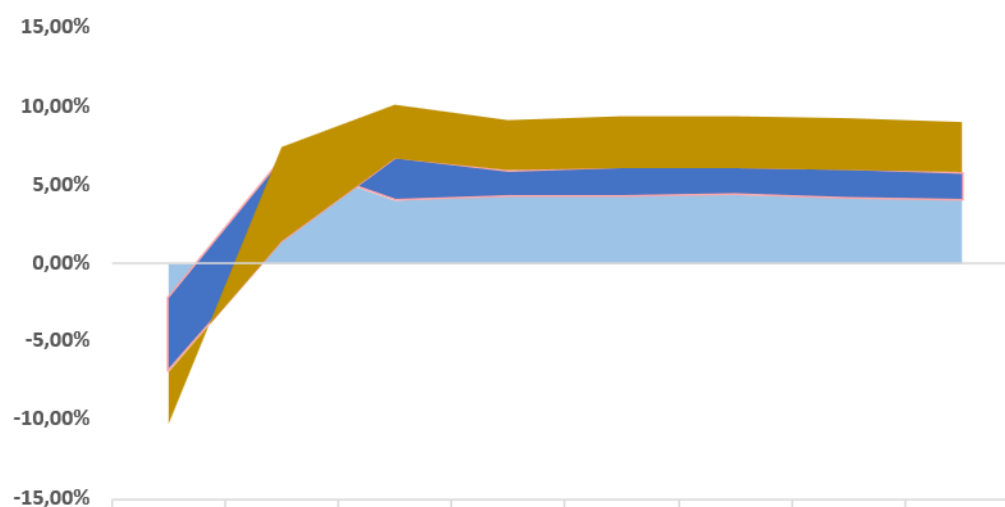

## I. RECENT DEVELOPMENTS IN THE GLOBAL ECONOMY

According to the IMF's January 2026 projections, global economic growth is expected to slow slightly by 0.1 percentage points between 2026 and 2027, falling from 3.3% to 3.2%, driven by the slowdown observed in advanced economies, where growth is projected to decline from 1.8% to 1.7%, as well as in emerging and developing economies, where it is projected to decline from 4.2% to 4.1% over the same period. This situation would also lead to a moderation in the global inflation rate of 0.4 percentage points between 2026 and 2027, as well as stability in global commodity prices.

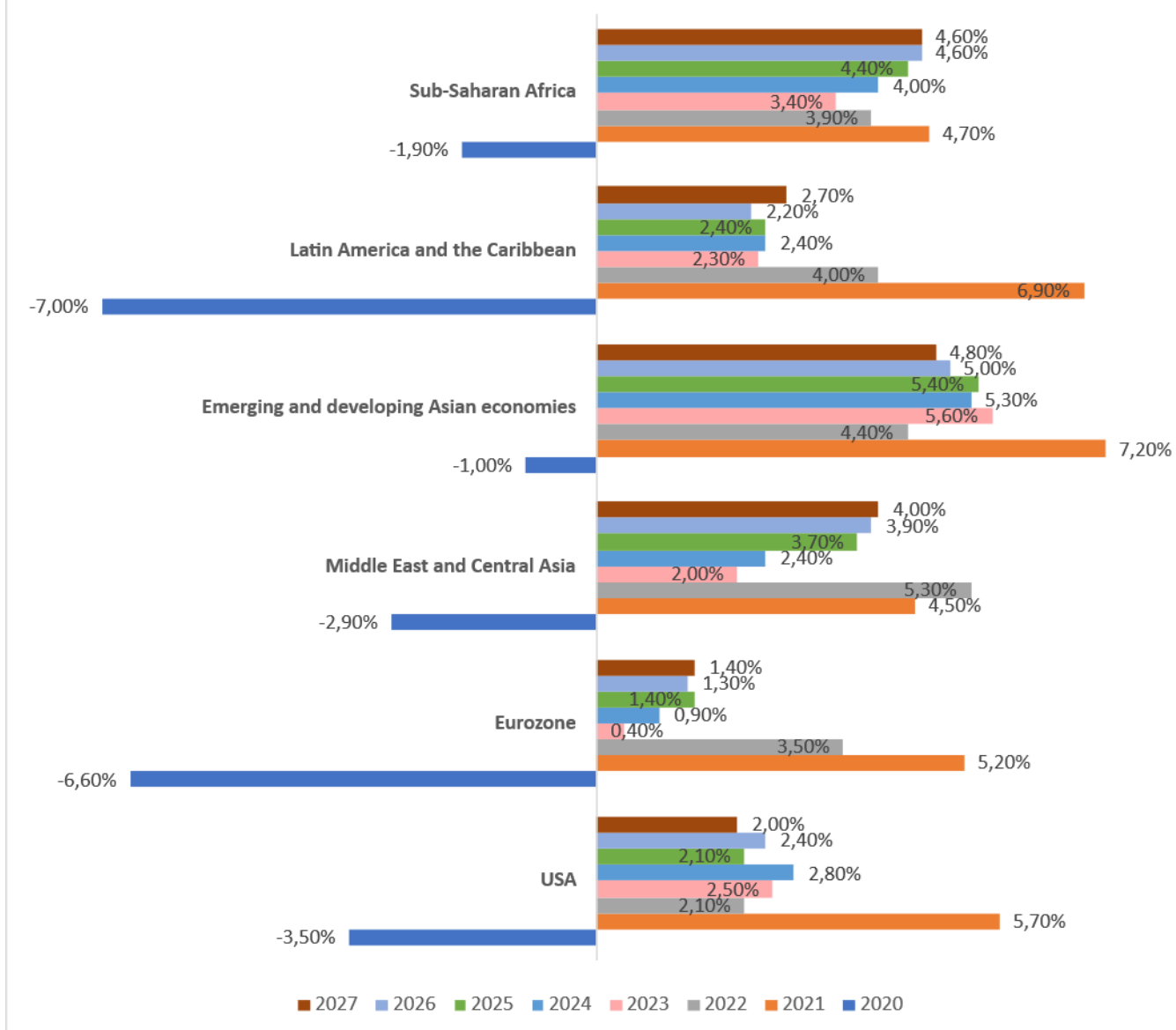
**Figure 1: Projected global economic growth between 2020 and 2027**

Between 2026 and 2027, economic growth is expected to pick up slightly in several regions. It is projected to rise from 1.3% to 1.4% in the euro area, from 3.9% to 4.0% in the Middle East, and from 2.2% to 2.7% in Latin America and the Caribbean. This trend is mainly driven by the gradual recovery of the global economy, the likely stability of energy prices, and a moderate rebound in investment. Nevertheless, this momentum remains fragile and is still exposed to risks such as geopolitical tensions, financial market volatility, and uncertainties related to developments in the international economic environment.

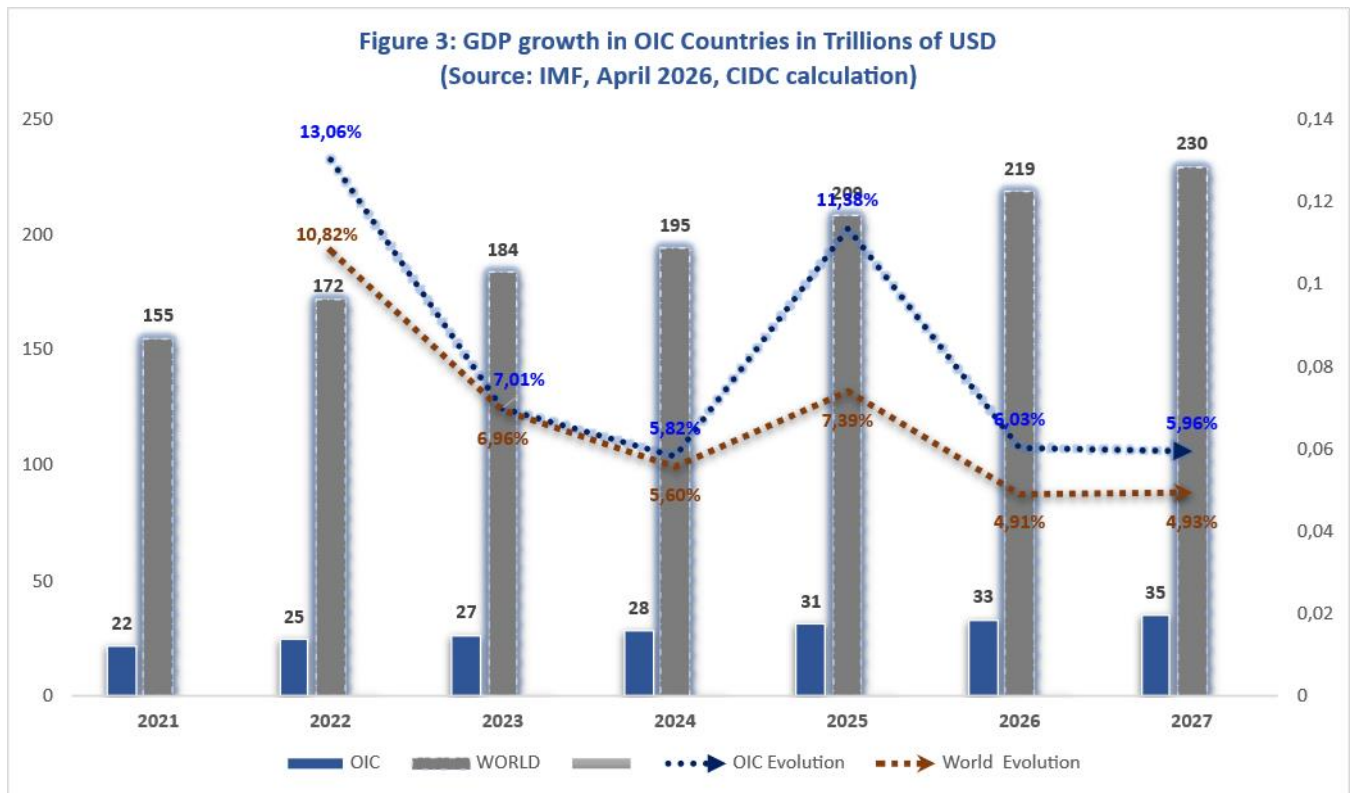
However, growth is expected to remain stable at 4.6% in Sub-Saharan Africa, resulting from a balance between supportive factors—such as resilient domestic demand and contributions from key sectors—and persistent constraints, notably inflationary pressures, high debt levels, and exposure to climate shocks.

