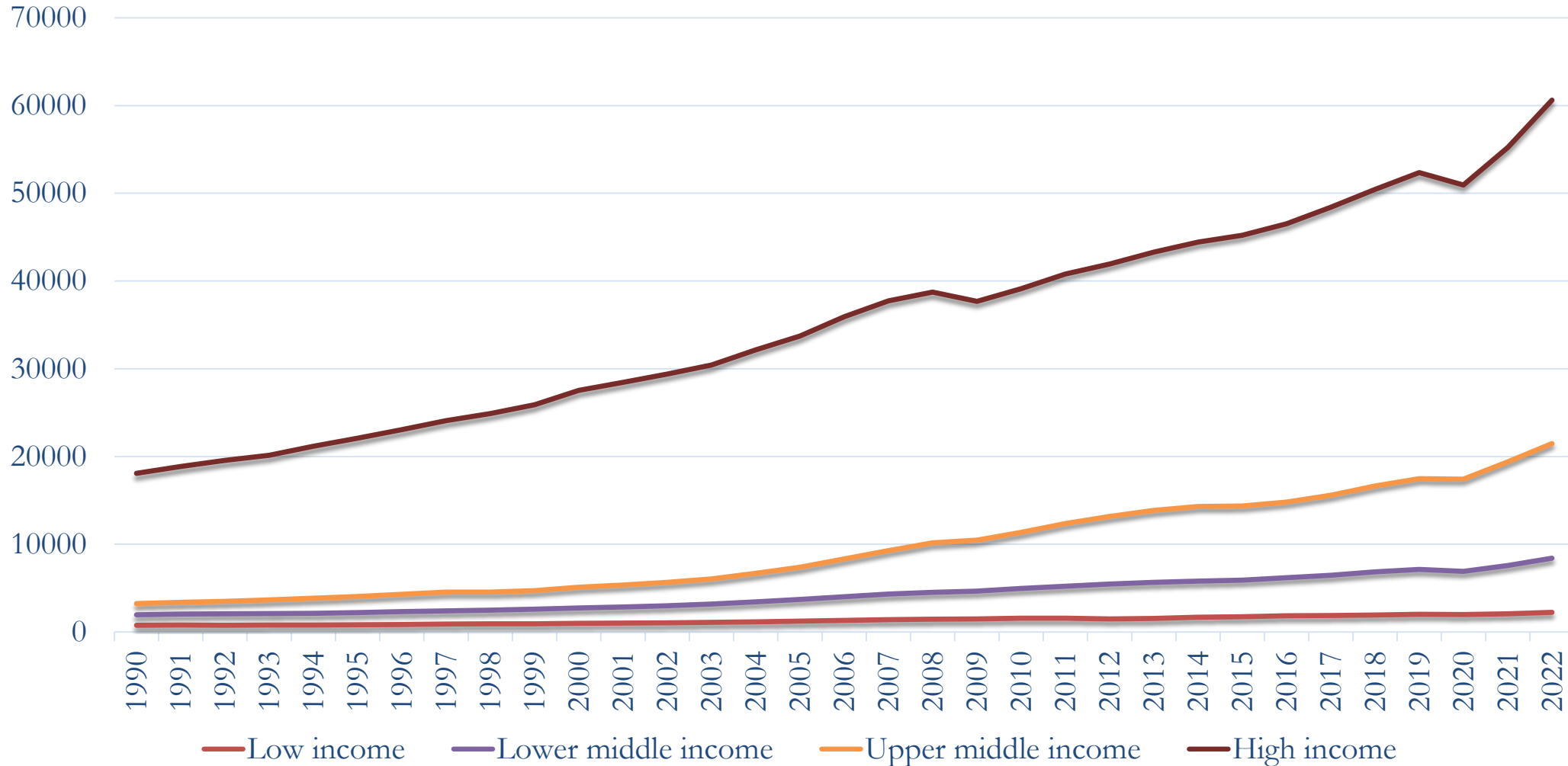


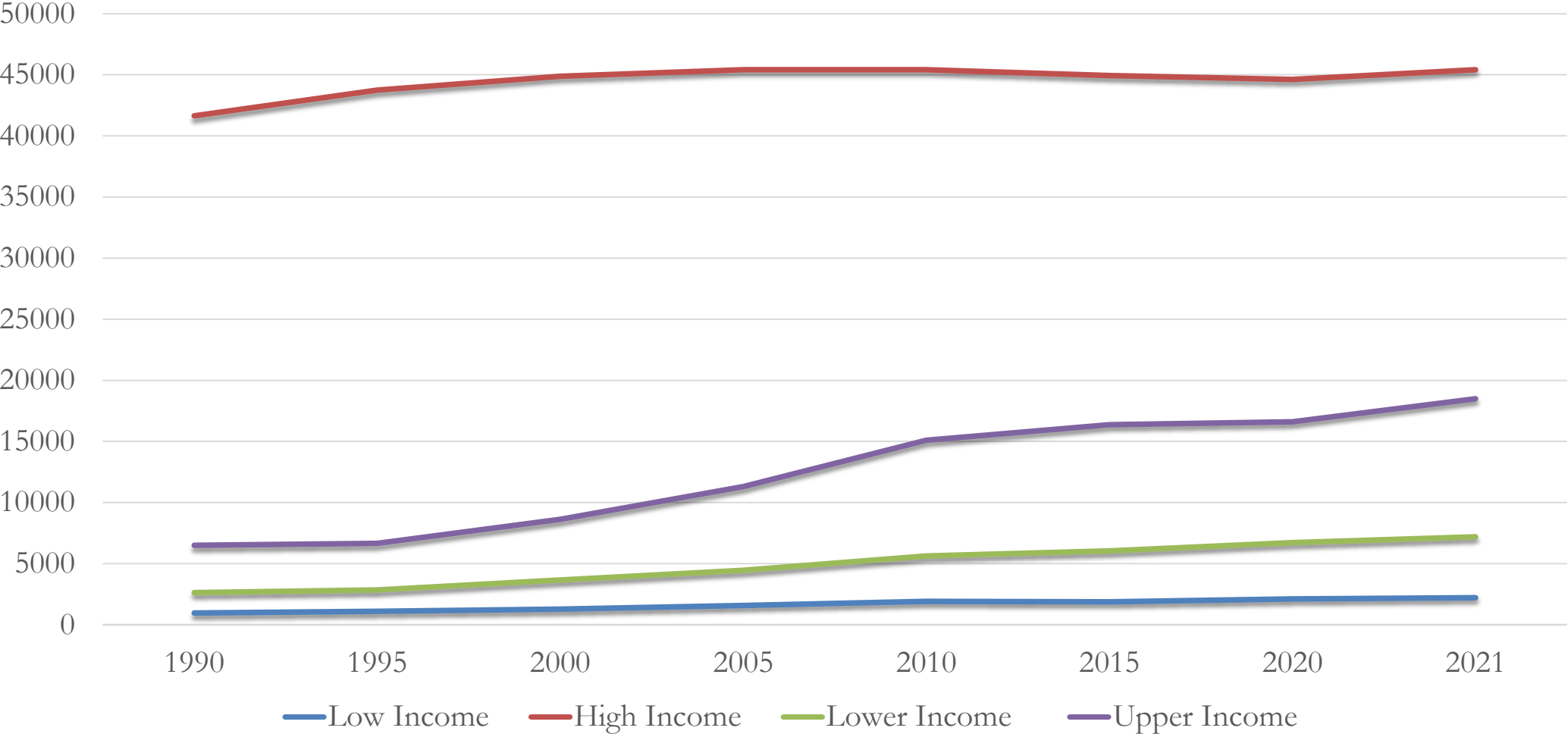

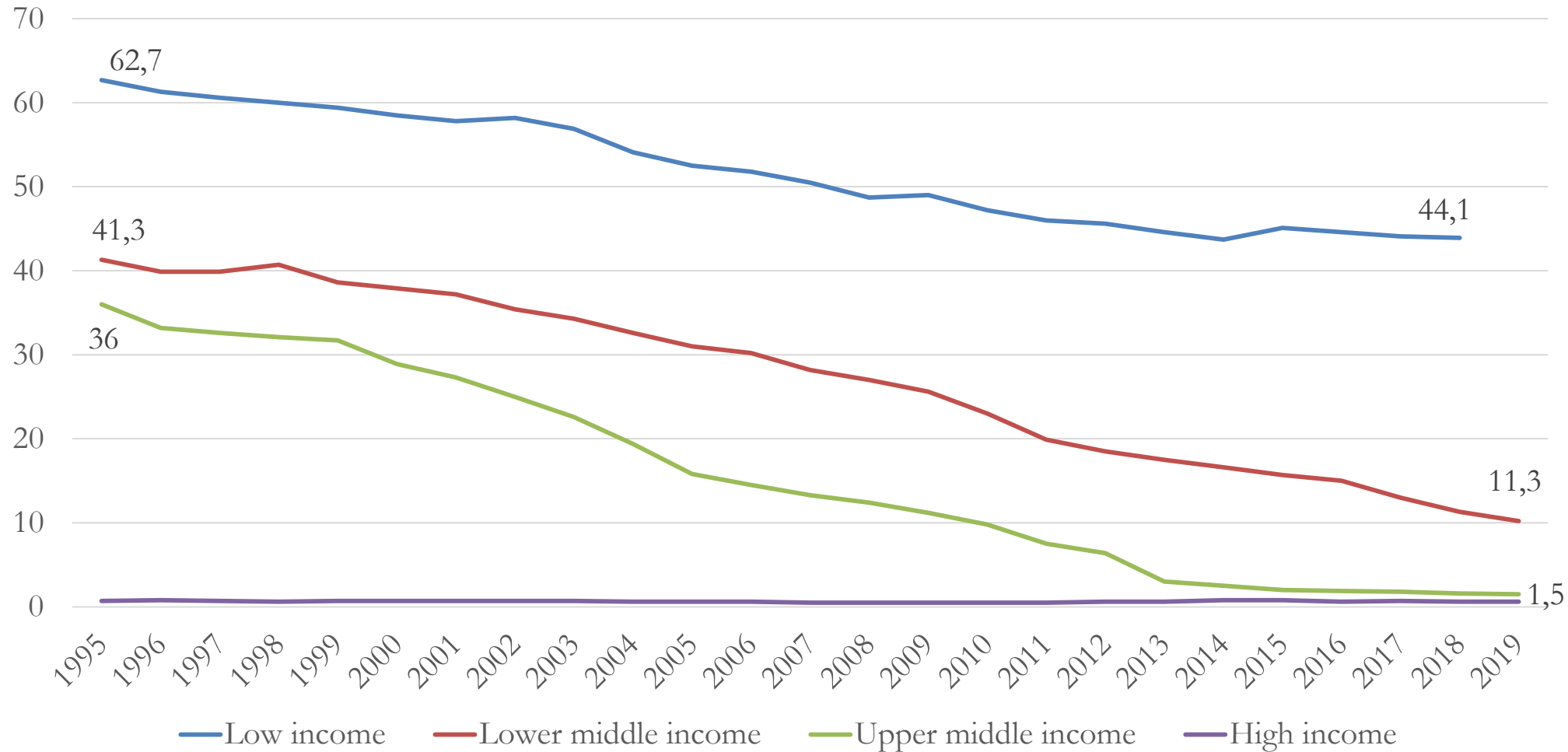
GDP Per Capita (PPP) (Curr. Int. \$) in the World



