2nd TECHNICAL MEETING ON COMCEC HIGH LEVEL DIGITAL INITIATIVE/ PROGRAMME

(November 1st, 2022; Virtual Meeting)

1. The 2nd Technical Meeting on COMCEC High-Level Digital Initiative/Programme was held virtually on November 1st, 2022.

(The Agenda and Programme of the Meeting are attached as Annex-I and Annex II)

2. The Meeting was attended by the representatives of the interested Member Countries of the OIC (Organization of Islamic Cooperation) and the relevant OIC Organs/Institutions, namely COMCEC Coordination Office, COMSTECH, IDB Group and SESRIC.

3. The Meeting started with a recitation from the Holy Quran.
4. At the outset, Mr. Selçuk KOÇ, Acting Director General of the COMCEC Coordination Office (CCO) delivered his opening remarks. Welcoming all participants to the meeting, Mr. KOÇ expressed his thanks and gratitude for the remarkable interest shown by the Member Countries during the technical preparations towards developing High-Level Digital Cooperation Initiative/Programme under the COMCEC. Recalling the relevant resolution of the 37th Meeting of the COMCEC Session, Mr KOÇ stressed that the 1st technical meeting was held on September 28, 2022, where the Member Countries had the opportunity to elaborate on the draft version of the concept report as well as discuss the possible thematic areas for cooperation. Mr KOÇ pointed out that during the second technical meeting, with the valuable contributions of the distinguished participants, the Revised Concept Report would be considered and the Thematic Areas for Cooperation to be submitted to the High Level Meeting to be organized on November 27, 2022 in Istanbul on the sidelines of 38th COMCEC Ministerial Session would be identified. Finally, he concluded his remarks by wishing every success to the participants in their deliberations to be made during the 2nd Technical Meeting.
5. Afterwards, Mr. Safa USLU, Head of International Relations Department at Digital Transformation Office of the Presidency of The Republic of Türkiye, delivered his opening speech as the Head of Delegation of the Host Country. In his opening remarks, Mr. USLU expressed his appreciation to the COMCEC Coordination Office for realizing this initiative and their hard work and dedication. Mr. USLU highlighted the importance of the digital transformation and the international cooperation in this area. He also underlined that COMCEC recognized the importance of keeping up with the world wide digital transformation and therefore seeks to strengthen Islamic cooperation and

partnership in this area. He also stated that during the 1st Technical Meeting, many issues regarding digitalization had been discussed including digital governance leadership and policy levers, digital resilience and cyber security, digital skills and competency, digital connectivity, broadband infrastructure and access. Mr. USLU also stressed that emerging technologies are essential for sustainable development but they could also increase inequalities. Finally, he emphasized the importance of developing common policies and projects with regards to digitalization among the Member Countries.

Current State of Digital Transformation in the OIC Member Countries

6. Ms. Şeyma ÖZCAN, Advisor, presented the revised version of the Draft Concept Report on Current State of OIC Member Countries in Digitalization. Ms. ÖZCAN informed the participants about the six possible themes for cooperation, which were updated based on the discussions during the first technical meeting, namely digital governance and leadership, digital resilience, digital connectivity, broadband infrastructure and access and digital skills and competencies and emerging technologies and data governance. Furthermore, Ms. ÖZCAN presented the cooperation framework envisaged in the concept report. She also expressed that the draft concept report reflecting all agreed points raised by the Member Countries during the technical meetings would be shared with the participants very soon.
7. The participants expressed their thanks and appreciation for the presentation and the comprehensive draft report on the current state of the Member Countries in digitalization. Afterwards, the participants highlighted the following issues regarding the report:
 - The issue of digital economy and financial technology (Fintech) can be elaborated in the report.
 - Some best practices and applications such as mobile ID, digital ID, e-government services from the member countries in the field of digital transformation can be referred in the report to the extent possible.
 - The member countries, which have not done so yet, to share their final observations on the draft Concept Report to the CCO by November 11th, 2022.

Moderation Session: Potential Areas of Cooperation

8. Ms. Şeyma ÖZCAN moderated the Session on the potential thematic areas of cooperation in digital transformation.
9. After intense deliberations the participants have identified the following thematic areas for cooperation within the framework of COMCEC High Level Digital Initiative/ Programme.
 - Developing Digital Government
 - Strengthening Digital Resilience and Safeguards
 - Enhancing Digital Connectivity, Broadband Infrastructure and Access
 - Advancing Digital Skills and Competencies
 - Emerging Technologies and Data Governance

- Cross-cutting digital cooperation issues such as start-up ecosystem and clusters for SMEs and entrepreneurs
10. For conducting the related activities and other efforts under each thematic area, a task force, to be led by a voluntary member country, can be formed.
11. Moreover, the participants underlined the need for establishing a regular platform for experience-sharing in these areas among the relevant authorities/institutions of the Member Countries.
12. In this regard, the participants also highlighted the following issues:
- The spread of the culture of digitalization can be included under the heading of developing digital government.
 - Ensuring the interoperability of e-commerce platforms as well as the harmonization of the legal frameworks for e-commerce platforms at the regional level can be referred under the relevant thematic heading in the draft report.
 - Capacity building for cyber security workforce in order to ensure digital resilience and safeguards can have more focus under the relevant thematic heading.
 - The issue of supporting the entrepreneurship and start-up ecosystem can be referred under the thematic heading called “Cross-cutting Digital Cooperation” section.
 - Organizing digital competition activities such as Hackathons and Digitons among the OIC Member Countries can be added under the relevant thematic areas.

Closing Remarks

13. In his concluding remarks, Mr. Mehmet C. AKTAŞ, Director from COMCEC Coordination Office thanked all participants for the fruitful deliberations made during the meeting. Mr. AKTAŞ reminded all participants that the responses of the Member Country observations on the Concept Report can be communicated to the CCO by November 11th, 2022. He also reminded the participants that the High-level Meeting on the Digital Initiative will be held on the sidelines of the 38th Meeting of the COMCEC Ministerial Session to be held on 27th November 2022.