In contrast, growth is expected to slow from 2.4% to 2.0% in the United States and from 5.0% to 4.8% in emerging and developing Asian countries, due to rising interest rates and weak external demand.

## 1. EVOLUTION OF THE GDP OF OIC MEMBER STATES

Between 2026 and 2027, OIC member states could see their GDP grow by approximately \$1.97 trillion, despite the various crises that have affected their economies. In fact, GDP could rise from 33.13 trillion USD in 2026 to 35.11 trillion USD in 2027, representing a 5.96% increase.

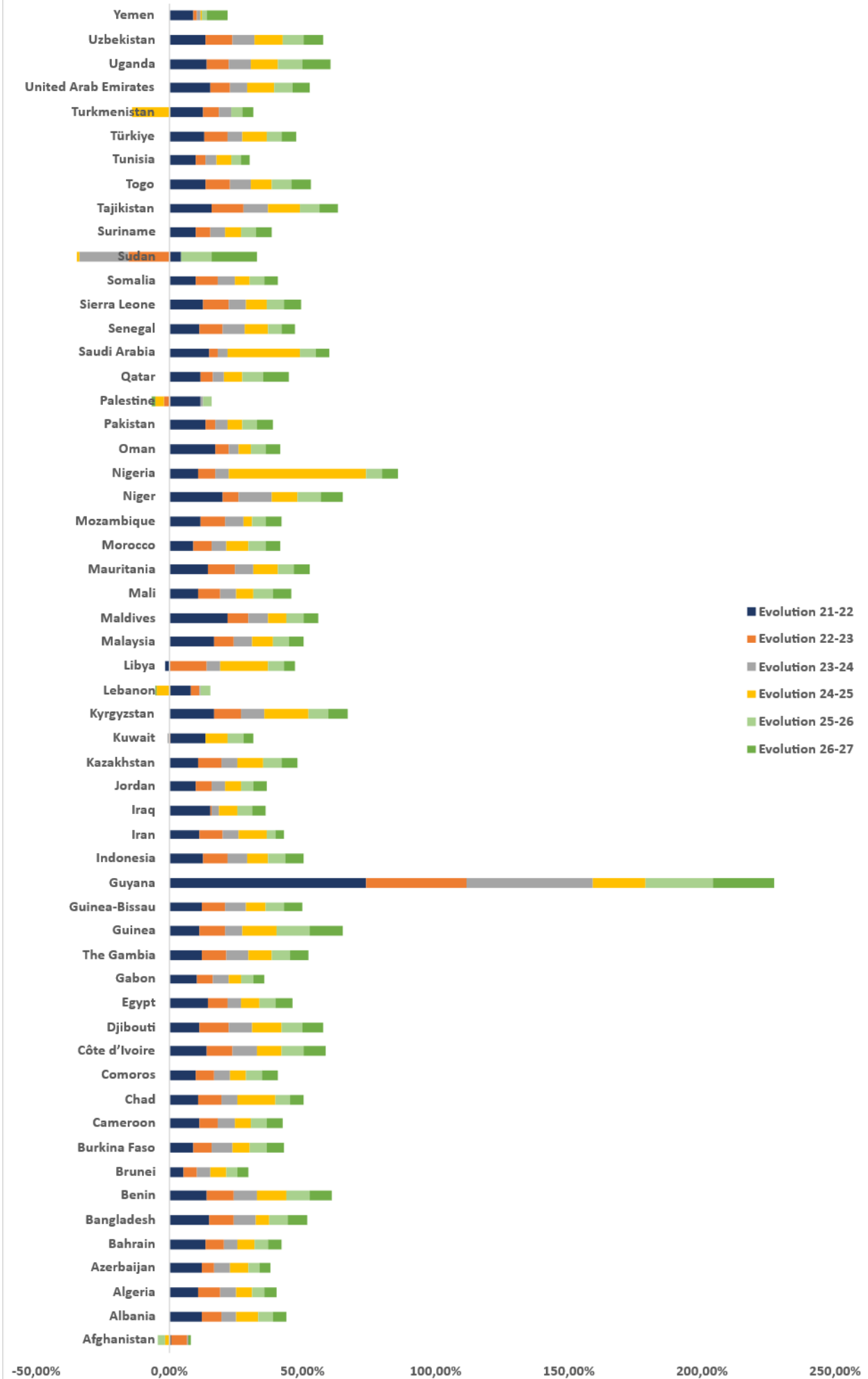
This growth could be attributed to the increase in GDP of more than 1.72 trillion USD recorded by the following member countries during this period: Indonesia, Türkiye, Egypt, Bangladesh, Saudi Arabia, Nigeria, Pakistan, Malaysia, the United Arab Emirates, Iran, Kazakhstan, Algeria, Qatar, Iraq, Uzbekistan, and Morocco.



To boost GDP growth in Member States, OIC institutions and their development partners have initiated several strategies, leading to the implementation of programs for the empowerment of women and youth, food and health security, investment attraction and the development of regional value chains.

Figure 4: GDP Growth Trends in OIC Member States between 2022 and 2027 (in %)

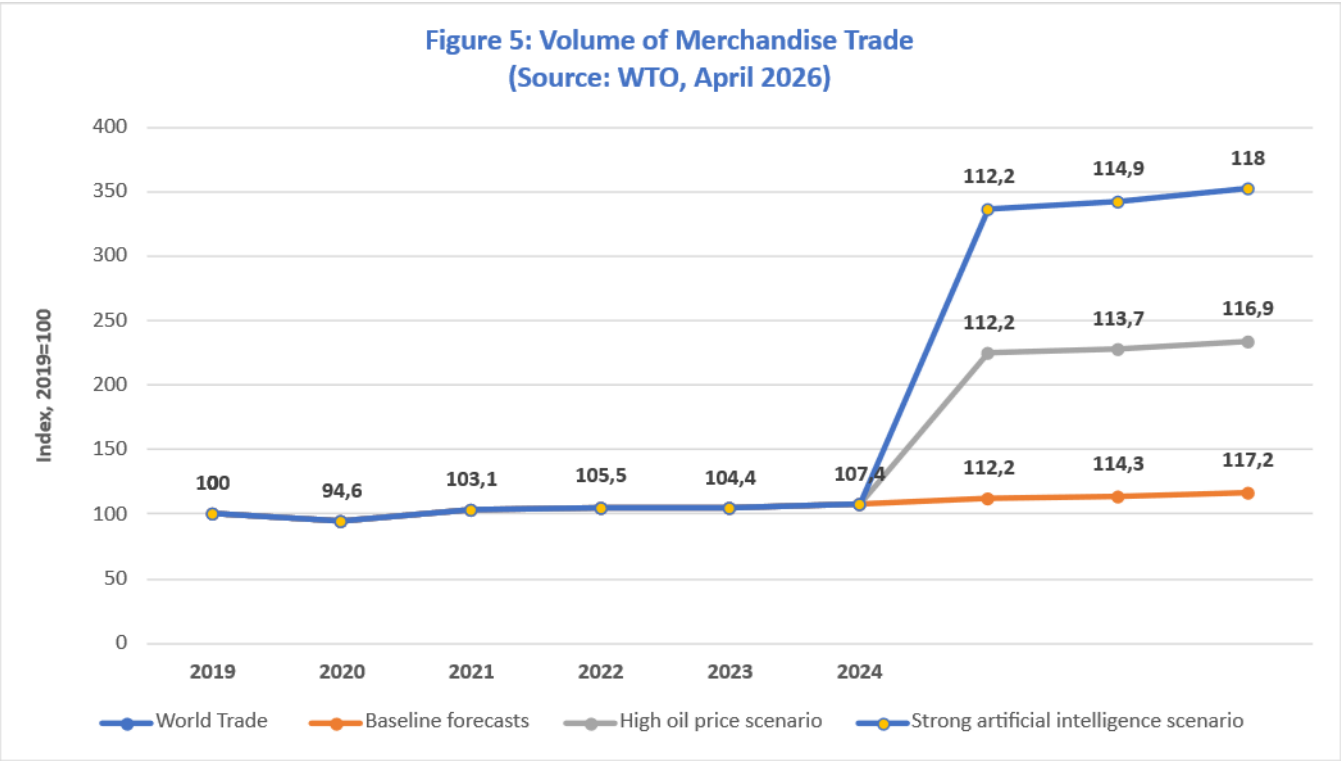

## 2. WORLD TRADE EVOLUTION

According to the WTO’s April 2026 forecast, global trade in goods and services grew by 4.7% in 2025, driven by strong demand for AI-related goods. However, the volume of global merchandise trade is expected to slow in 2026, falling from 4.6% in 2025 to 1.9% in 2026 before rebounding to 2.6% in 2027; at the same time, the volume of trade in services is expected to grow from 4.3% in 2025 to 4.8% in 2026, and then to 5.1% in 2027.