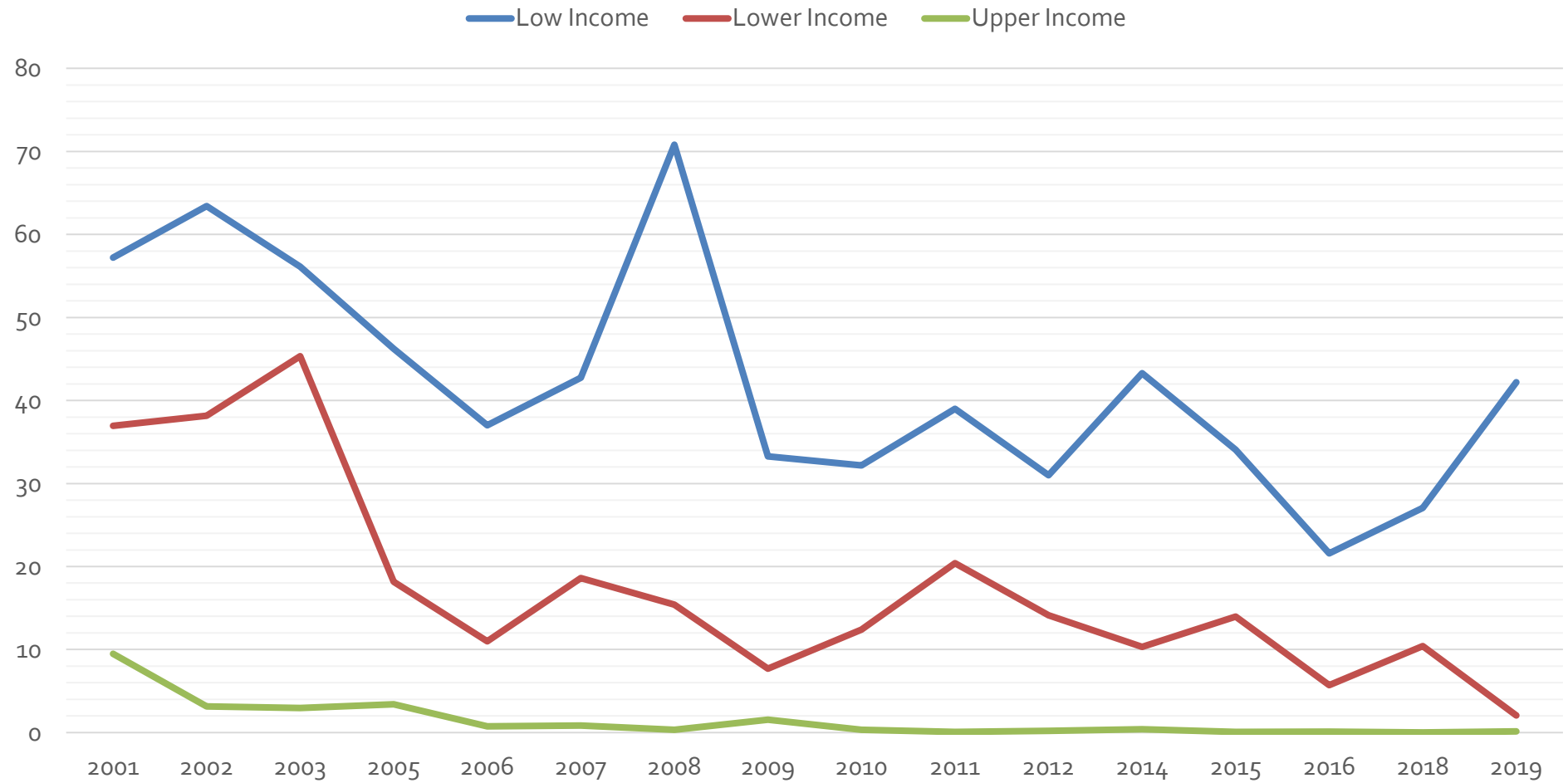
GDP Per Capita (PPP) in OIC Countries



Poverty Headcount Ratio at US\$2.15 a day (PPP) (% of Population)

