemployment Rate



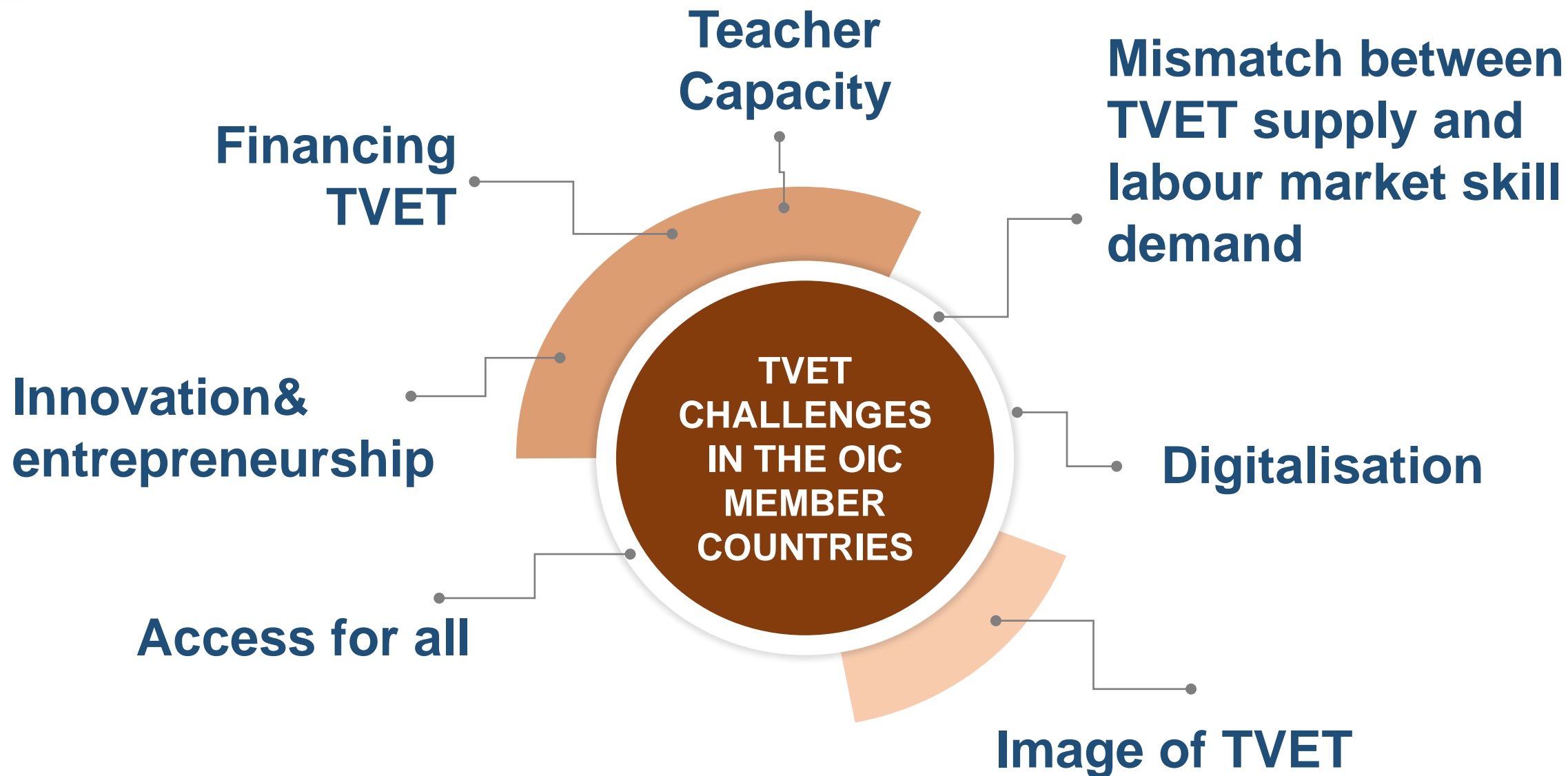

Development of the OIC-VET Programme

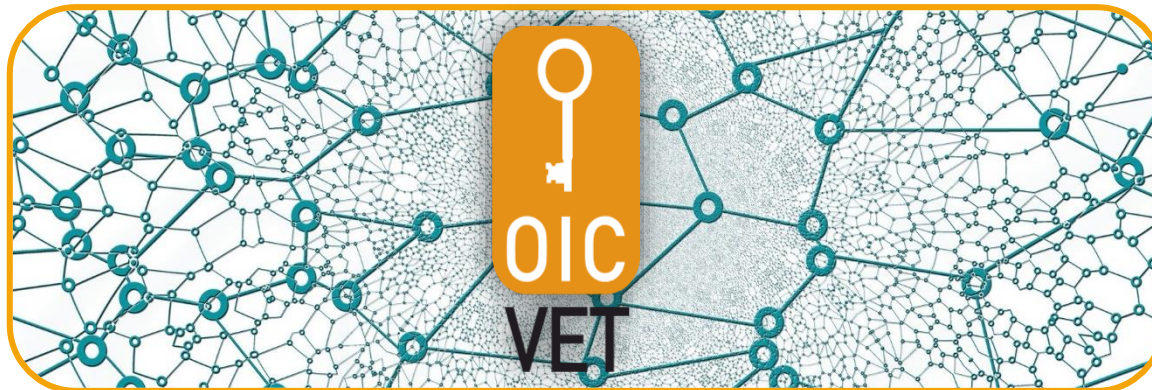
- SESRIC proposed designing and developing a Vocational Education and Training Programme for the OIC Member Countries during the 23rd Session of the COMCEC, held in Istanbul on 14-17 November 2007.
- The 24th Session of the COMCEC, held in Istanbul on 20-24 October 2008, approved the proposed implementation mechanism of the Vocational Education and Training Programme for the OIC Member Countries (OIC-VET) prepared by the SESRIC. The Session called upon the Member Countries to incorporate their vocational training programmes into the OIC-VET Programme, in order to generate a common OIC platform for the benefit of the OIC countries in this area.

Official Launch of the OIC-VET Programme

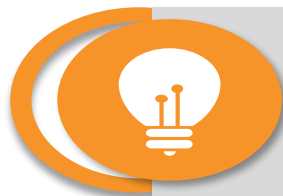
- The OIC-VET Programme was officially launched at the COMCEC Economic Summit held in Istanbul on 9 November 2009 by the President of the Republic of Türkiye, the Chairman of the COMCEC, with the participation of the heads of states and governments of the OIC Member Countries.

- Enhancing the quality and innovation capacity of TVET systems in the OIC Member States

