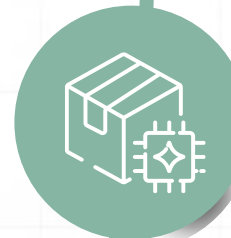

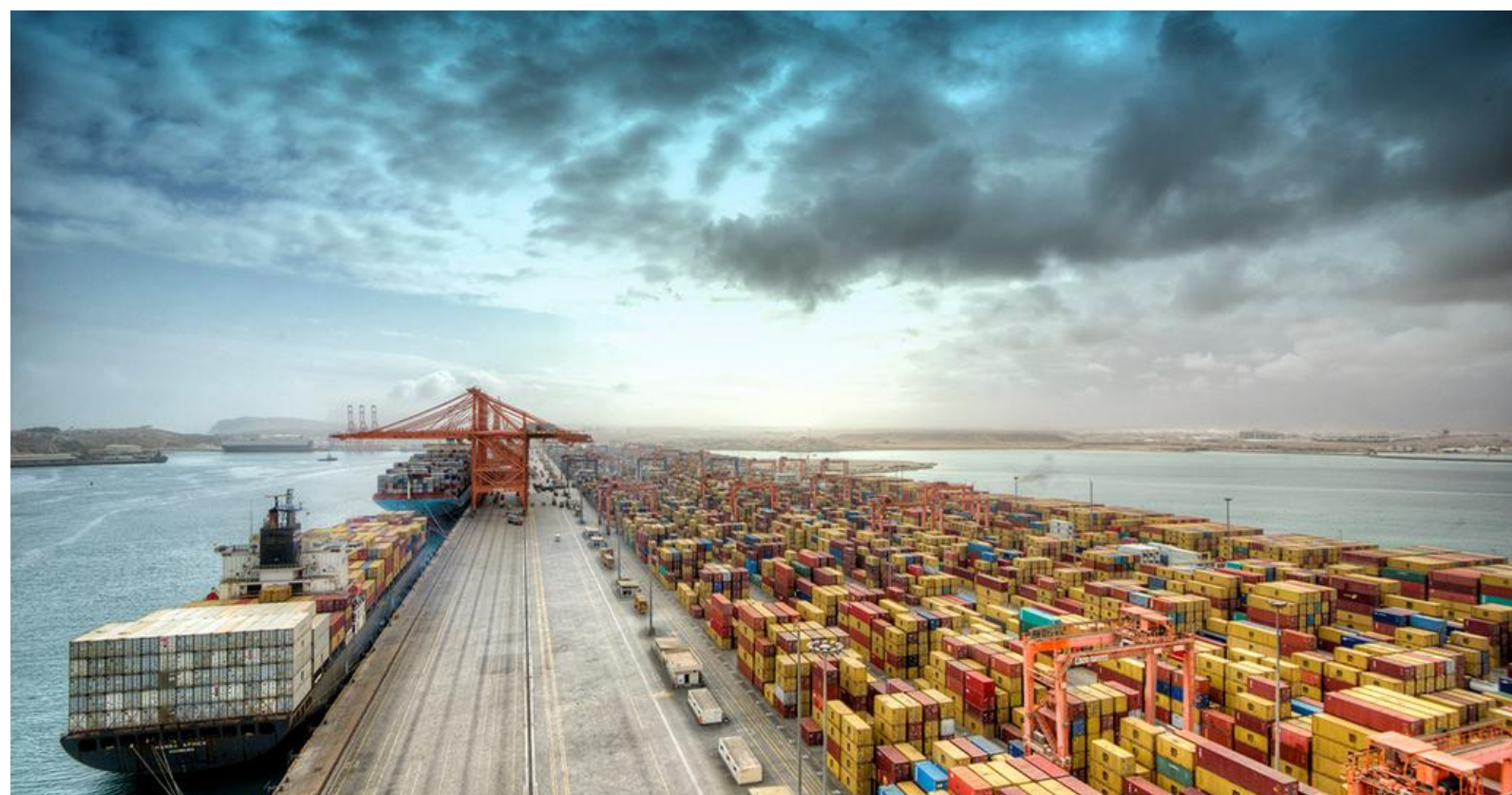

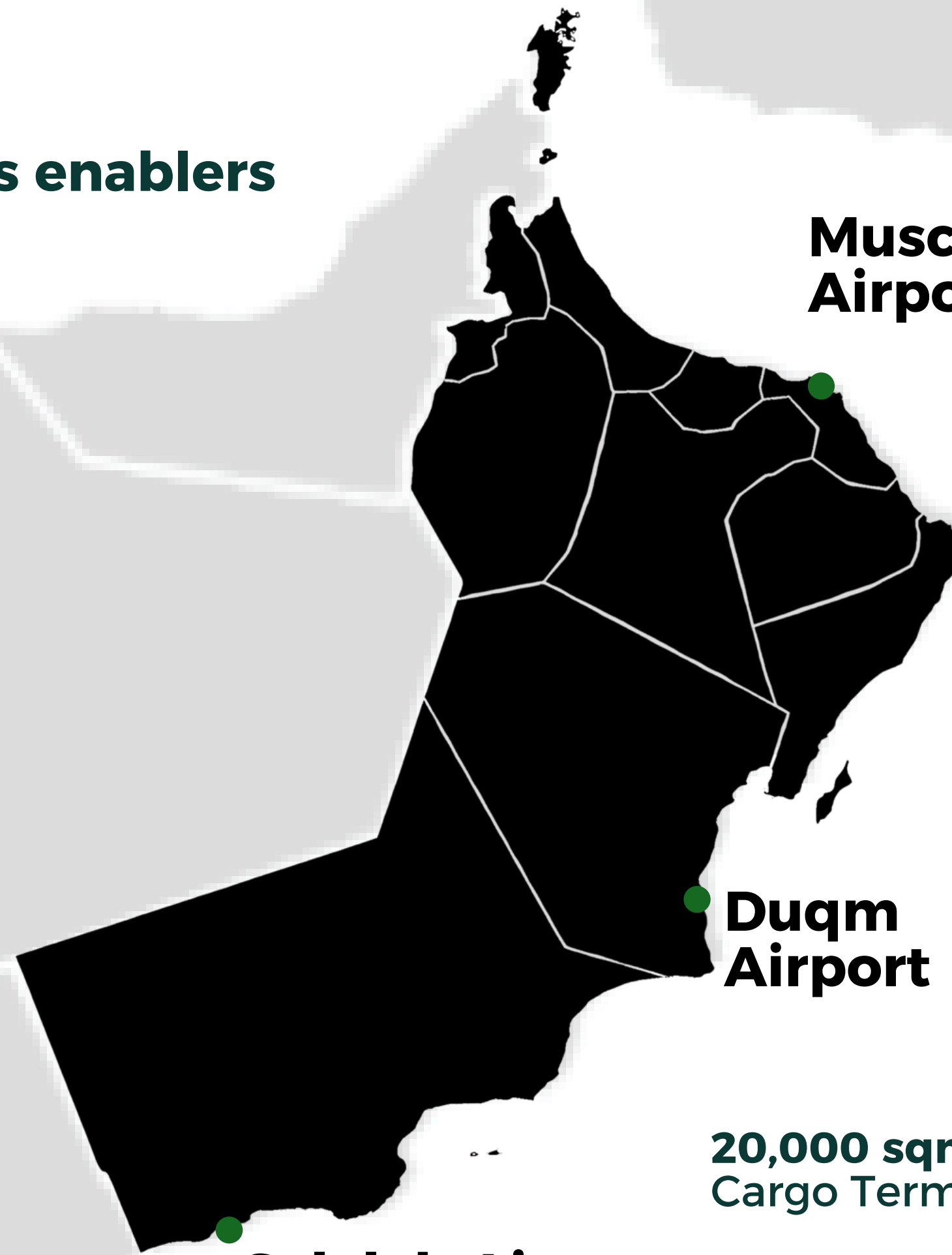

Multimodal Transport Law

An integrated legal framework governing the movement of goods under a single contract across two or more modes of transport. It defines the rights, obligations and liability of all parties, enables negotiable transport documents, and supports efficient, secure and competitive trade corridors.

ONE CONTRACT, ONE REGIME

A unified legal framework for door-to-door cargo movement across road, sea, air and rail.

NEGOTIABLE DOCUMENTS

Recognition of negotiable and electronic multimodal transport documents to support trade finance.