This assessment is primarily driven by a mix of contrasting factors, including rising tariffs, the impact of geopolitical tensions in the Middle East on transportation and energy costs—particularly disrupting maritime and air links—as well as strong demand for artificial intelligence-related goods and increased uncertainties surrounding trade policies.



In 2025, global merchandise trade, measured in current U.S. dollars, grew by 7%, reaching nearly \$26 trillion. This growth was primarily driven by fluctuations in commodity prices, a recovery in global demand, improvements in supply chains, and the lingering effects of inflation on the prices of traded goods.

The value of trade in commercial services increased by 8%, reaching \$9.56 trillion. This growth was driven by the recovery in transportation and travel services, the expansion of digital and technology services, and growth in financial and professional services.

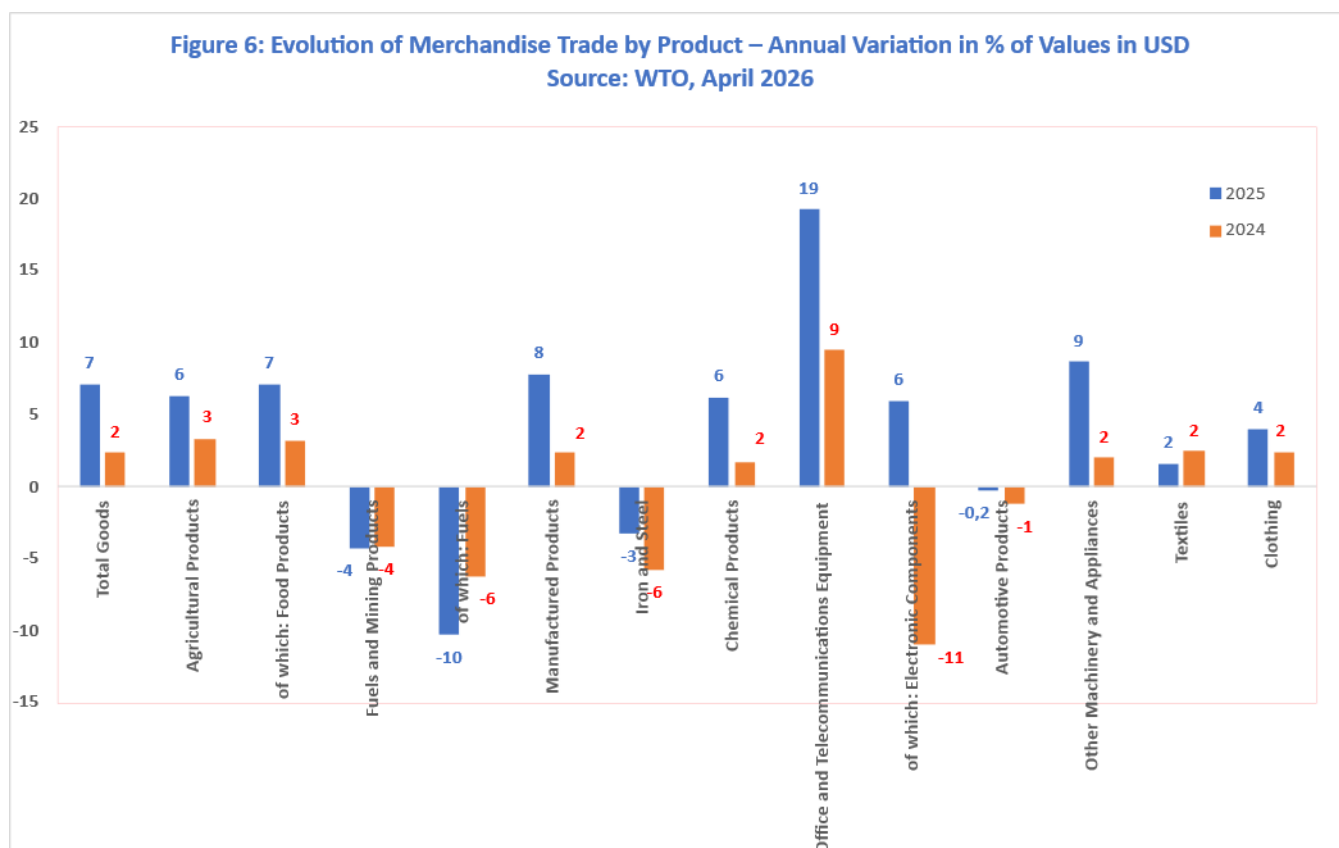
According to the WTO, the structure of global merchandise trade in 2025 remains largely dominated by manufactured goods, which account for between 65% and 70% of the total value of trade.

Fuels and mining products rank second, with a share of between 20% and 25%, reflecting the importance of the energy and raw materials markets in international trade.

In contrast, agricultural products continue to account for a smaller share, estimated at between 8% and 10% of total value.

The highest annual growth rates were recorded for office and telecommunications equipment (+19%), followed by other machinery (+9%) and food products (+7%). Among the main product groups presented, only fuels and mining products (-4%), including fuels (-10%), iron and steel (-3%), and automotive products (-0.2%), experienced declines in value.

Global trade in fuels fell by 10% in value, while prices dropped by 8% over the same period, indicating a slight contraction in volume.

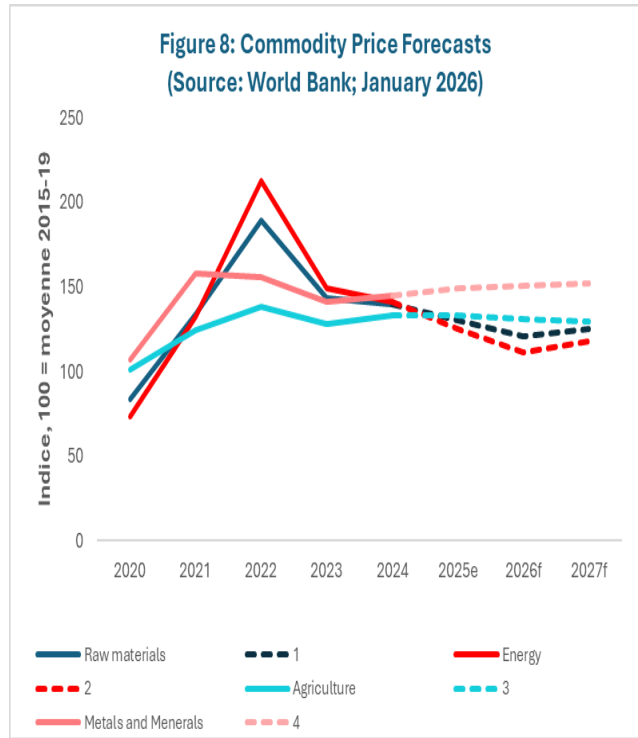
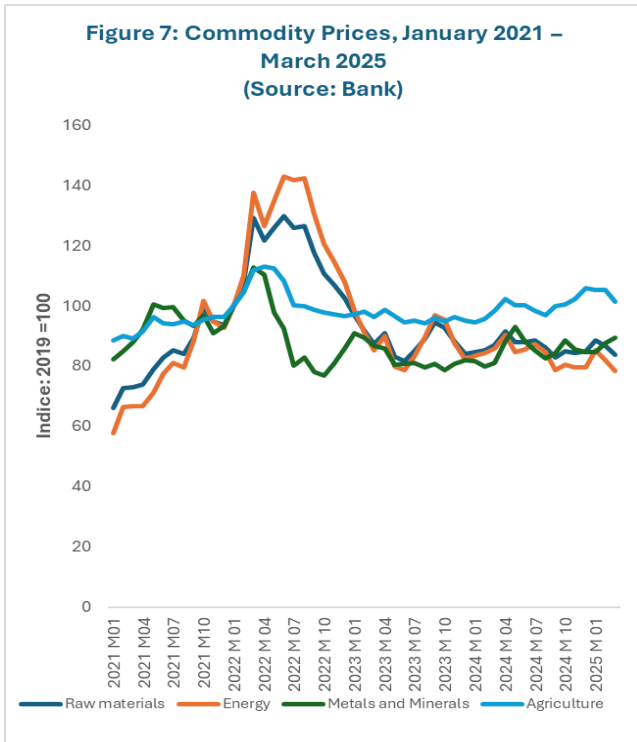


According to the outlook published by the World Bank in January 2026, global commodity prices are expected to continue their downward trend in the short term before beginning a slight recovery.