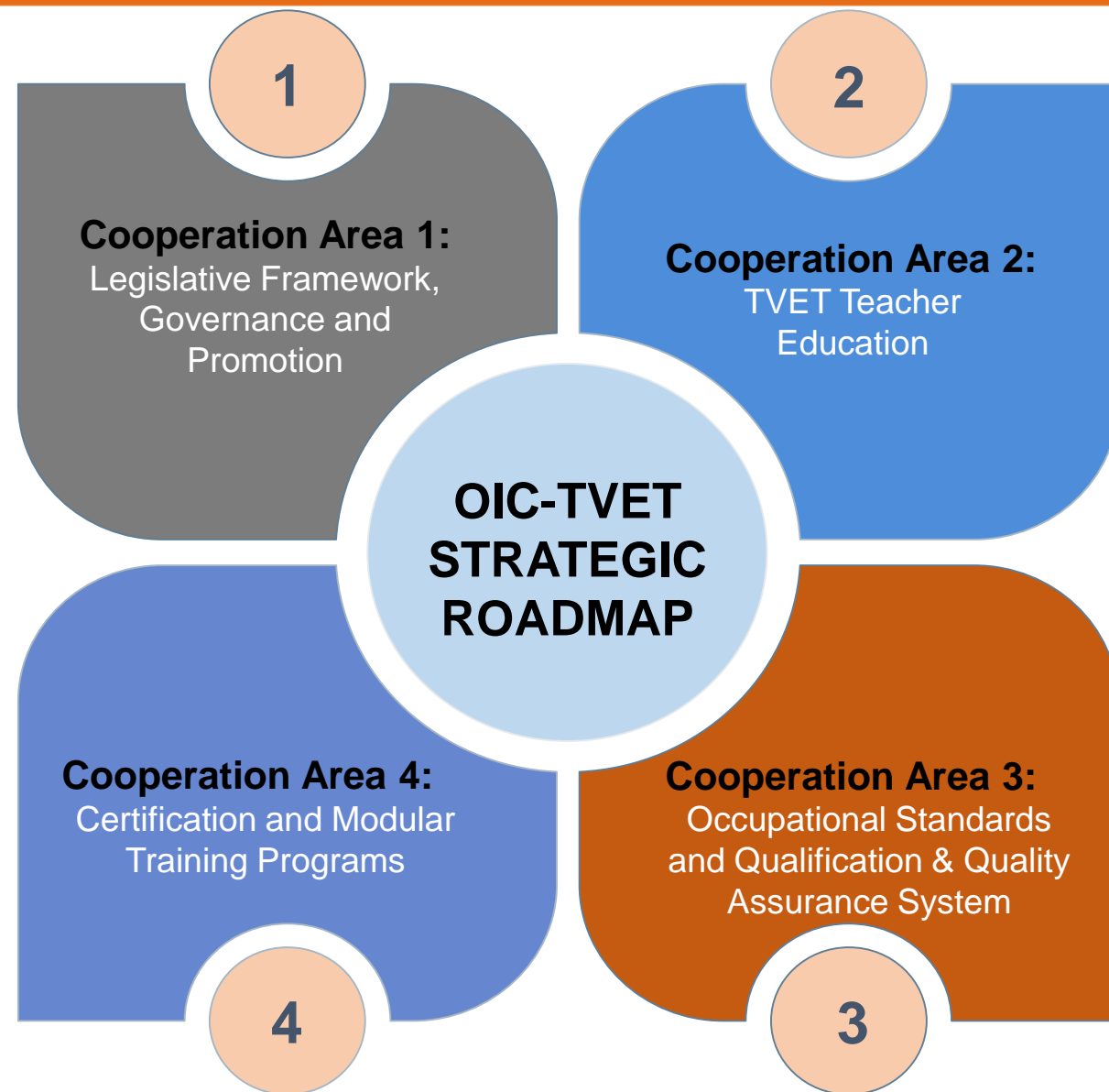