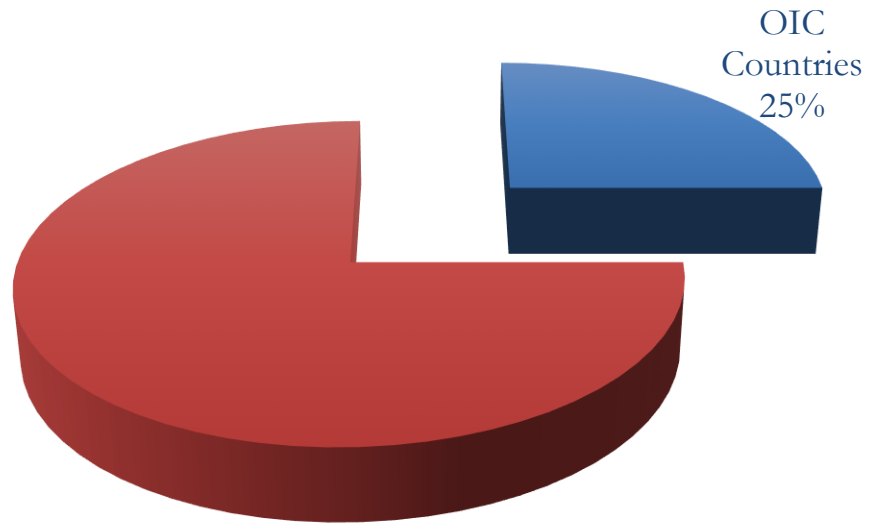


Poverty Headcount at US\$2.15 a day (PPP) (% of Pop.) in OIC

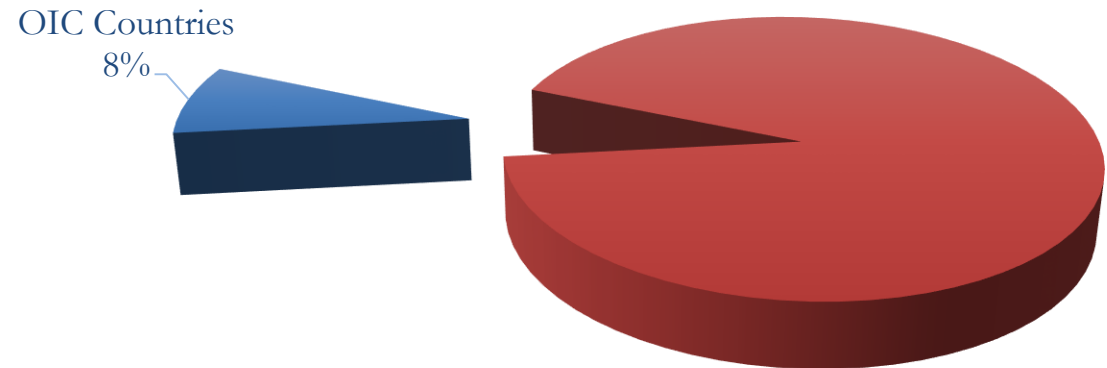

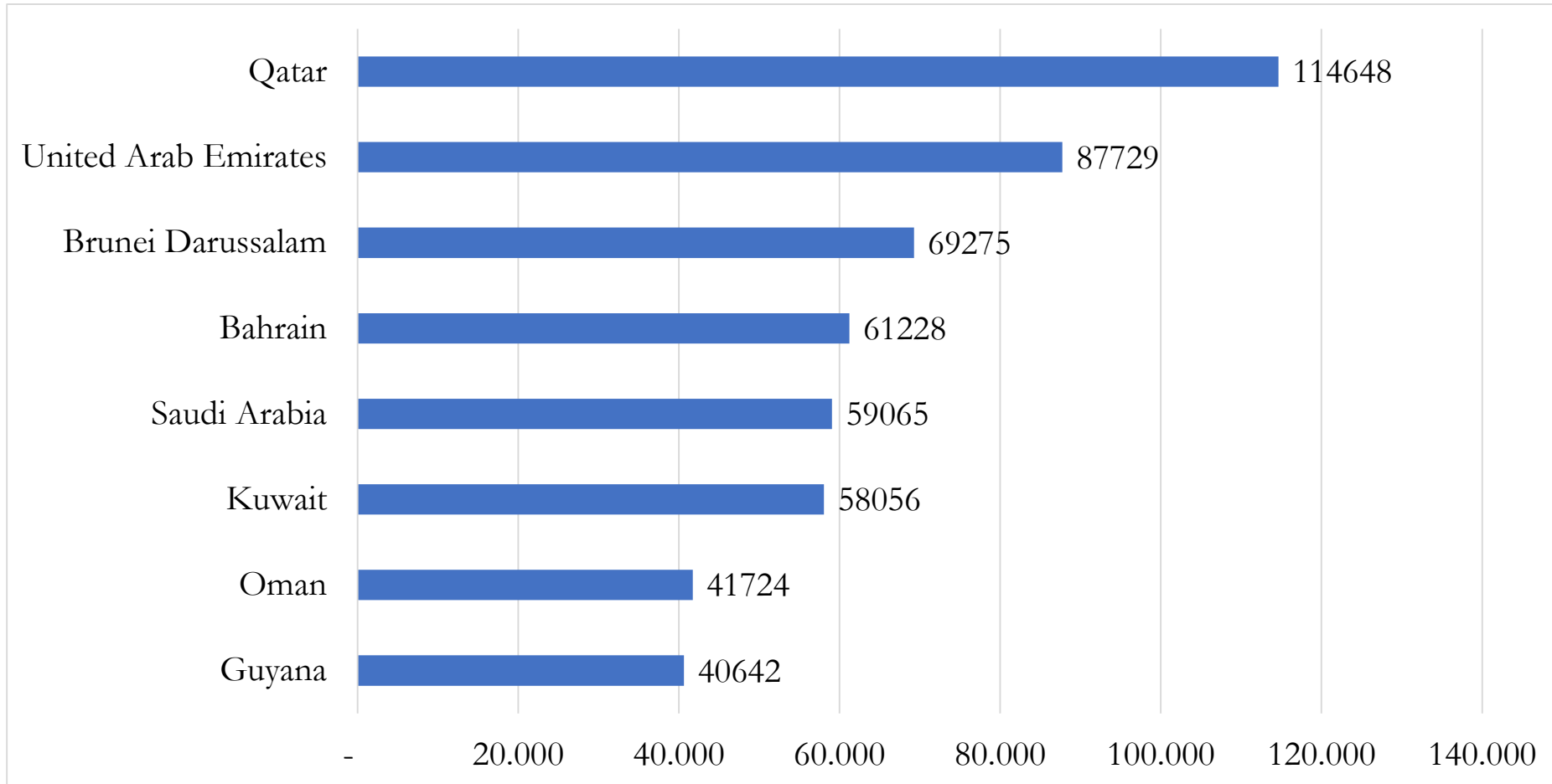

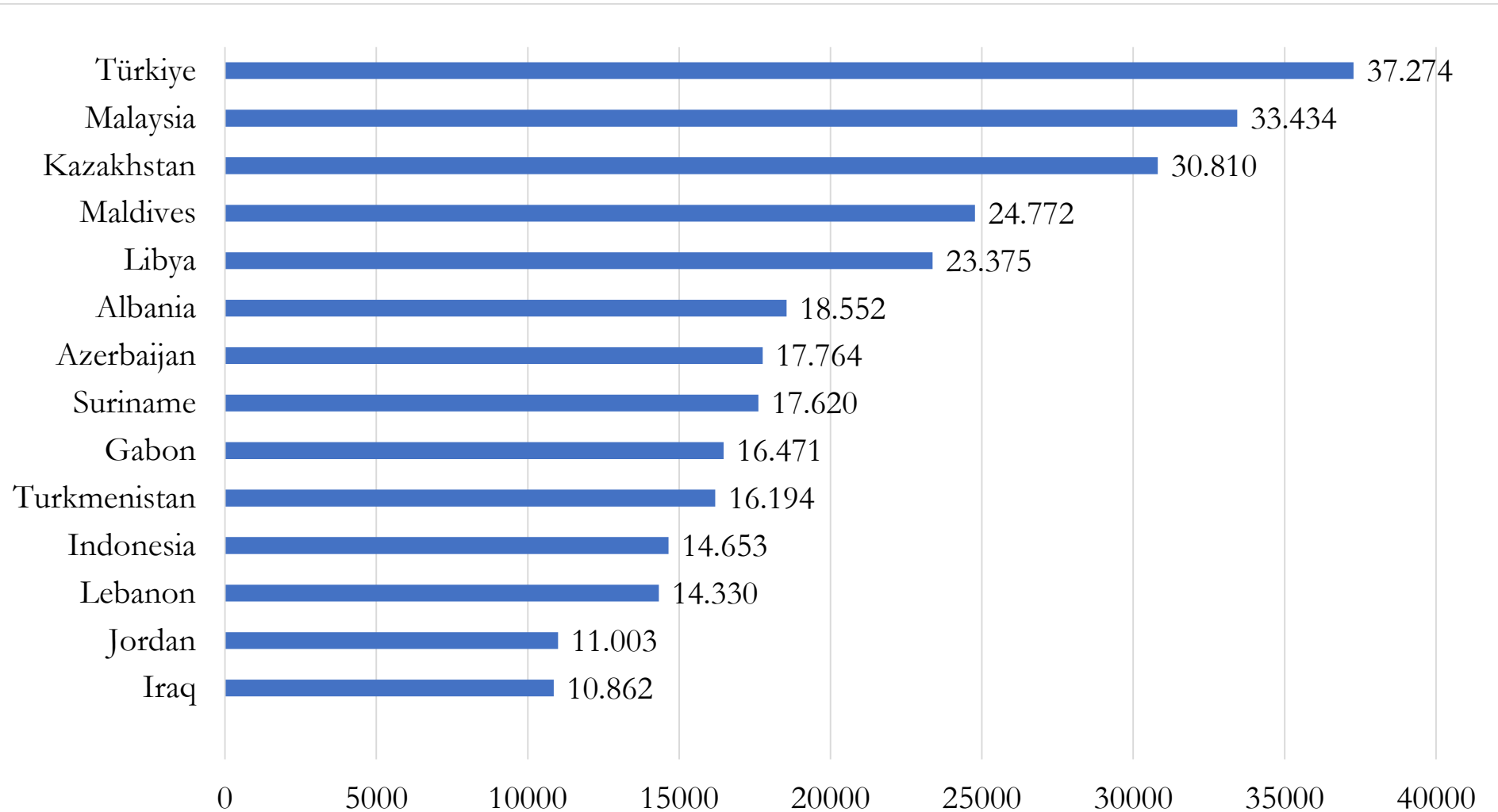

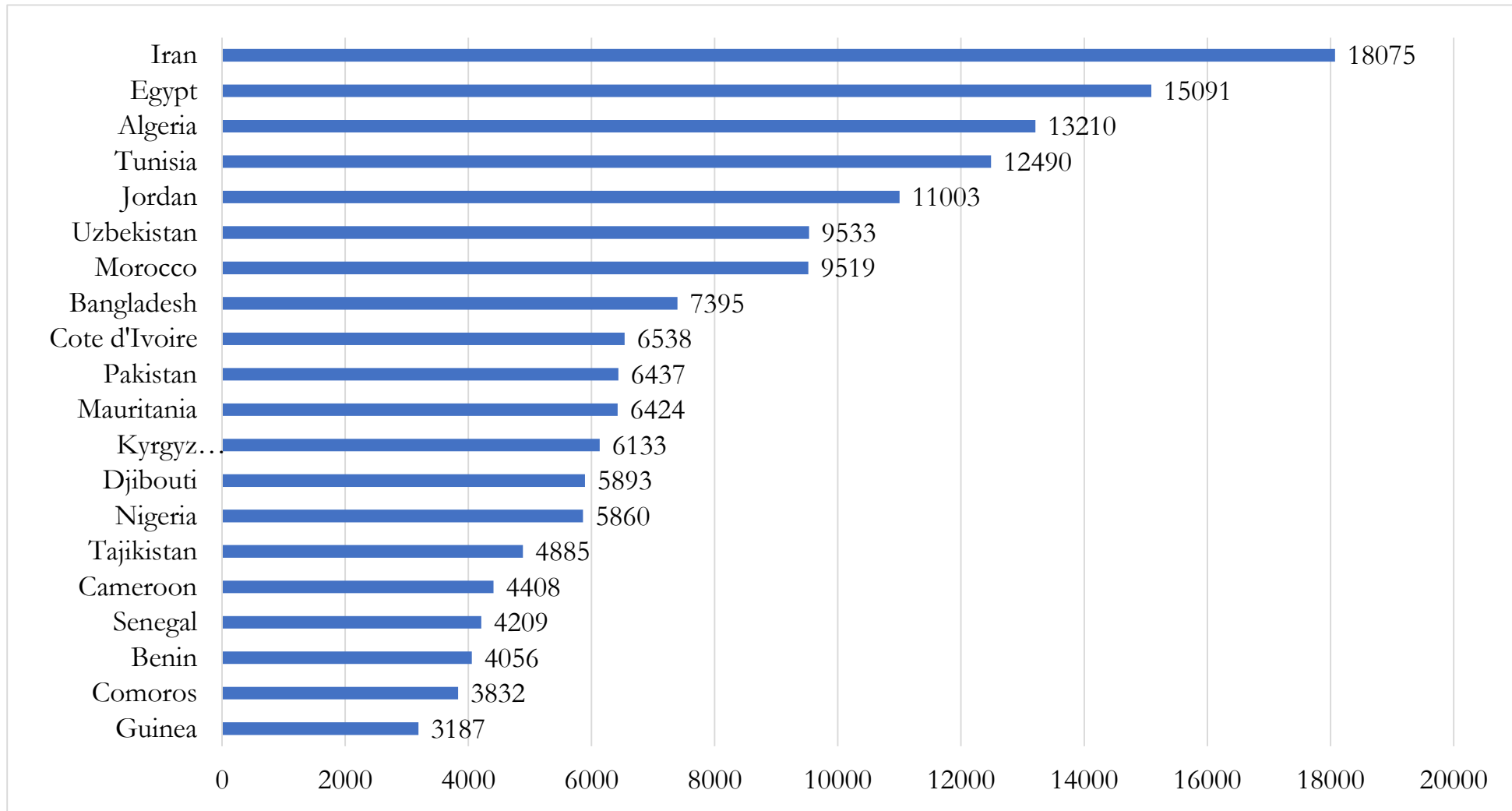
GDP Per Capita (PPP, Current Int. \$) in the High Income OIC Countries, 2022 – High Income Countries