Indeed, the global commodity price index is projected to decline by approximately 7% in 2026, following a decline of similar magnitude in 2025. This trend reflects a gradual rebalancing of supply and demand, particularly in energy markets. In the medium term, a slight price recovery of around 4% is expected in 2027, reflecting a gradual normalization of market conditions, linked to the ultimately less pronounced impact of restrictive trade measures on global economic activity.

For energy products, prices are projected to decline by an estimated 10% in 2026. The price of Brent crude oil averaged \$69 per barrel in 2025 and is expected to fall to around \$60 per barrel in 2026, driven by excess supply in the oil market and moderate global demand.

Meanwhile, other commodity categories show more mixed trends. Industrial metals are expected to remain relatively stable, supported by demand linked to the energy and industrial transitions, while precious metals are projected to rise by 5% in 2026, driven by increased demand for safe-haven assets amid uncertainty.



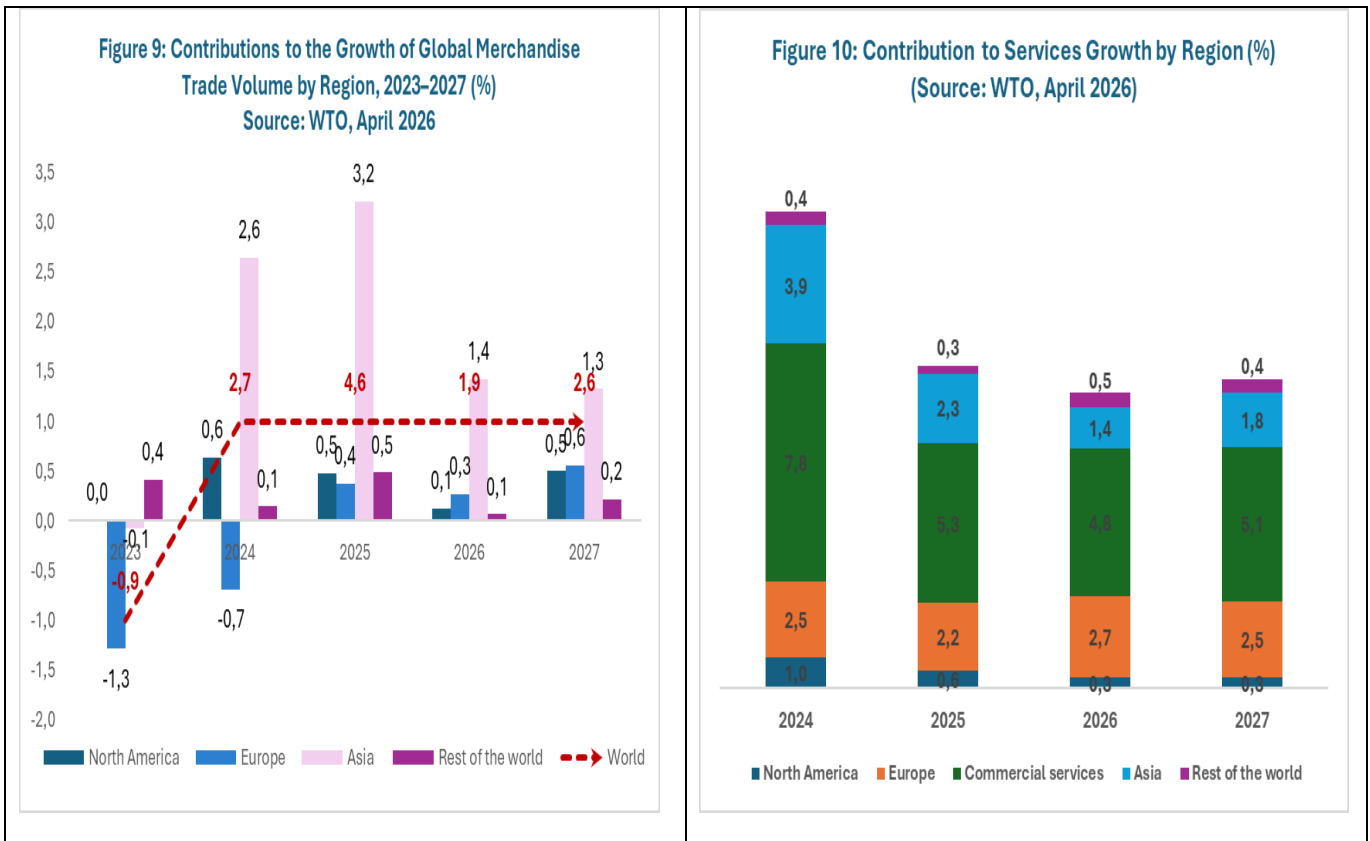
### 3. TRENDS IN REGIONAL TRADE

According to the WTO's April 2026 Outlook, the contributions of different regions to global merchandise trade growth in 2026 continue to show significant disparities, reflecting contrasting economic dynamics among the major geographic regions.

Global GDP is projected to grow by 2.8% in 2026, with stronger growth in Africa (4.3%), in Asia (3.9%), and in the Middle East (3.3%), followed by South America (2.4%), North America (2.3%), the CIS (1.8%), and Europe (1.6%).

This trend in GDP growth is expected to be driven primarily by increased exports from Asia and South America (3.5%), followed by North America (1.4%), the CIS (1.3%), and Africa (1.2%). In contrast, exports from the Middle East are expected to slow sharply (0.6%), while those from Europe would continue to stagnate (0.5%).

Regarding merchandise imports, Asia is projected to record the strongest growth in volume (3.3%), followed by Africa (3.2%). South America (2.5%), Europe (1.3%), and the Middle East (1.0%). Imports from North America are expected to remain stable (0.3%), while those from the CIS are projected to decline (-2.0%).



## II. OREIGN TRADE TRENDS OF OIC MEMBER STATES

### 1. EVOLUTION OF TRADE

According to data compiled by DOTS, the IMF, WITS, and the ITC in April 2026, as well as calculations by the CIDC, the volume of global merchandise trade increased by 11% between 2024 and 2025, rising from \$47.36 trillion in 2024 to \$52.56 trillion in 2025. This increase is attributable to the global economic recovery, rising global exports, developments in regional and international trade agreements, and the stabilization of commodity prices.

In contrast, the economies of OIC member states have demonstrated resilience in recent years, thanks to the measures implemented and the strengthening of bilateral and regional economic cooperation, particularly in the areas of food and medical supplies, the stability of commodity prices, and the rise in exports from producer countries to international markets. As a result, global trade among OIC member states recorded a significant increase of 3.23%, rising from \$4.85 trillion in 2024 to \$5.00 trillion in 2025.

The countries that contributed most to this growth are: Indonesia, Saudi Arabia, Malaysia, Türkiye, Morocco, Egypt, Bangladesh, and Kuwait.

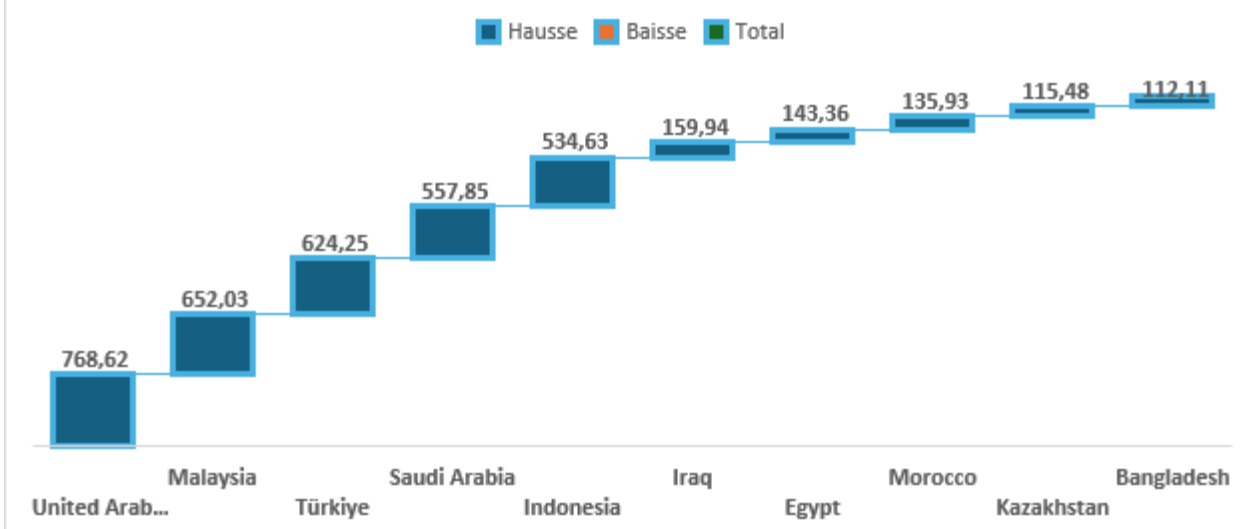
**Figure 11: Evolution of Global Trade of OIC Member States, 2016–2025 (in trillion USD)**

The leading players in the foreign trade of OIC Member States are: the United Arab Emirates, Malaysia, Türkiye, Saudi Arabia, Indonesia, Iraq, Egypt, Morocco, Kazakhstan, and Bangladesh, which accounted for more than three trillion USD, or 76.06% of total trade, in 2025.