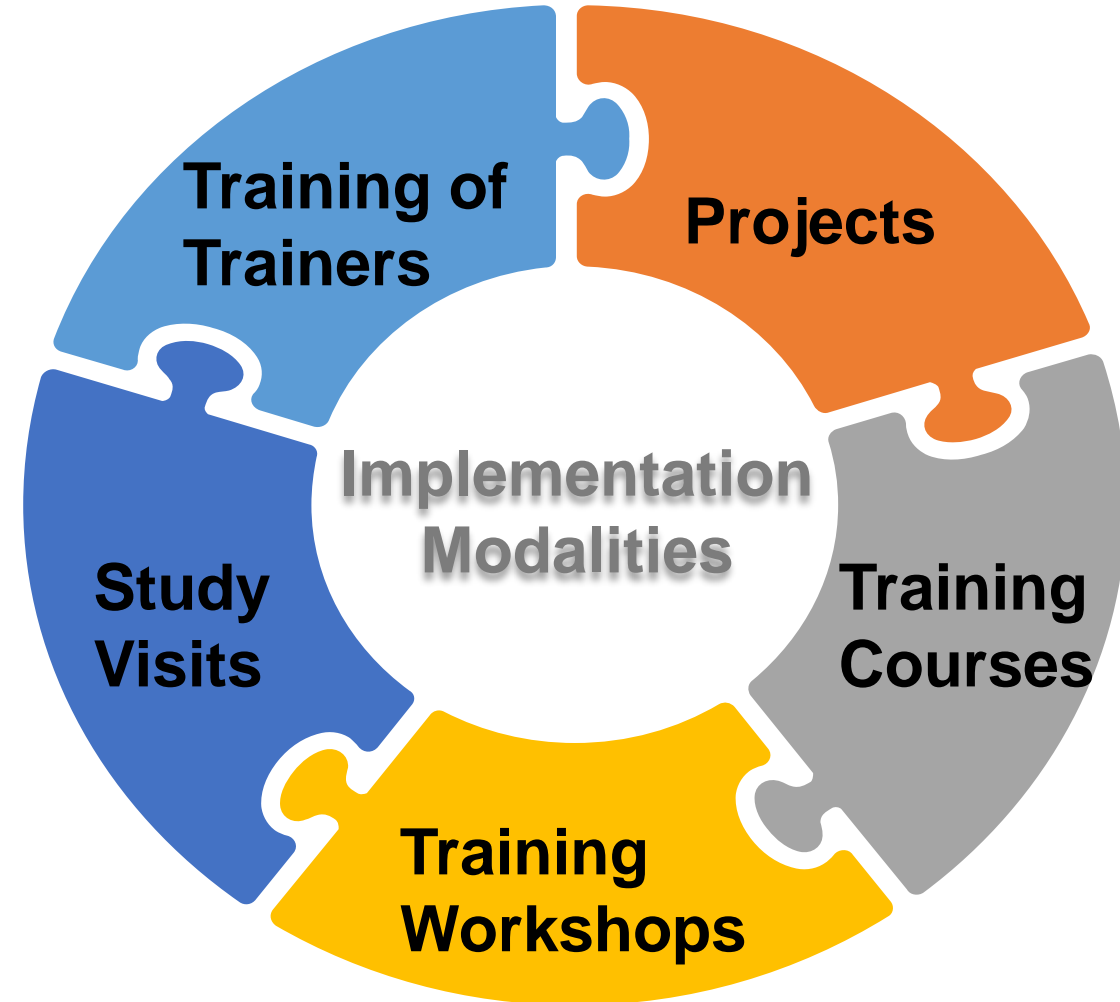