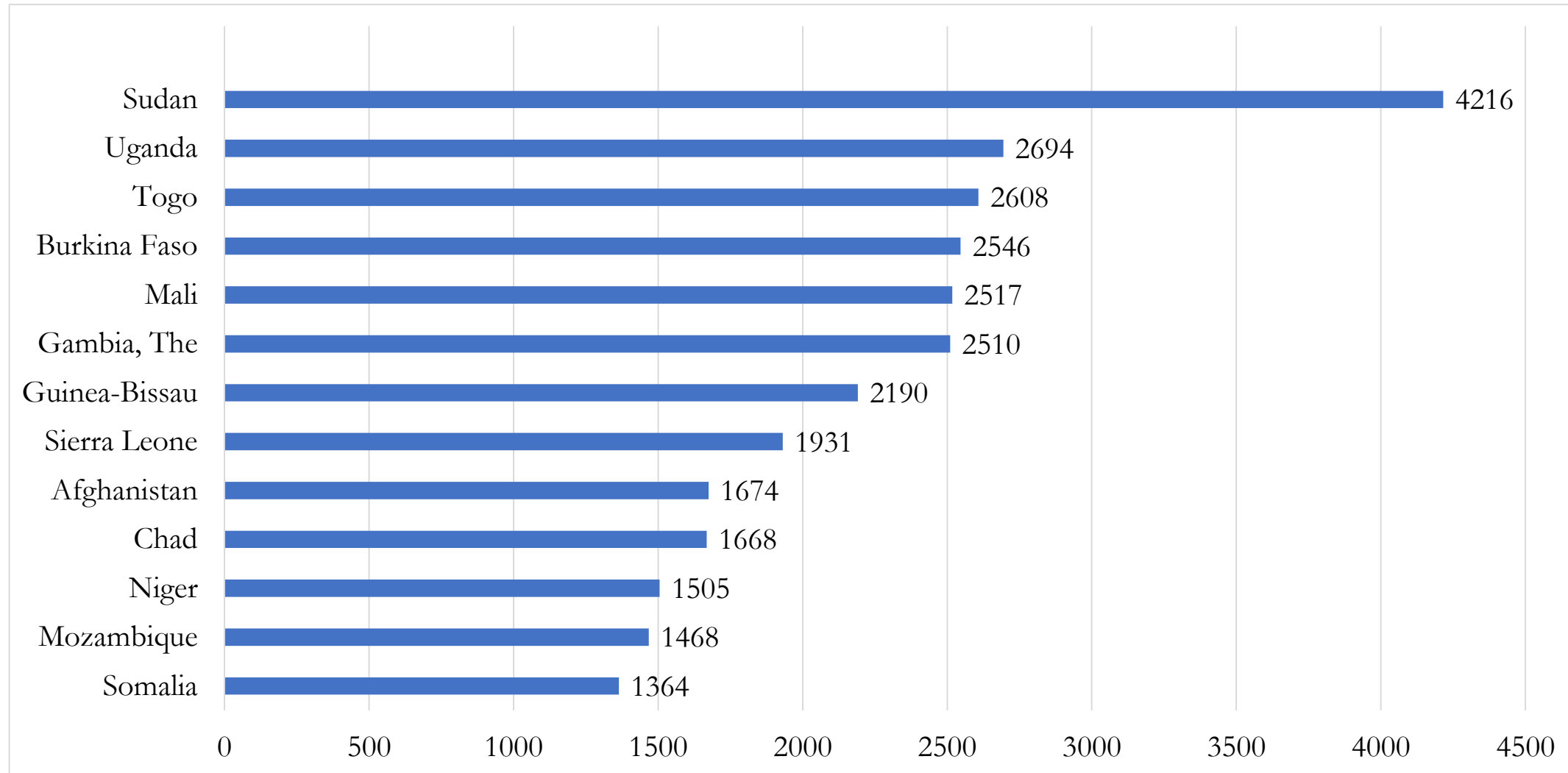
GDP Per Capita (PPP, Current Int. \$) in the High Income OIC Countries, 2022 – Upper Middle Income Countries



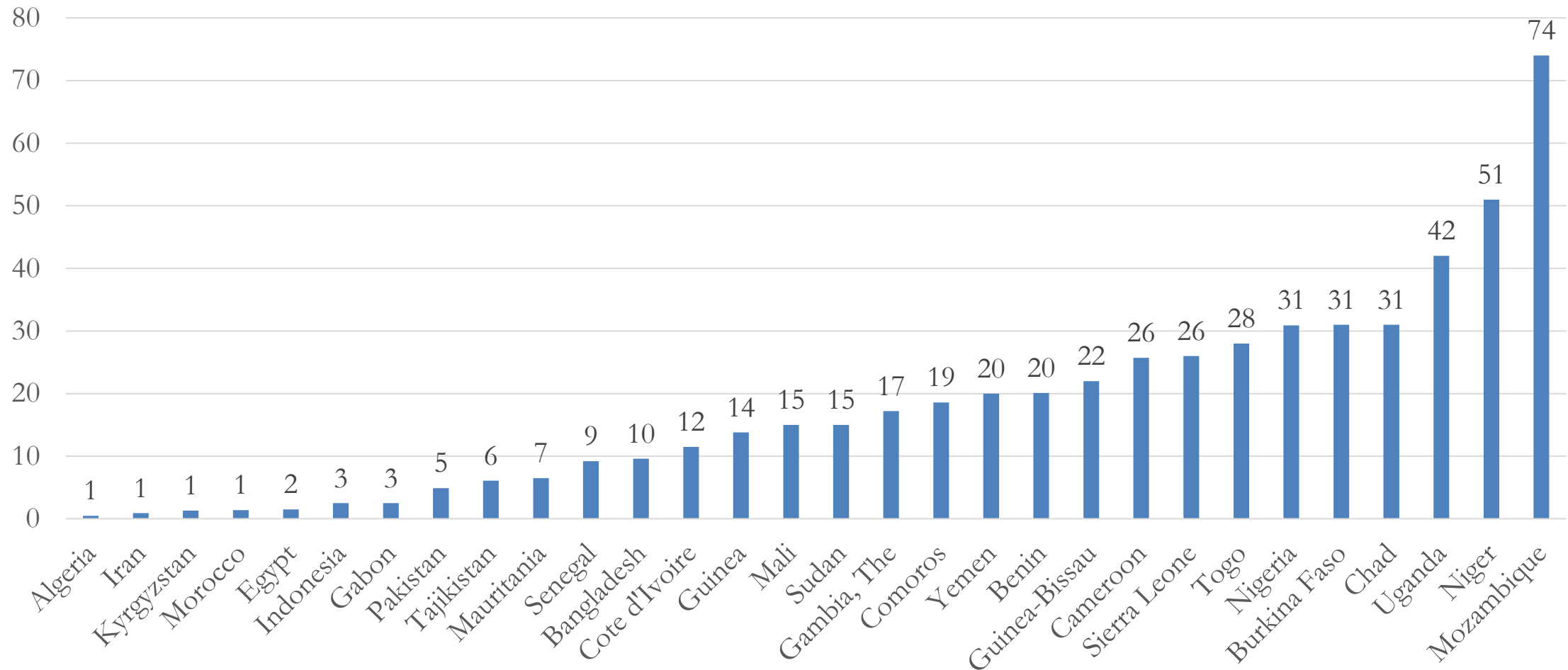
GDP Per Capita (PPP, Current Int. \$) in the High Income OIC Countries, 2022 – Lower Middle Income Countries