Between 2024 and 2025, global exports of Organisation of Islamic Cooperation countries recorded a slight decline of 1.25%, decreasing from USD 2.38 trillion in 2024 to USD 2.35 trillion in 2025. In contrast, imports experienced a significant increase of 7.60%, reaching USD 2.64 trillion in 2025, compared to USD 2.45 trillion in 2024.

## 2. FOREIGN TRADE STRUCTURE

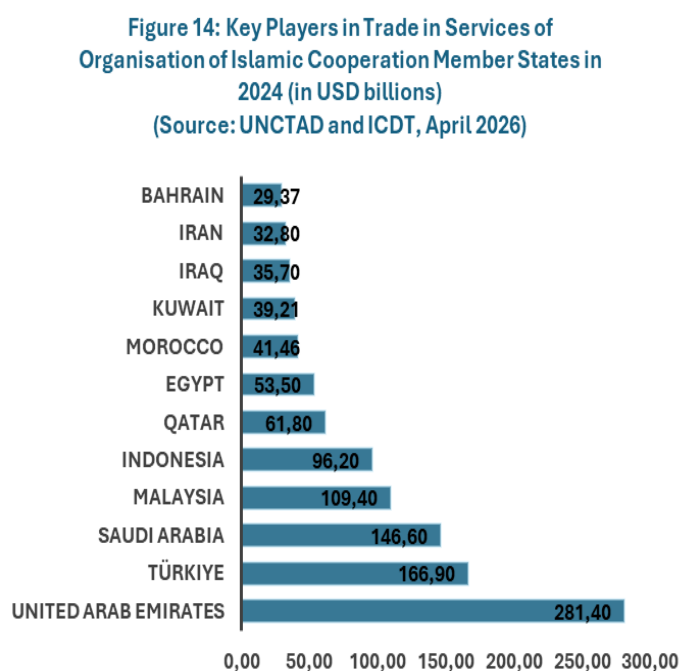
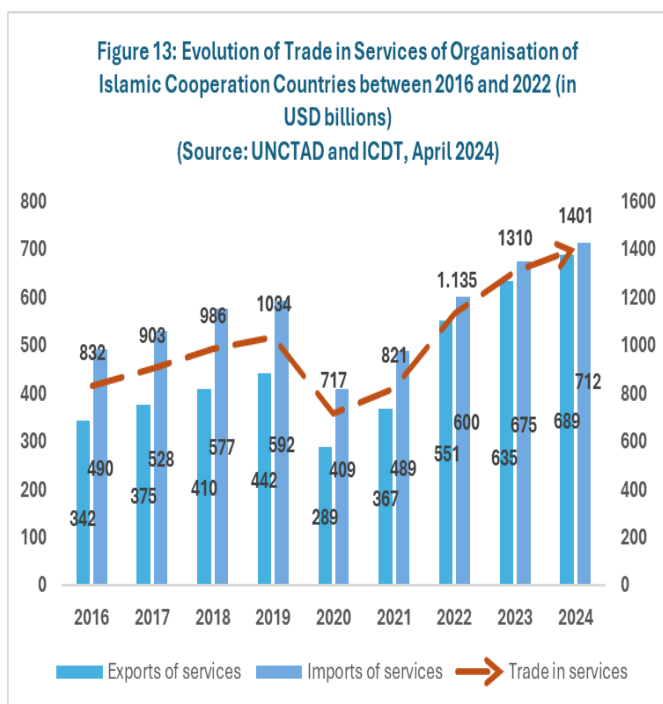
According to International Trade Centre data from April 2026, the main products exported by Organisation of Islamic Cooperation member states in 2025 were dominated by electrical machinery and equipment, fuels, animal and vegetable fats and oils, as well as motor vehicles.

Imports, for their part, mainly consisted of electrical machinery and equipment, fuels, land vehicles, pearls and precious metals, as well as iron and steel and plastics.

## 3. EVOLUTION AND STRUCTURE OF TRADE IN SERVICES

Global trade in services recorded a 7.8% increase in 2025 compared to 2024, reaching USD 18.4 trillion. This growth was mainly driven by the strong recovery in international travel (+38%) as well as the sustained expansion of digital services (+24%), particularly in the financial, business services, and telecommunications sectors in an increasingly digitalized services economy.

Developed countries recorded an increase of 7.98% in their exports and 8.15% in their imports, while developing countries contributed 22% of these exports and 5.75% of these imports.



## III. EVOLUTION OF INVESTMENTS IN OIC COUNTRIES

The value of global foreign direct investment (FDI) recorded a notable increase of 4%, rising from USD 1.45 trillion in 2023 to USD 1.51 trillion, despite ongoing economic and political crises in the Ukraine–Russia region, the Middle East, Sub-Saharan Africa, and Latin America.

Indeed, FDI inflows increased by 12% in developed countries, compared to a 6% decline in developing countries. This trend was driven by a 23% growth in North America and a 29%

drop in China, largely due to fluctuations in mergers and acquisitions in high-tech services (cloud computing, artificial intelligence, data centers, fintech platforms, tradetech, blockchain, big data, and enterprise software), as well as in public transport infrastructure, renewable energy, agri-food, and healthcare sectors.

## 1. EVOLUTION OF FOREIGN DIRECT INVESTMENT (FDI) IN AFRICA

According to United Nations Conference on Trade and Development, foreign direct investment (FDI) flows to Africa increased by 75%, reaching USD 97 billion, representing 6% of global FDI in 2024, compared to 4% in 2023. This growth was largely driven by an international agreement to finance urban development projects in Egypt. Moreover, this upward trend also reflected a 12% increase, bringing inflows to approximately USD 62 billion, or 4% of global flows. Investment facilitation efforts continued to play a significant role on the continent, accounting for 36% of investor-friendly policy measures.

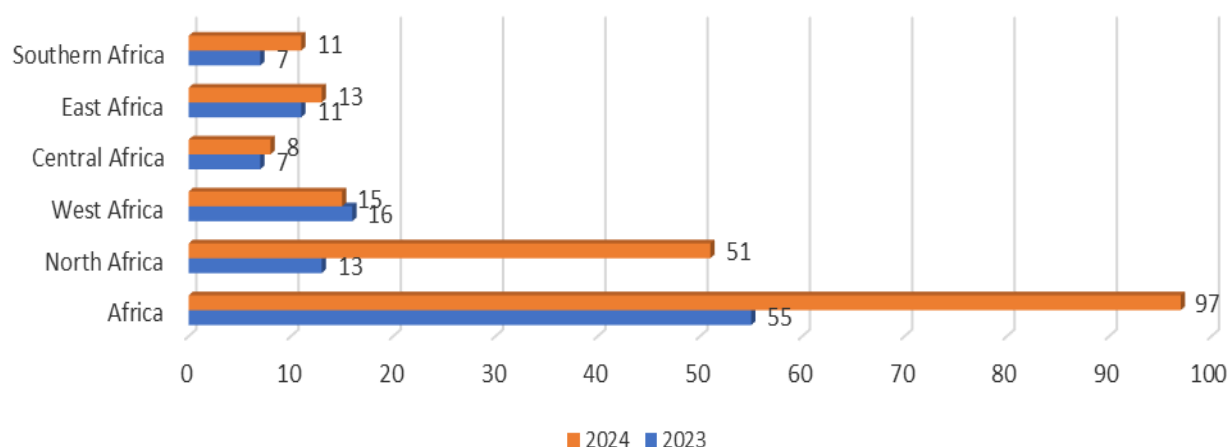
In Africa, the value of international project finance (IPF) deals rose by 15%, supported by major projects in the energy and transport infrastructure sectors. In Egypt, IPF commitments more than doubled despite a 3% decline in the number of projects. Renewable energy was the only sector to record notable growth, with seven major deals worth around USD 17 billion, mainly in offshore power cables and wind and solar plants in Egypt. Other countries also recorded increases in FDI inflows, including Tunisia (+21%, reaching USD 936 million) and Morocco (+55%, reaching USD 1.6 billion), partly driven by investments in renewable energy.

In the same vein, liberalization remained a key component of investment policymaking in Africa and Asia, accounting for one-fifth of the measures adopted in 2024. European investors held the largest stock of FDI in Africa, followed by the United States and China. Chinese investments totaled USD 42 billion in the pharmaceutical and agri-food industries. About one-third of projects under the Belt and Road Initiative focus on social infrastructure and renewable energy.

At the sectoral level, construction and metal products recorded the strongest increases in greenfield investment projects, while investment in electricity and gas supply projects declined by USD 51 billion across African countries.

## 2. EVOLUTION OF FOREIGN DIRECT INVESTMENT (FDI) IN ASIA

Asian countries are known for their strong attractiveness to foreign direct investment (FDI), although they experienced a contraction of around 3% between 2023 and 2024. Nevertheless, the region remains the world’s leading destination for foreign investment. In 2024, Asia accounted for 40% of total global FDI and 70% of flows to developing economies, despite increased volatility and fragmentation in the southern part of the region. This situation is mainly due to declining investment in infrastructure, rising digital flows, and growing uncertainty in domestic policies.