LIABILITY & CLAIMS

Clear allocation of carrier liability, claims procedures, time limits and compensation rules.

TRADE COMPETITIVENESS

Faster cargo flows, lower transaction costs and stronger confidence in Oman's logistics corridors.

Laws & Regulations

Electronic Waybill (E-way Bill)

A formal document that governs the freight transport agreement and records the consignor, consignee, carrier and shipment details. The initiative uses blockchain technology to secure and automate the transport document, enabling electronic exchange among the parties involved.

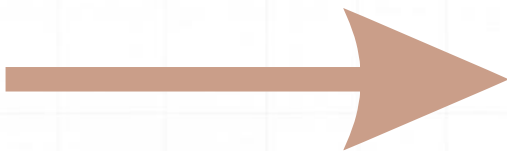

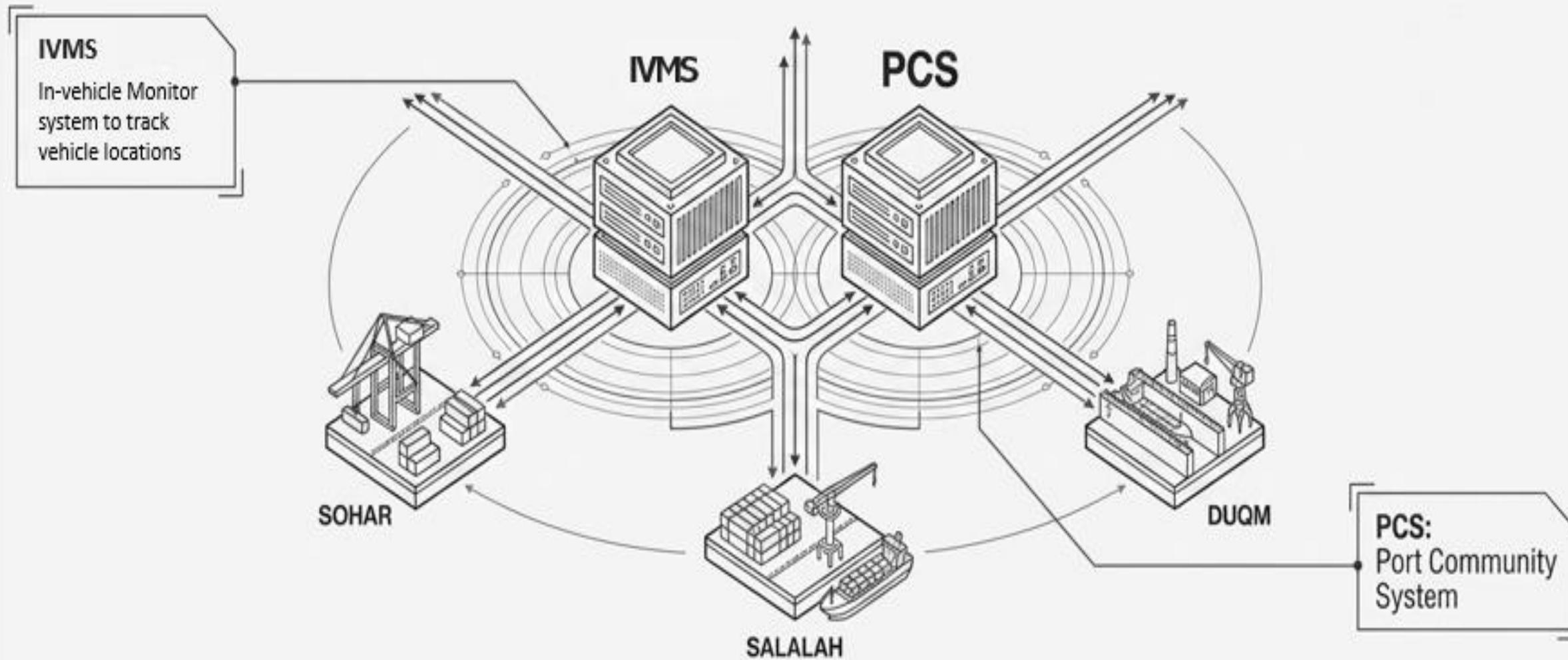