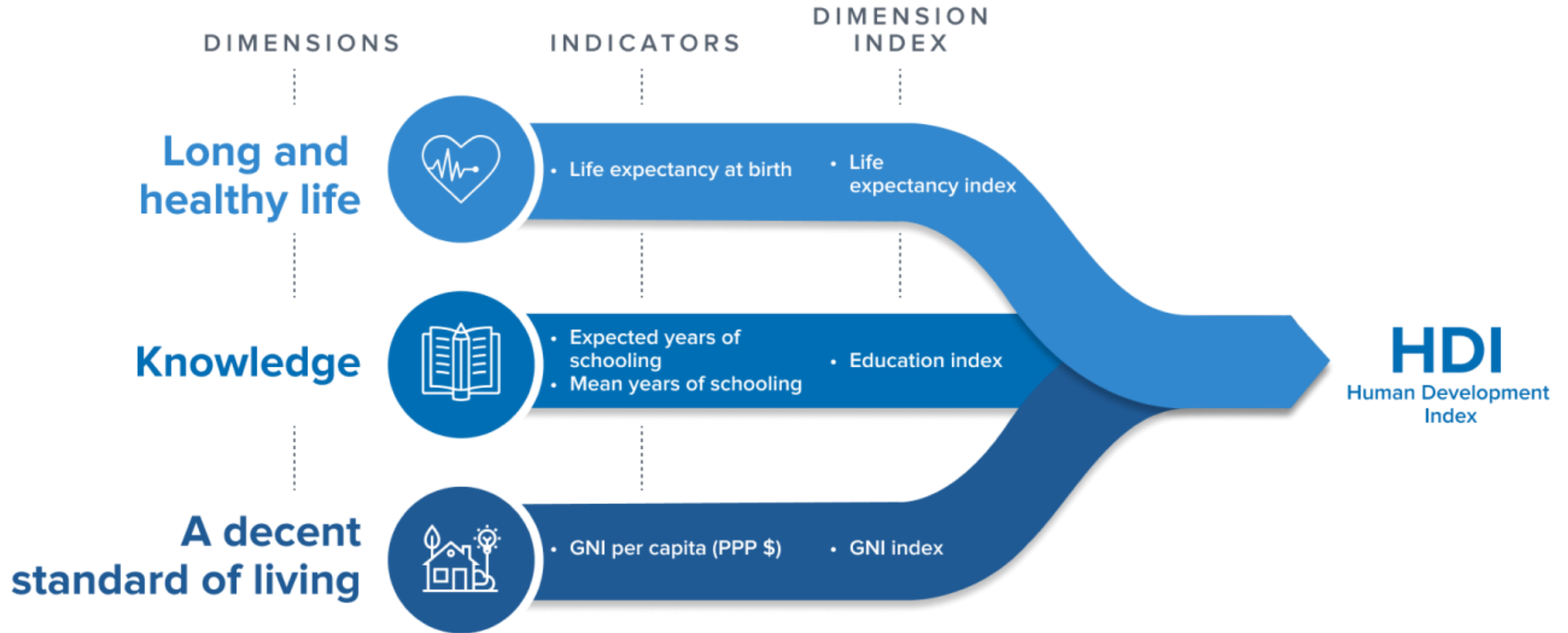

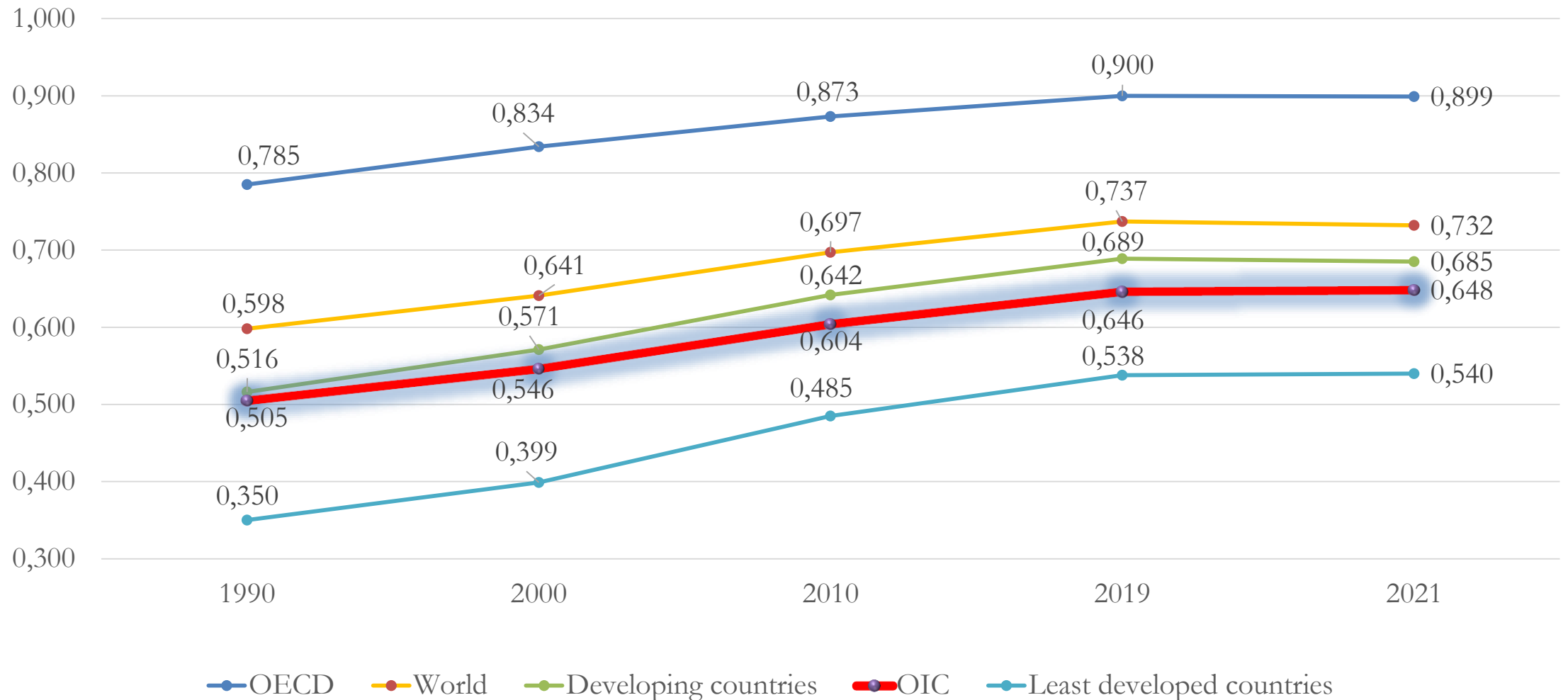
Poverty Headcount at US\$2.15 a day (PPP) (% of Pop.) in OIC



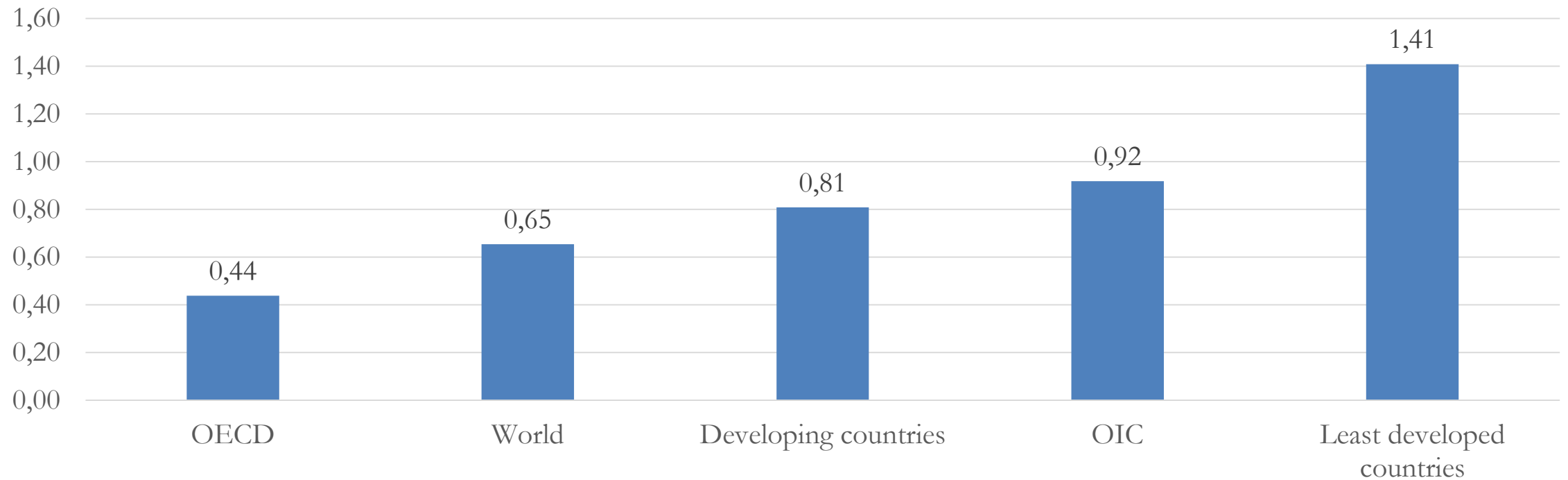

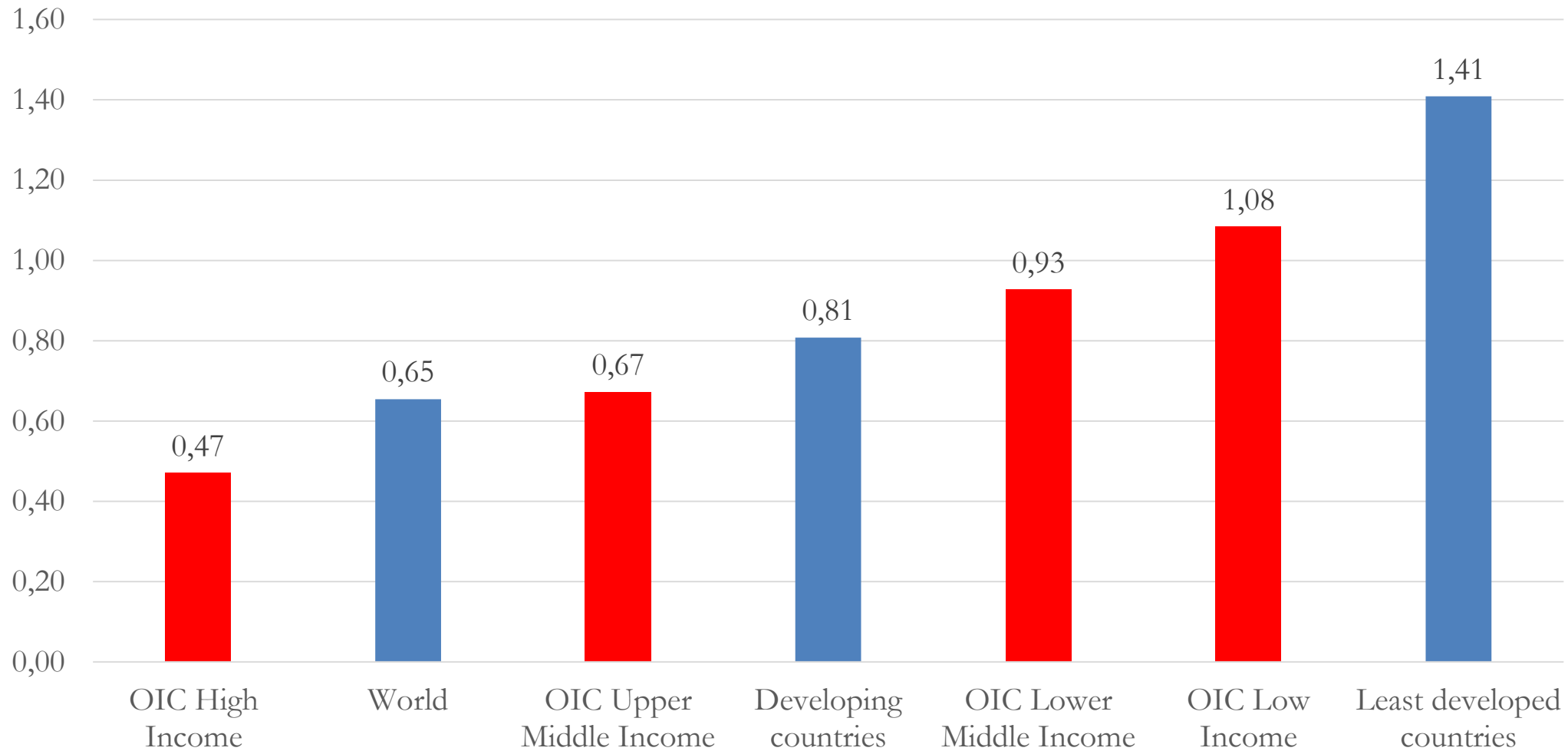
Trends in Human Development Index, 1990-2021



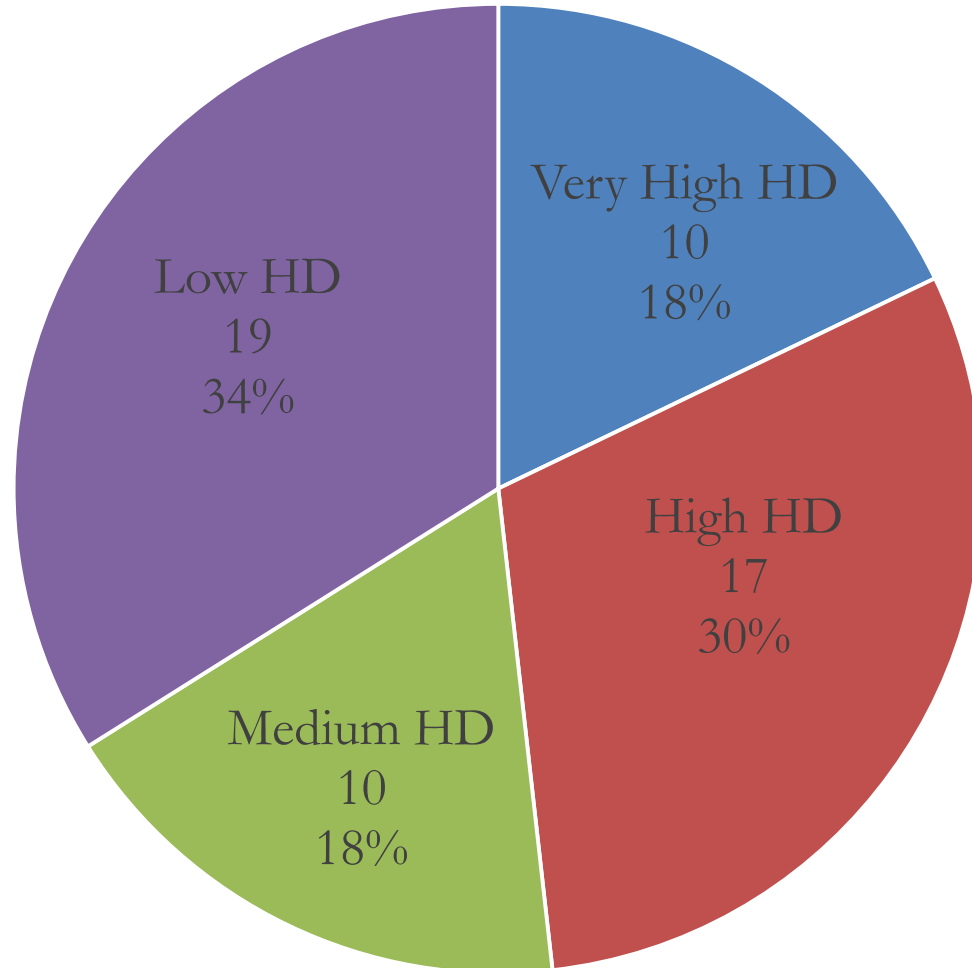
Annual growth rate in HDI between 1990 and 2021