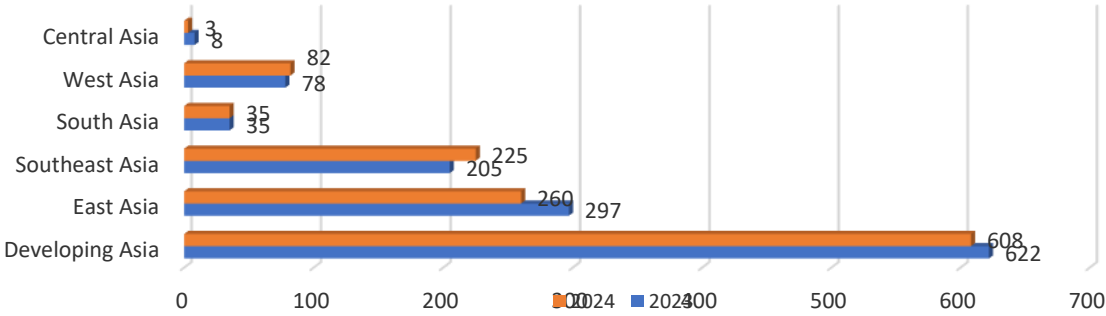
Indeed, China remains the largest recipient of FDI among developing economies, although inflows declined by 29% in 2024. In contrast, flows to Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) increased by 10%, reaching USD 225 billion, driven by strong growth in Indonesia, Malaysia, Singapore, Thailand, and Vietnam, as well as in Pakistan and Sri Lanka.

Furthermore, a decline was observed in India, although it remained one of the largest recipients of foreign investment in the region. In Central Asia, a notable decrease in FDI was recorded in Kazakhstan, as well as in several Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) countries, including Bahrain, Kuwait, Oman, Qatar, and Saudi Arabia.

In 2024, the number of greenfield projects in Asia increased by 5%, but their total value fell by 23%, amounting to USD 363 billion. This decline was mainly due to a reduction of USD 70 billion in electricity, gas, and oil production projects, despite growth in the digital economy and metallurgical production. This downturn is also linked to decreased international project finance (IPF) in infrastructure and public services, combined with a slowdown in cross-border mergers and acquisitions in China and India, which are increasingly shifting toward the digital industry.

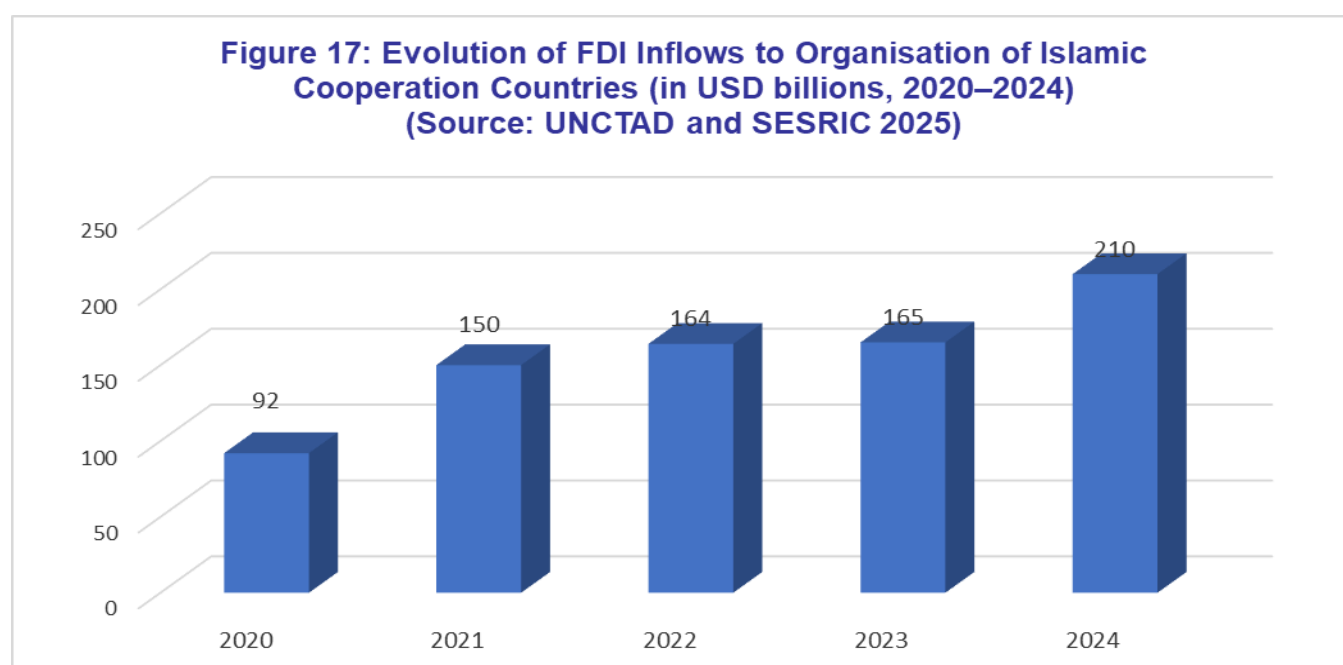


### 3. EVOLUTION OF FOREIGN DIRECT INVESTMENT (FDI) IN OIC MEMBER STATES

According to United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (2025) data, net FDI inflows to OIC Member States totaled approximately USD 165 billion, compared to USD 210 billion in 2024, representing a growth of more than 27%, driven by increased inflows into Gulf countries, Sub-Saharan Africa, and Asia. As a result, the share of OIC countries in global FDI flows improved by 23%, rising from 11.3% in 2023 to 13.9% in 2024. Similarly, their share in total flows to developing countries increased from 24.5% in 2023 to 33.2% in 2024. In addition, total FDI stock in OIC countries reached USD 2.6 trillion in 2024, representing around 5% of global FDI stock.

The main recipients of FDI among OIC countries include Egypt, United Arab Emirates, Indonesia, Saudi Arabia, Malaysia, Turkey, Oman, Guyana, Côte d'Ivoire, and Mozambique, which together account for more than 85% of total FDI inflows to OIC Member States.

Moreover, the countries with the largest FDI stock in 2024 are Indonesia, United Arab Emirates, Saudi Arabia, Malaysia, Egypt, Turkey, Kazakhstan, Lebanon, Nigeria, and Oman, accounting for 70% of the total FDI stock of OIC Member States.



## IV. TRENDS IN INTRA-OIC TRADE

### 1. EVOLUTION OF INTRA-OIC TRADE

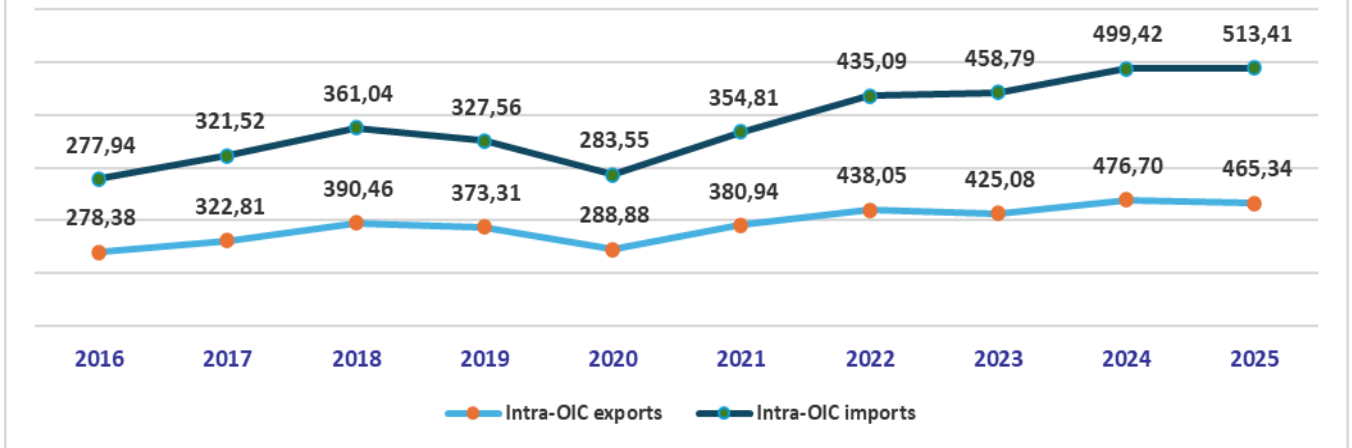
In a context of gradual recovery in the global economy, Organisation of Islamic Cooperation countries recorded a slight increase in intra-OIC trade, reaching USD 979 billion in 2025, compared to USD 976 billion in 2024, representing a rise of 0.27%.

This moderate growth can be explained by the diversification of member states' economies, the strengthening of local production, disruptions in supply chains, and ongoing geopolitical tensions that continue to hinder the smooth flow of trade.

Moreover, the share of intra-OIC trade in the total external trade of member states decreased by 2.87%, falling from 20.15% in 2024 to 19.57% in 2025.

This increase is attributed to trade growth of more than USD 1 billion in the following countries: Libya, Côte d'Ivoire, Guyana, Jordan, Mozambique, Benin, Algeria, Egypt, Chad, and Nigeria.