Annual growth rate in HDI in OIC by income groups 1990-2021



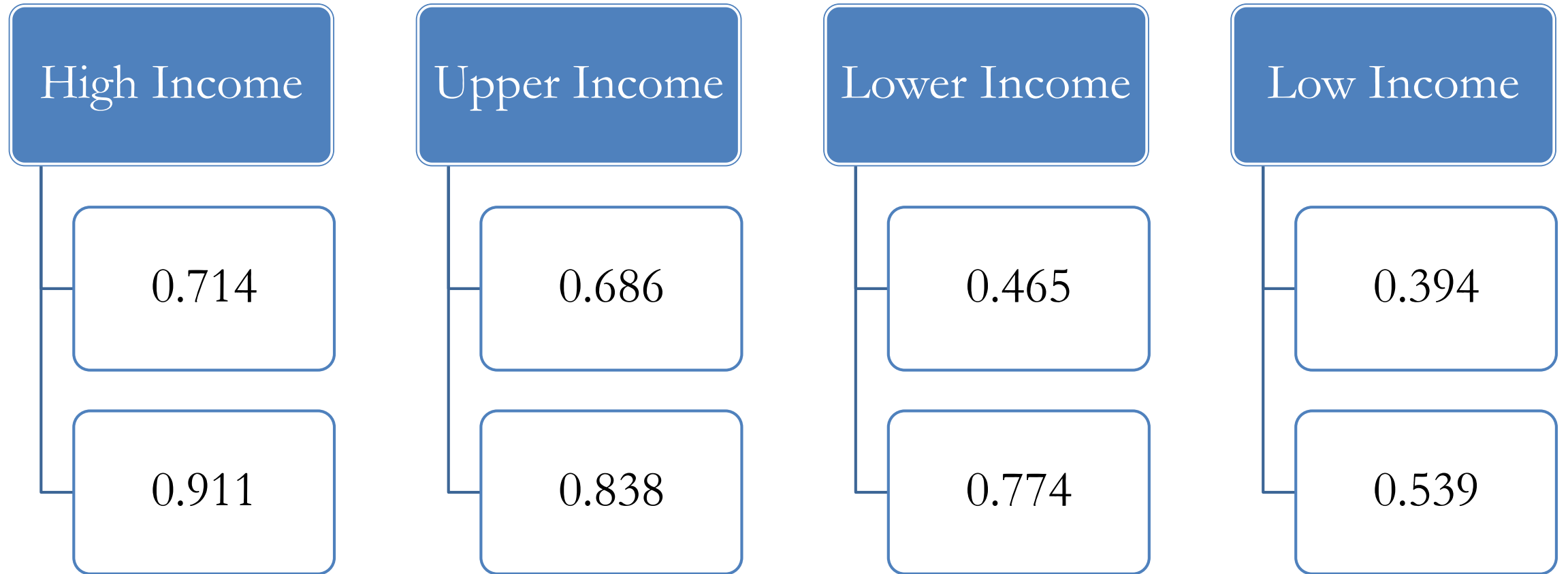

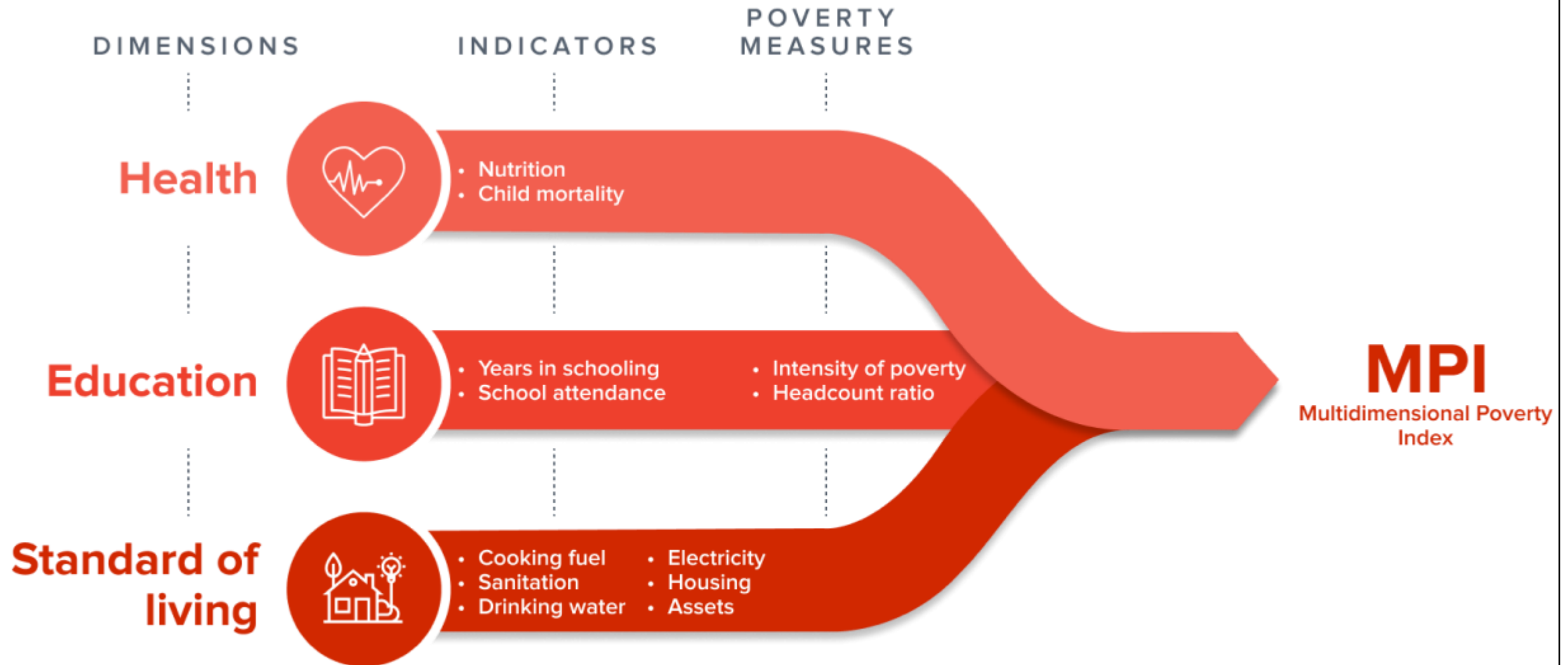

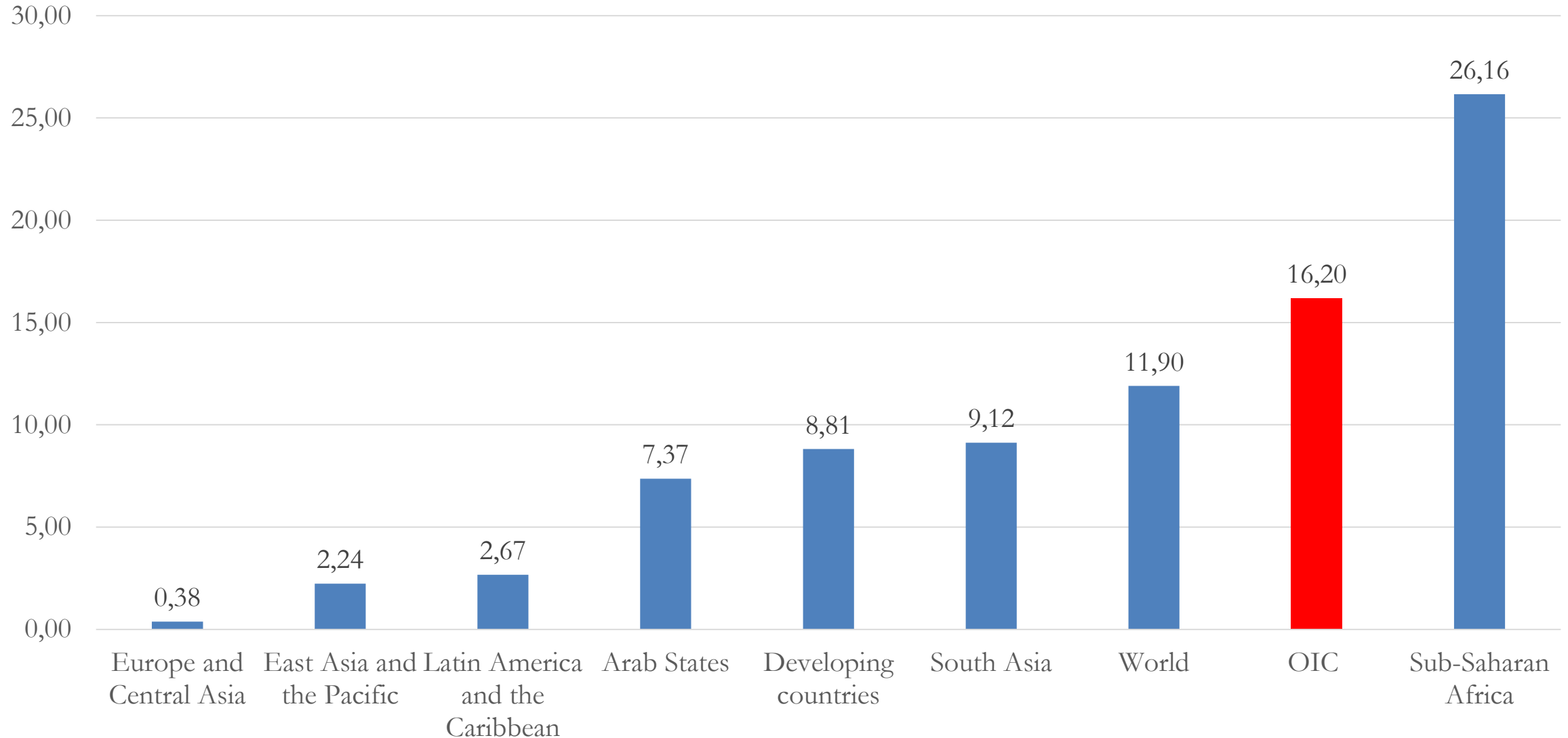

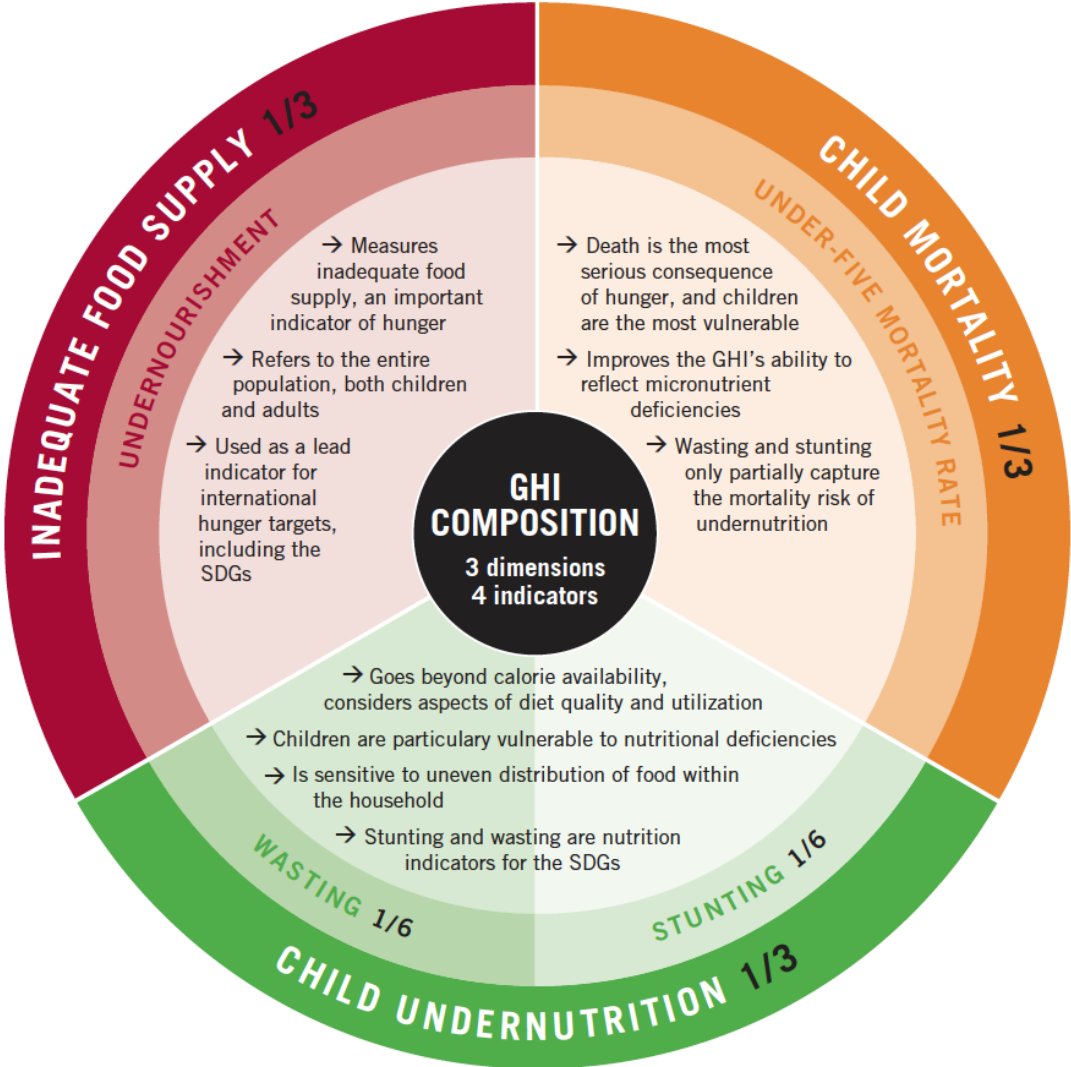
Multidimensional Poverty Index



Multidimensional Poverty by Region (%)

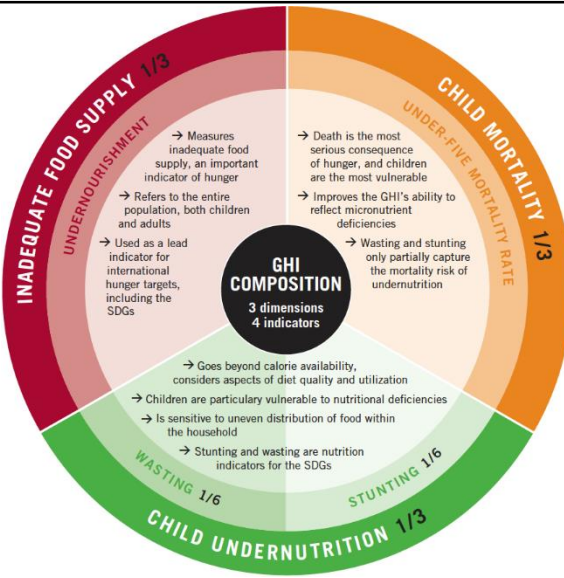
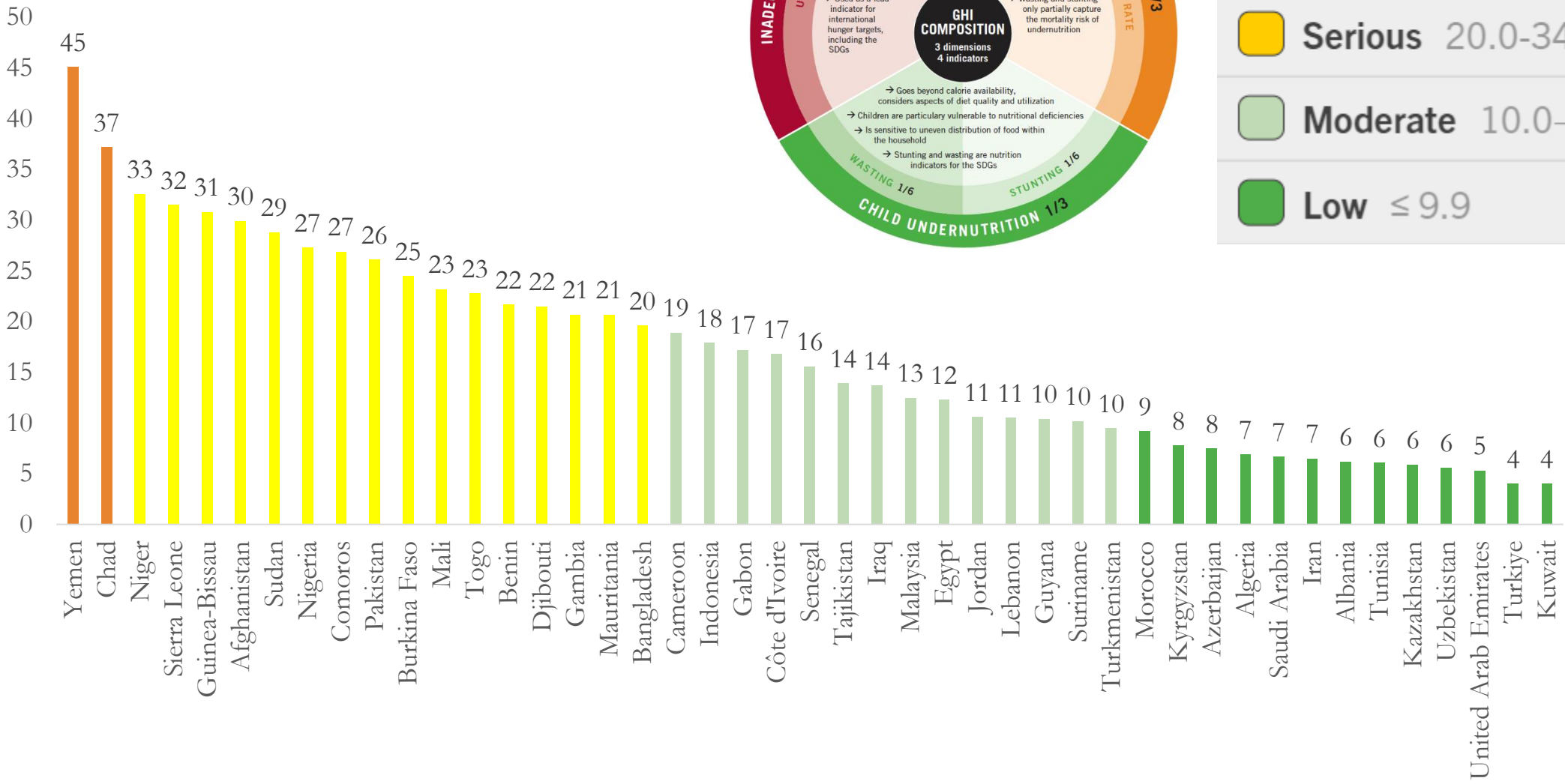