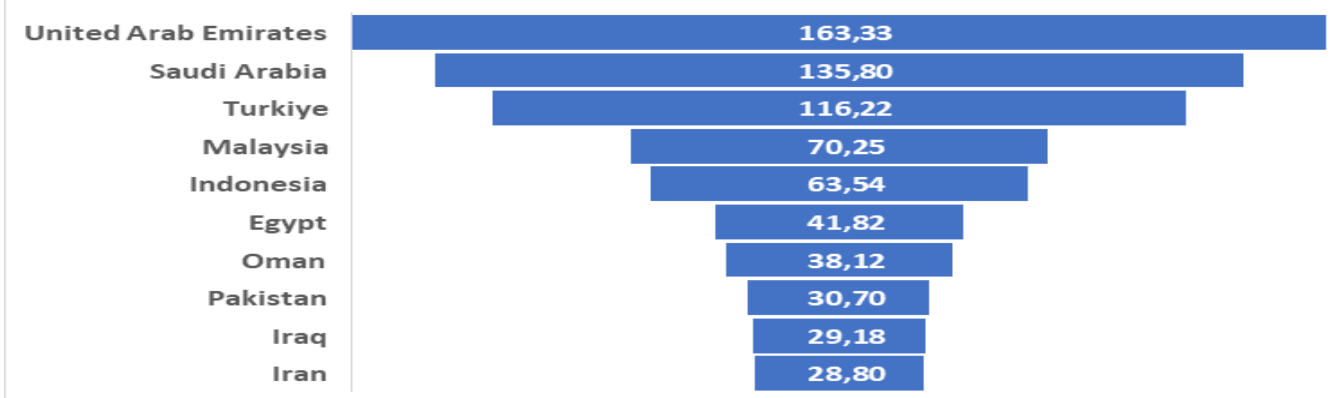

The main players in intra-OIC trade in 2025 are: United Arab Emirates, Saudi Arabia, Turkey, Malaysia, Indonesia, Egypt, Oman, Pakistan, Iraq, and Iran. These countries accounted for approximately 73% of intra-OIC trade, representing a total of USD 718 billion.

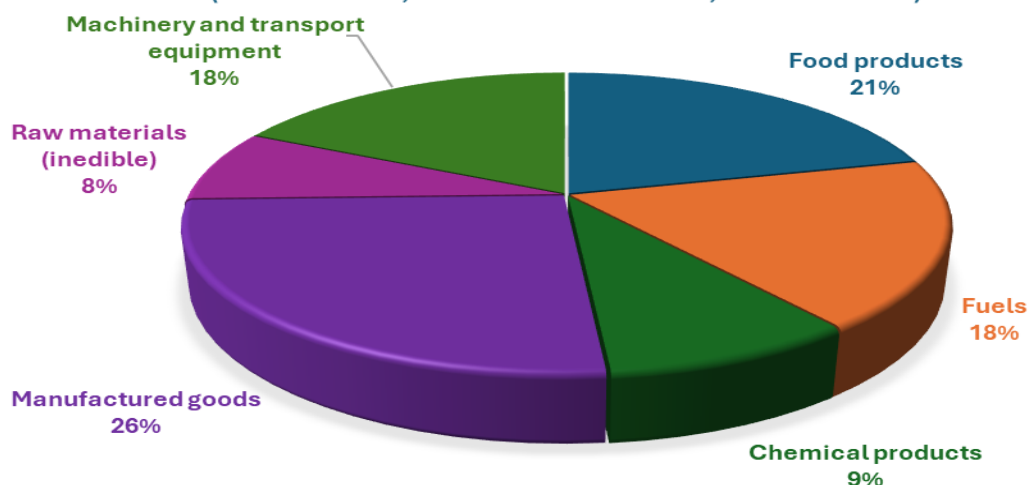


## 2. STRUCTURE OF INTRA-OIC TRADE

According to International Trade Centre data from April 2026, the main products traded among Organisation of Islamic Cooperation Member States in 2025 are characterized by a strong sectoral concentration. On the export side, intra-OIC trade mainly involves animal and vegetable fats and oils, pearls and precious metals, mineral fuels, as well as mechanical machinery and equipment, electrical equipment, iron and steel, land vehicles, plastics, miscellaneous manufactured articles, and cereals.

As for intra-OIC imports, they are dominated by fuels, pearls and precious metals, plastics, cast iron and steel, aluminum, copper, cocoa, as well as organic chemical products.

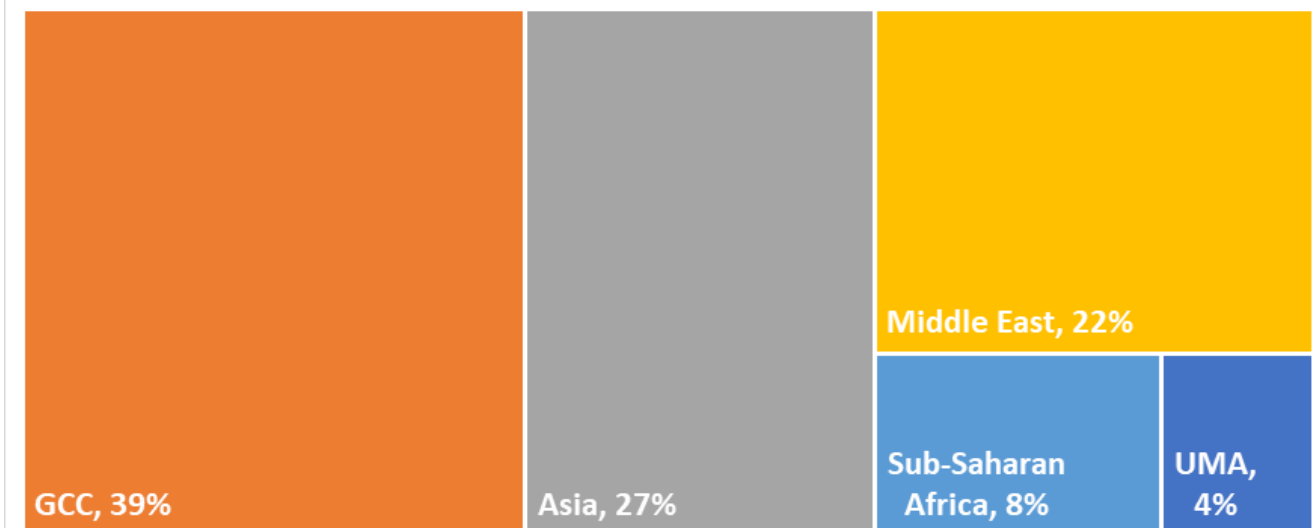


The chart indicates that trade among Organisation of Islamic Cooperation Member States is concentrated in manufactured goods, food products, and fuels. This highlights the need to strengthen regional value chains and to adopt structural reforms aimed at developing and diversifying intra-OIC trade.

### 3. GEOGRAPHICAL DISTRIBUTION OF INTRA-OIC TRADE

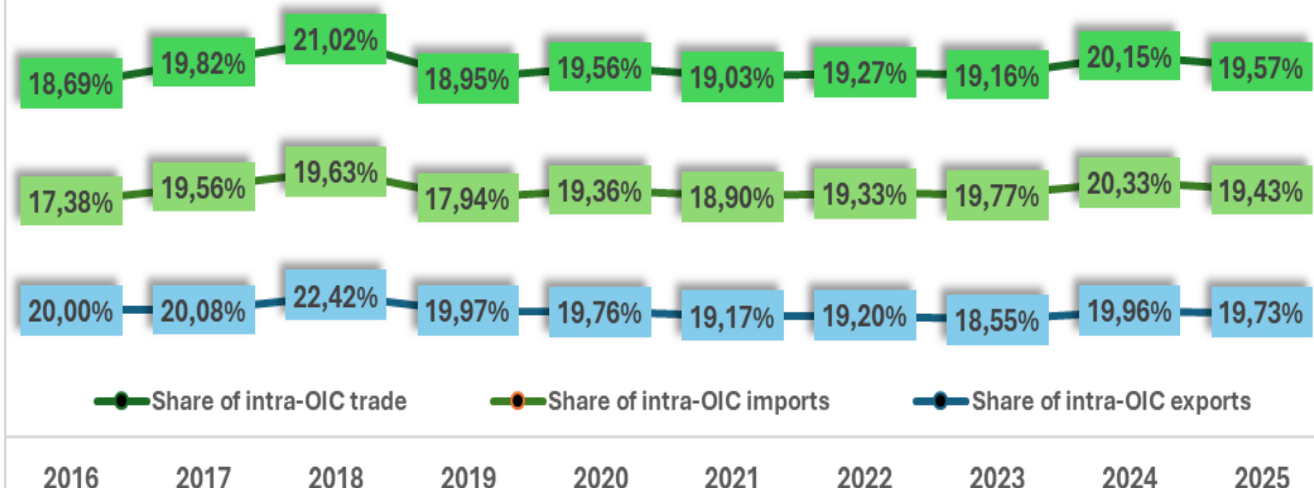
The geographical distribution of intra-OIC trade in 2025 is as follows: Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) countries account for the largest share (39%), followed by Asian countries (27%), Middle Eastern countries (22%), Sub-Saharan African countries (8%), and finally the countries of the Arab Maghreb Union (4%).