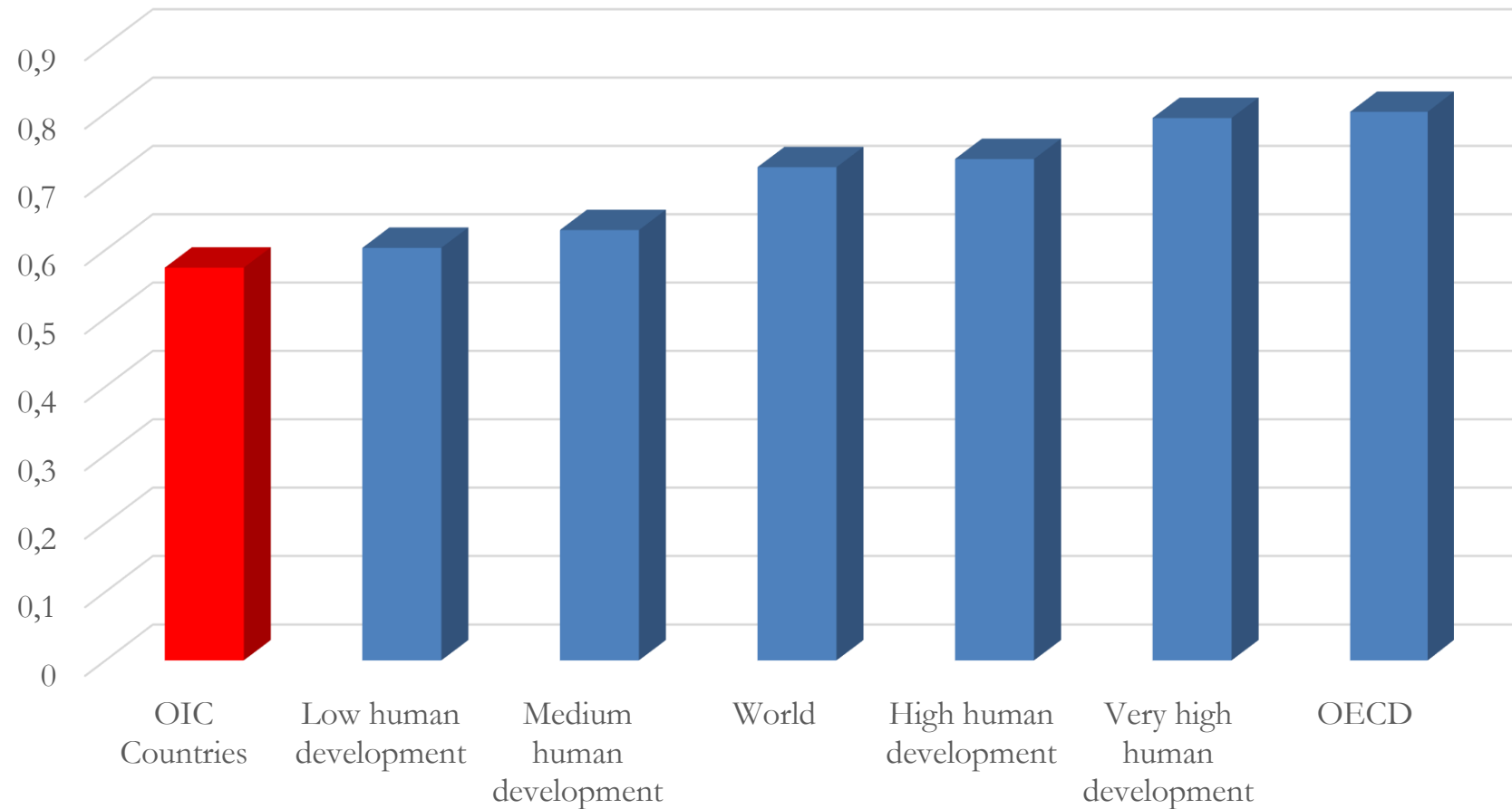

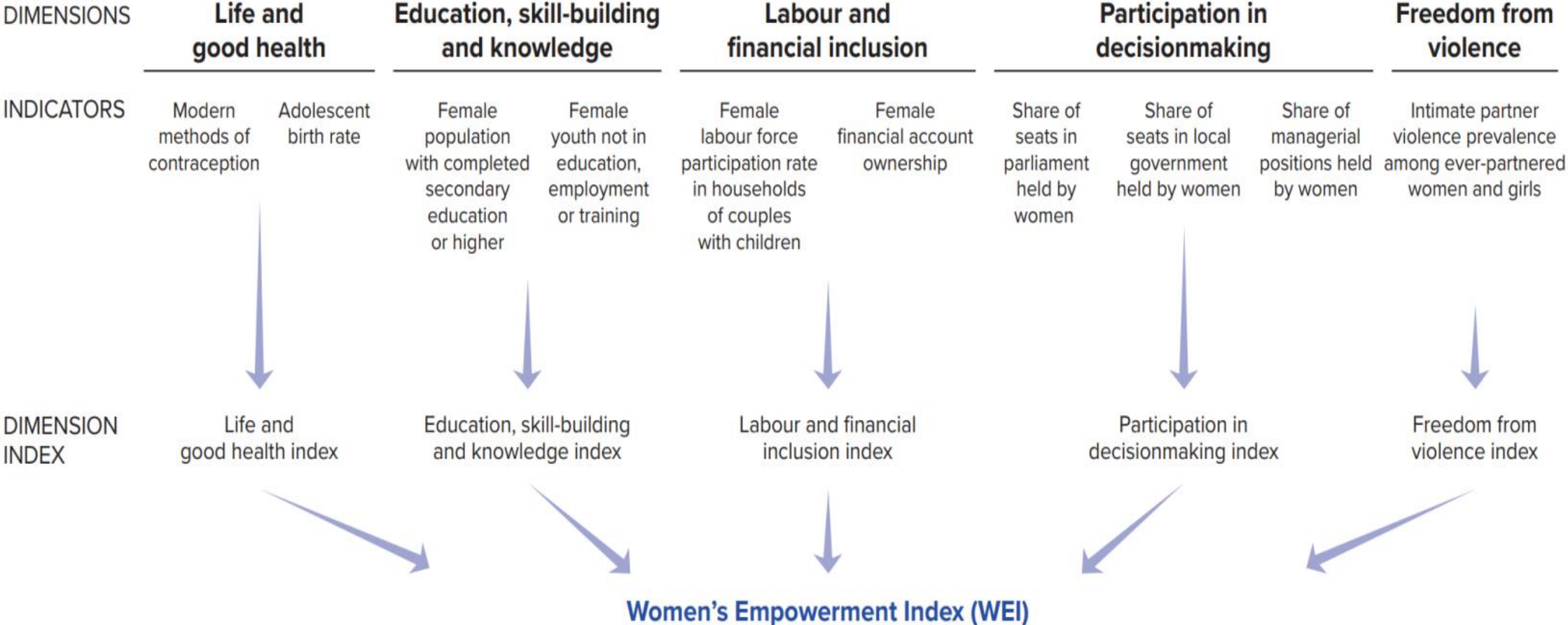

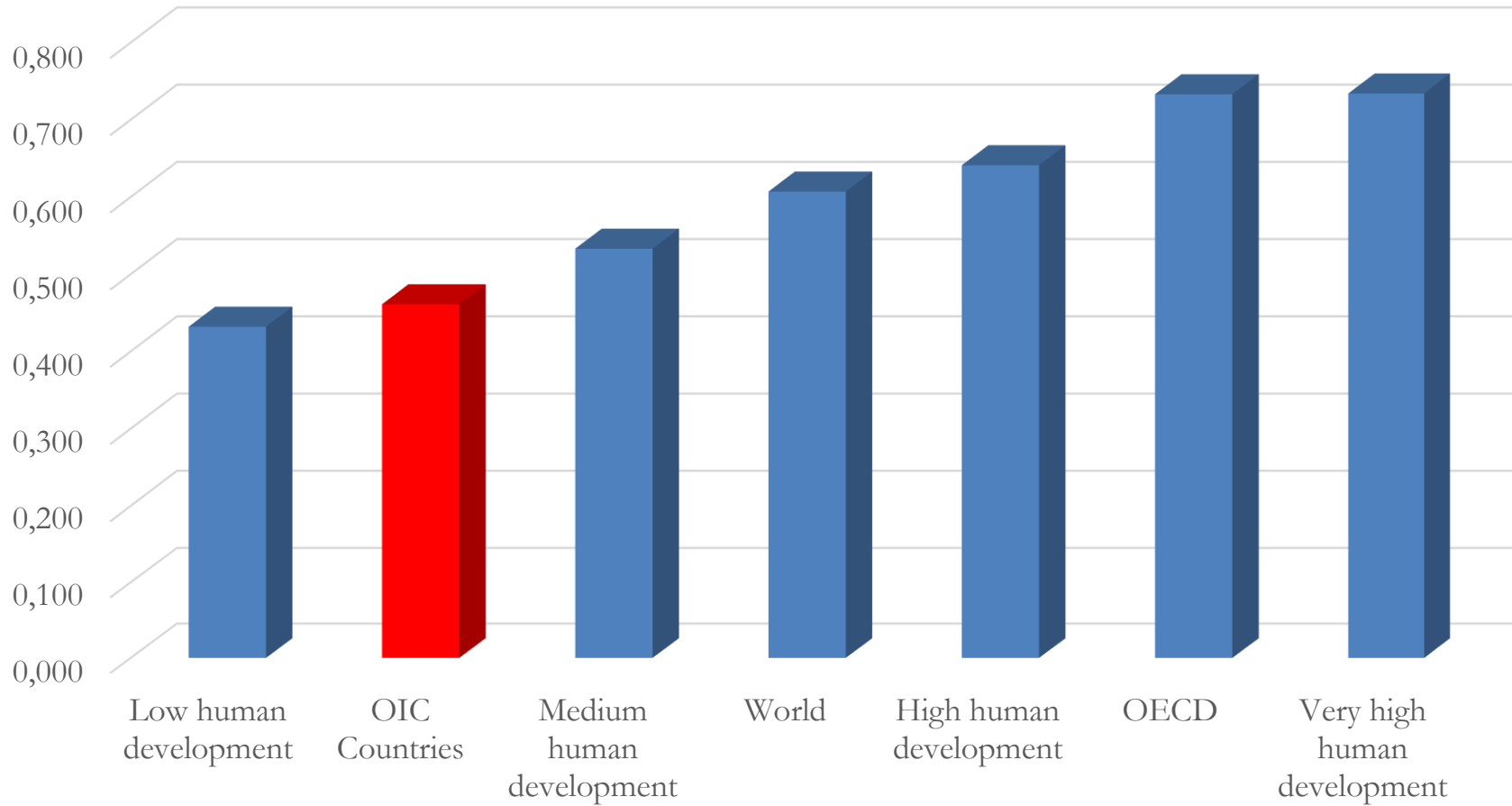
Global Gender Parity Index, 2022.

Summary

- The OIC Member Countries **do not form a homogenous group** in terms of poverty.
- **21 out of 46 Least Developed Countries** (LDCs) are members of the OIC.
- Although developing countries have recorded **considerable improvements in monetary and non-monetary poverty alleviation** in the last decades, poverty rates are still high for a sizeable number of countries.
- There is more than **377 million people** suffering from poverty in OIC Region.
- Achievements in poverty alleviation have been **adversely affected by the COVID-19**.
- Poverty alleviation is a **permanent agenda item and cooperation areas of the COMCEC**.
- Through the collaborative efforts and support of COMCEC, individual member states should continue working towards **sustainable development** that encompasses crucial aspects such as **health, education, a decent standard of living, the reduction of gender inequality, and the empowerment of women**.