**Figure 22 : Evolution of the Share of Intra-OIC Trade between 2016 and 2025**

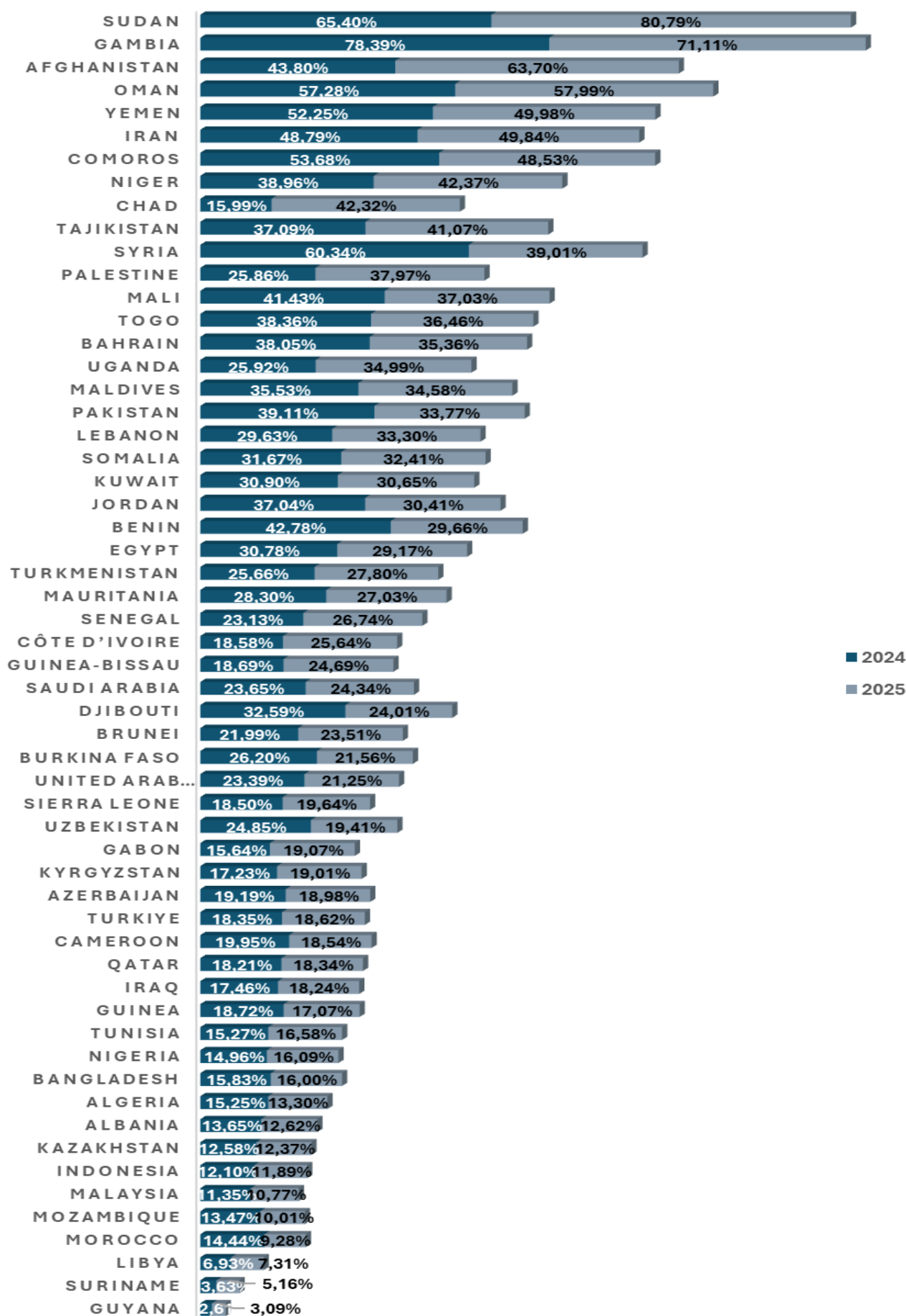

In summary, 28 Organisation of Islamic Cooperation Member States reached, in 2025, an intra-OIC trade share equal to or exceeding 25% of their total trade. These countries are: Sudan, The Gambia, Afghanistan, Oman, Yemen, Iran, Comoros, Niger, Chad, Tajikistan, Syria, Palestine, Mali, Togo, Bahrain, Uganda, Maldives, Pakistan, Lebanon, Somalia, Kuwait, Jordan, Benin, Egypt, Turkmenistan, Mauritania, Senegal, and Côte d'Ivoire.

## V. WAY FORWARD

Between 2026 and 2027, Organisation of Islamic Cooperation Member States could experience GDP growth of approximately USD 1.97 trillion, despite the various crises affecting their economies. Indeed, GDP is expected to increase from USD 33.13 trillion in 2026 to USD 35.11 trillion in 2027, representing a growth of 5.96%.

According to data compiled from International Monetary Fund DOTS, WITS, and International Trade Centre in April 2026, as well as calculations by Islamic Centre for Development of Trade, the volume of global merchandise trade increased by 11% between 2024 and 2025, rising from USD 47.36 trillion in 2024 to USD 52.56 trillion in 2025. This growth is attributed to the recovery of the global economy, the increase in global exports, the evolution of regional and international trade agreements, and the stabilization of commodity prices.

Meanwhile, the economies of OIC Member States have demonstrated resilience in recent years, supported by implemented measures and strengthened bilateral and regional economic cooperation, particularly in the supply of food and medical products, the stabilization of commodity prices, and increased exports from producing countries to international markets. As a result, total trade of OIC Member States recorded a significant increase of 3.23%, rising from USD 4.85 trillion in 2024 to USD 5.00 trillion in 2025.

Global trade in services increased by 9% in 2023 compared to 2022, reaching USD 15 trillion. This growth was mainly driven by the strong recovery in international travel (+34%) and the sustained expansion of digital services (+8%), particularly in financial and business services, in a post-pandemic transition context. Developed countries recorded an increase of 8.70% in their exports and 9.46% in their imports, while developing countries contributed 7.38% to exports and 9.11% to imports.

In a context of gradual recovery in the global economy, OIC Member States recorded a slight increase in intra-OIC trade, reaching USD 979 billion in 2025, compared to USD 976 billion in 2024, representing a rise of 0.27%. This moderate growth is explained by the diversification of member states' economies, the strengthening of local production, disruptions in supply chains, as well as ongoing geopolitical tensions that continue to hinder the smooth flow of trade. Moreover, the share of intra-OIC trade in the total external trade of Member States decreased by 2.87%, falling from 20.15% in 2024 to 19.57% in 2025.

Overall, 28 Member States reached, in 2025, an intra-OIC trade share equal to or exceeding 25% of their total trade. These countries include: Sudan, Gambia, Afghanistan, Oman, Yemen, Iran, Comoros, Niger, Chad, Tajikistan, Syria, Palestine, Mali, Togo, Bahrain, Uganda, Maldives, Pakistan, Lebanon, Somalia, Kuwait, Jordan, Benin, Egypt, Turkmenistan, Mauritania, Senegal, and Côte d'Ivoire.

To achieve the objective of the Ten-Year Programme of Action (2026–2035), which aims to increase the share of intra-OIC trade to 30% by 2035, the Islamic Centre for Development of Trade has launched a program focused on trade facilitation and investment promotion, the development of strategic products, trade intelligence, and international trade negotiations, in collaboration with the Trade and Investment Support Institutions and regional and international organizations.

This program includes, among other activities:

- Organization of a general trade fair and a tourism fair (every two years), as well as specialized exhibitions (4 to 6 per year);
- ICDT investment initiatives by country and by region targeting key national and regional sectors, in order to help increase sectoral investment flows among Member States.
- OIC strategic sector initiatives by country aimed at attracting importers and investors to specific OIC Member States (pineapple, cotton, yam, coffee, fishery products, wood, rice, dates, meat, vegetable oils – palm, groundnut, sunflower – hides and leather, fertilizers);
- Projects for the digitalization of foreign trade and investment services and the reduction of trade costs, such as e-Phyto, e-sanitary certificates, eTIR, and eCMR across Organisation of Islamic Cooperation countries, particularly in Sub-Saharan Africa and Central Asia, in collaboration with the Islamic Development Bank Group (Cooperation and Capacity Development Department), United Nations Conference on Trade and Development, United Nations Economic Commission for Europe, International Road Transport Union, and the Global Alliance for Trade Facilitation;
- Updating trade and investment databases in collaboration with the International Trade Centre, World Trade Organization, and United Nations Conference on Trade and Development to inform Member States about trade and investment opportunities at national and regional levels;
- Supporting OIC countries that are candidates for accession to the World Trade Organization and implementing the Trade Preferential System of the OIC in collaboration with the WTO, UNCTAD, Standing Committee for Economic and Commercial Cooperation, and the Islamic Development Bank;
- Publication of annual reports on trade and investment, the halal economy, tourism, and international trade negotiations;
- Support programs for women entrepreneurs in their business projects across OIC countries;
- Food safety and security programs in Sub-Saharan Africa in collaboration with SMEs, Arab Bank for Economic Development in Africa, the Islamic Development Bank, African Guarantee Fund for Economic Cooperation, World Health Organization, Food and Agriculture Organization, and other partners.
